Ohio- Drs. Hagelin and Tompkins, President and Vice President

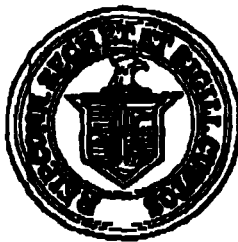
Pennsylvania- William Alan Hickman and Eugene Nau, House
