
Dear Sirs:

On July 31, 1978, I submitted a letter to your office requesting an advisory opinion regarding in kind contributions by county party committees to the Citizens for Cochran Committee. My correspondence was received by your office on August 3, 1978, and was designated AOR 1978-55.

During the intervening period, the hypothetical situations cited which prompted the request for the advisory opinion were further discussed with legal counsel. Through their recommendations, the Citizens for Cochran Committee has become fully cognizant of the fact that it cannot, and will not, accept any contribution from any committee, party or non-party, that has been tainted by corporate contributions.

Therefore, the request for AOR 1978-55 is hereby withdrawn.
