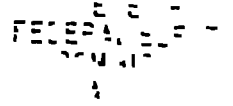

Dear Mr. Terry:

This refers further to your recent inquiries dated August 4 and 5, 1992, to me seeking an advisory opinion from the Federal Election Commission with respect to your continuing employment as the host of a daily radio talk show while you are a 1992 candidate for Congress.

I have received tapes of three very recent radio broadcasts of your program "Randall Terry Live." There are a few other factual clarifications that should also be provided at this time. Please provide written responses to the following questions.

1) State the history of your radio broadcast program career. Your answer should include the date when your current program began and a brief summary of any other broadcast activity you have previously pursued.

2) Is Randall Terry Live broadcast in a manner that accepts live call-ins from listeners who engage you (and others) in conversation that simultaneously goes on the air? Or are the call-ins pre-recorded or subject to any broadcast delay features? Describe each system that is used.

3) Identify all cities and counties in New York where your program may be heard.

4) Describe other employment ventures that you pursue along with your daily radio program. Include an estimate of the number of hours per week that you spend with the radio program and with your other employment ventures.


5) Explain the role and authority of Randall Terry Live, Inc., in the production and distribution of the radio program. Also identify the stockholders and officers of the corporation, and state their family (or other) relationships with you.

Greetings.

Here are the answers you requested.

Question #1

History: Besides hosting Randall Terry Live Inc, I have the following radio experience:

- 1) ~~hosted~~ From the fall of 1988 until the summer of 1992 I hosted a five-minute daily (mon-fri) entitled "Operation Rescue News Update"
- 2) In Feb 1992 I hosted one week in Bing. N.Y. on W.I.R.R. (1 hr. daily)
- 3) In Oct 1991 I hosted one week in L.A. Cal. on K.K.L.A. (1 hr. daily)
- 4) In Aug. 1991 I hosted two weeks on K.S.G.L. (and another 50 stations via satellite) (1 hr. daily)
- 5) In July 1991 I hosted one week on K.C.C.V. (1 hr. daily)

Question #2

We do accept live call-ins, and we do talk at ones simultaneously over

the air. We do not have a "delay" system.

Question #3 -

We are only carried on one N.Y. Station - W.L.N.C. in Horseheads N.Y. (near Elmira)

As you can see by looking at a map, Horseheads is quite a distance from this district. WL.M.L. is a 5000 watt "Daytimer" which beams into Chemung, Tioga, Schuyler & Steuben counties. The signal also reaches portions of Broome County - but primarily the western side and the center. By the time you're in Binghamton, the signal is almost extinct.

Question #4

I spend about 35 hours per week ~~working~~ ^{working} for Randall Terry Live. I am also a lecturer and a pro-life activist. That takes on average about 15 hrs a week. I earn roughly the same amount of money in speaking honorariums as I do through radio. (I don't have an exact amount until the end of the tax year.)

Question #5

A family member is the sole incorporator of Randall Terry Live Inc. Neither this family member, nor the incorporation has made any donations to the campaign, nor done "in kind" contributions, nor

does the family member or incorporation
intend to do so.
Randall Terry Corp. Inc. Produces the
show, which is then distributed via satellite
around the nation on a C.B.N. satellite

I hope these answers will help us expedite the process. The election is only five weeks away! My, how time flies.
