ADR 981 - ACTBLUE and Erin Hill, Treasurer (C00401224)

The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 20L-22 for processing on October 29, 2020, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 981. This office intends to notify Respondents after five business days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the ADR Office.

Summary of Case: RAD referred ACTBLUE and Erin Hill, Treasurer (Respondent or the Committee) for failing to remedy apparent excessive receipts totaling \$43,676.10 within the permissible timeframe. The Committee refunded the entire amount outside the permissible timeframe.

On May 20, 2020 the Committee filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) in response stating that it has since enhanced its ability to detect contributions over the limit. Further, the Committee stated that it has identified the procedural oversight that resulted in the failure to identify the excessive contributions and corrected it.
