
To the Commission:

In connection with Draft AO 1995-2, dated April 13, 1995, please accept the following comment (submitted to clarify the New York Mercantile Exchange's ("NYMEX") submission dated January 4, 1995 at page 1).

As set forth at line 23 of Draft AO 1995-2, the COMEX Division continues to trade contracts formerly traded by the COMEX. However, the second clause of the sentence beginning at line 23 is inaccurate and should read "and COMEX Members also have trading rights with respect to certain new contracts that may be traded in the future on each division."
