| 3 | "The Commission notes that this advisory opinion analyzes the Act, as amended by the |

| 4 | Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act of 2002 ("BCRA"), and Commission regulations, |
| 5 | including those promulgated to implement the BCRA amendments, as they pertain to |
| 6 | your proposed activities. On May 2, 2003, a three-judge panel of the United States |
| 7 | District Court for the District of Columbia ruled that a number of BCRA provisions are |
| 8 | unconstitutional and issued an order enjoining the enforcement, execution, or other |
| 9 | application of those provisions. McConnell v. FEC. Civ. No. 02-2003 WL 21003144 |
| 10 | (D.D.C. May 2, 2003), notice of appeal filed (U.S. May 2, 2003). The District Court |
| 11 | ruling has been appealed to the United States Supreme Court. The Commission has |
| 1 2 | determined that your request for advice is not affected by the District Court's ruling. The |
| 13 | Commission cautions that the legal analysis in this advisory opinion may be affected by |
| 14 | the eventual decision of the Supreme Court." |
