Thank you for visiting with Veronica Cintron and me yesterday about the Silvestre Reyes Golf Tournament to be held October 6, 2007. Our specific question was acceptable wording for hole sponsorships that would be paid individually with that individual's employer noted. We understand that 1) political contributions should not be made by individuals fronting for others, 2) It is illegal for corporations to make political contributions, and 3) such contributions would apply toward that individual's contribution limit. That being said, we have two samples attached for the hole sponsor signs. We hope you will agree that either sample would be acceptable.
