Re: Advisory Opinion Request

Dear Mr. Noble:

This letter is a follow-up to the request for an advisory opinion dated November 20, 1997 from Hughes Electronics Corporation. In that request I informed you (at page 4, the middle paragraph under "HACF") that the number of participants making contributions from the defense, the telecommunications and space and the automotive business units broke down into the following percentages: 72%/20%/8%. Then in Question 4 on page 5 I state that the existing funds would be split among the three proposed PACs based on the amount contributed weekly from the respective businesses. Erroneously, I stated that this breakdown is 72%/20%/8%. In fact the amount of money contributed weekly (as opposed to the number of participants making weekly contributions) breaks down as follows: 62%/30%/8%.

Accordingly, please treat this letter as an amendment to Question 4 in my advisory opinion request of November 20, 1997 (1) to delete the words "72%/20%/8%" and to substitute in lieu thereof the words "62%/30%/8%" and (2) to delete the reference to "72%" in the parenthesis and substitute in lieu thereof the words "62%".
