The purpose of our request for an Advisory Opinion by the Federal Election Commission is to determine whether or not corporate checks written to "ASHA-PAC" can be deposited into a banking account of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association to be used to defray the expenses of administering ASHA-PAC (e.g. fundraising mailings) when those checks are written by: 1) association members who own incorporated private practices, and 2) association members who are presidents of separate state associations.
