Dear Ms. Hefner:

This refers to your letters dated January 9 and February 16 1993, concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 ("the Act"), as amended, to the deposit and reporting of contributions made during the 1992 campaign to Fields for Congress ("the Committee"), but not discovered until 1993.

You state that on January 4, 1993, when inquiring about holiday mail removed from the Committee's post office box, you discovered that post office personnel had also removed mail from the box on October 31 or November 1, 1992, and had failed to notify the Committee. These contributions totaled \$5,405 and were postmarked, you state, from the last week in October, 1992. You now seek guidance as to the procedures the Committee should adopt in regard to the treatment of these contributions.

The Act authorizes the Commission to issue an advisory opinion in response to a "complete written request" from any person with respect to a specific transaction or activity by the requesting person. 2 U.S.C. §437f(a). Commission regulations explain that such a request "shall include a complete description of all facts relevant to the specific transaction or activity with respect to which the request is made." 11 CFR 112.1(c). Finally, this office is authorized to determine if a request is incomplete or otherwise not qualified as an advisory opinion request. 11 CFR 112.1(d).

Your February 16 letter includes copies of various documents including contribution letters, checks and envelopes. After reviewing your documentation, this office has determined that clarification on some points is necessary, as well as additional information.


1. Your February 16 letter includes a copy of a letter signed by Albert H. Kramer which informs the Committee of \$100 in contributions made by members of the American Public Communications Council (APCC). Please identify which particular contributions of the total \$5,405 amount made up the \$100 referred to in the Kramer letter.
2. Your documentation fails to provide copies of the postmarked envelopes for the contributions made by the following contributors: Bruce A. Sandys, Edward S. Zacek, and USAA Group Political Action Committee. Further, copies provided of the envelopes of two contributors, Stan Schlueter and Ms. Lois Emma Hall appear to be incomplete so not to display the postmark date. Please complete your documentation by providing the above information.
3. Finally, the documentation contains an envelope which cannot be positively connected with any of the other contributions. The sole identification is a signature which appears to be "Carmel Culpepper." Please explain the relationship, if any, this contributor has with any of the other contributors identified in your inquiry.

Upon receiving your response to this request for information, this office and the Commission will give further consideration to your inquiry as an advisory opinion request. If you have any questions concerning the advisory opinion process or this letter, please contact the undersigned.
