Dear Mr. Reiff:

Last week, you confirmed that your client, Nabilah Islam, is no longer a candidate for federal office. As a result, Ms. Islam's request for an advisory opinion no longer presents "a specific action or activity that the requesting person plans to undertake." *See* 11 C.F.R. § 112.1(b). Her request is therefore moot and no longer qualifies as an advisory opinion request. We are now closing our files on the matter.
