RESOLUTION TERMS: Develop and certify implementation of compliance
operations manual; conduct an internal training that includes
procedures for determining and disclosing independent
expenditures; and pay a civil penalty of \$12,100.

Attached for your review is a signed Negotiated Settlement pertaining to ADR 922 (RAD 19L-17). The ADR Office received this referral on July 16, 2019.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred United We Can and Gerald Hudson, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to file one (1) 24-Hour Report totaling \$161,347.77 to support two (2) independent expenditures disclosed on the 2018 30-Day Post-General Report.

Respondents state that a miscommunication regarding the dissemination date for the independent expenditures resulted in the Committee inadvertently omitting these expenditures from a filed 24-Hour Report. Respondents state that since the error they have automated their internal independent expenditure process, with any updates or changes being documented within an electronic tracking system.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Approve the attached negotiated settlement of United We Can and Gerald Hudson, Treasurer.
2. Approve the appropriate letters.
3. Close the file on this matter.
