RESOLUTION TERMS: Certify that a representative of the Committee participated
in an FEC conference, webinar, or other training program
developed in consultation with the FEC's Information
Division; and pay a civil penalty of \$11,535.

Attached for your review is a signed Negotiated Settlement pertaining to ADR 993 (RAD 21L-02). The ADR Office received this referral on February 16, 2021.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred Alliance for a Better Minnesota Federal PAC and Joe Davis, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely file one (1) 48-Hour Report totaling \$230,756 supporting one (1) independent expenditure disclosed on the 2020 October Quarterly Report.

On December 4, 2020, the Committee filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) stating that its failure to timely file the 48-Hour Report was due to an internal miscommunication, and it filed the required 48-Hour Report upon discovery of its oversight. In addition, the Committee stated that it had modified its

internal processes to ensure the type of miscommunication that led to the untimely filing does not reoccur.

1. Approve the attached Negotiated Settlement of Alliance for a Better Minnesota Federal PAC and Joe Davis, Treasurer.
