Dear Mr. Litchfield:

This letter constitutes an Advisory Opinion Supplement letter requested by you in a November 5, 1992 telephone conversation with staff of the Clinton/Gore '92 Committee ("the Committee"). It is my understanding that you require additional information regarding two aspects of the Committee's Advisory Opinion Request.

First, you have requested information regarding the types of expenses the Committee is required to pay before the Secret Service reimbursements are received. A listing of these expenses is attached.

Second, you have requested clarification of the amount owed to the Committee by the Secret Service. The Committee estimates this amount as 1.2 million dollars for expenses up to and including those incurred on November 3, 1992. The Committee has not yet billed the Secret Service for all expenses incurred. Thus, the Secret Service's figures for amounts owed do not reflect all charges to be billed through November 3, 1992.
