Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 19L-30 for processing on September 6, 2019, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 932. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We expect initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 932 within five (5) business days. Summary of Case: RAD referred For Our Future and Gail Stoltz, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on its 2018 30 Day Post-General Report, originally filed on December 6, 2018. On July 16, 2019, the Committee filed an Amended 30 Day Post-General Report including \$133,489.00 in additional in-kind contributions.

In a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) filed on July 15, 2019, the Committee stated that an internal miscommunication resulted in the inadvertent omission of the in-kind contributions. The Committee additionally stated that it has since reviewed its internal communication procedures in an effort to prevent similar omissions in the future.
