As we discussed this advisory opinion is now scheduled to be discussed by the Commission on December 11. By our calculations the 60 day period for consideration of your request will expire on December 15. While it is possible that the Commission can conclude its consideration of the request in one meeting it is also possible that the Commission will need two sessions to come to a consensus. The next open session would be December 18th. It would be helpful if you were to grant the Commission an extension of time until December 29 to deal with the request. This would permit the Commission extra time to deal with a tally vote conclusion to the December 18th meeting should that become necessary. We think this would cover all the possible eventualities.
