11	This refers to your letter dated January 23, 1998, which requests advice	•
12	concerning the application of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended	
13	("the Act"), and Commission regulations to the possible status of the Reform Party of	
14	Idaho ("the Party") as a State committee of a political party.	
15	Enclosed with your request is a copy of the certificate of the Party's ballot status in	
16	the State of Idaho. Your request also includes a copy of an affiliation agreement between	
17	the Reform Party of Idaho and the Reform Party of the United States of America.	
18	Under the Act and Commission regulations, the term "State committee" means the	
1 9	organization which, by virtue of the bylaws of a political party, is responsible for the day-	
20	to-day operation of such political party at the State level, as determined by the	
21	Commission. 2 U.S.C. §431(15); 11 CFR 100.14. The definition of State committee also	
22	requires the existence of a political party. The term "political party" is defined under 2	
23	U.S.C. §431(16) and 11 CFR 100.15 as an association, committee, or organization which	
24	nominates a candidate for election to any Federal office whose name appears on the	
25	election ballot as the candidate of such association, committee, or organization.	
26	The Commission notes that the issue of the State committee status of the Reform	
27	Party of Idaho was included in Advisory Opinion 1998-2 which considered and approved	
. 28	the national committee status of the Reform Party of the United States of America and the

1	State committee status of several of its State affiliates. See Advisory Opinion 1998-2.
2	For the reasons stated in that opinion, the Commission concludes again that the Reform
3	Party of Idaho qualifies as the State committee of a political party under the Act and
4	Commission regulations.
5	This response constitutes an advisory opinion concerning the application of the
6	Act, or regulations prescribed by the Commission, to the specific transaction or activity
7	set forth in your request. See 2 U.S.C. §437f.
