GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

BACKGROUND

This matter was generated as a result of a Reports Analysis review of the Travis County Democratic Yes Committee ("Yes") reports on file with the Commission. The review of the "Yes" committee reports indicated that the Travis County Democratic Executive Committee ("Exec"), a committee not registered with the Commission, transferred a total of \$1496.96 to the "Yes" committee. "Yes" committee reports revealed that support of Federal candidates was given during the period in which the transfer occurred.

Legal Analysis

Since the "Exec" committee transferred in excess of \$1,000 to the "Yes" committee, it therefore had an obligation to register with the Commission and submit reports of receipts and expenditures which it had failed to do.

General Counsel staff, upon contacting the committee treasurer by telephone, informed the treasurer of the necessity for the committee to file reports of receipts and expenditures for the year 1977, the year when the transfer

occurred.

On January 2, 1980, the Commission adopted the recommendation of the General Counsel to defer any further action against the committee until the reports had been received by the Reports Analysis Division.

The Yes Committee filed FEC forms 1 and 3 with the Commission on January 22 and February 8, 1980. A review of the reports by the Reports Analysis Division and the Office of General Counsel indicates that the Yes Committee has met the disclosure requirements of the Act. Accordingly, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission take no further action and close the file.

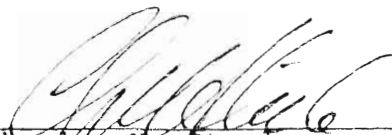

Each political committee which anticipates receiving contributions or making expenditures during the calendar year in aggregate amount exceeding \$1000 shall file with the Commission a statement of organization ...

Since the "Exec" committee transferred in excess of \$1,000 to the "Yes" committee during the 1977 calendar year, it therefore had an obligation to register with the Commission and submit reports of receipts and expenditures which it failed to do. On February 1, 1979, the Commission found reason to believe that the "Exec" committee violated 2 U.S.C. §§433 and 434 and the committee was so notified. The "Exec" committee has failed to submit anything in writing to date in response to the Commission's RTB letter of February 1, 1979.

On December 11, 1979, Office of General Counsel staff contacted by telephone, Bruce Todd, an agent representing the committee. Staff informed Mr. Todd of the necessity for the committee to register a statement of organization and file reports of receipts and expenditures for the year 1977. Mr. Todd responded that he would do so immediately and the appropriate forms were forwarded to his attention.

RECOMMENDATION

SUBJECT : Recommendation for Consideration as a Pre-MUR
CALMEDPAC and Physicians for Younger

In the course of normal review and analysis of reports filed by California Medical Political Action Committee, an apparent surface violation was discovered. Due to the fact that the reporting entity was a respondent in an open MUR, we consulted with your office and followed your request not to send surface violation letters. The matter is therefore being referred to you for your examination.

In August and September of 1978, California Medical Political Action Committee (CALMEDPAC) made three (3) loans to Physicians for Younger totaling \$25,000.00 (See Attachment 1). Physicians for Younger, an unregistered entity supporting the election of Evelle Younger (R) for governor of California, made three (3) partial repayments of this loan totaling \$15,540.70 (See Attachment 2) with the remainder forgiven by CALMEDPAC (See Attachment 3). In transferring in excess of \$1000 to a political committee, Physicians for Younger (per standard procedures established by the Commission in Directive 19) would have incurred a registration and filing requirement under the Act (See Attachment 4). Additionally, CALMEDPAC would have received a surface violation letter for receiving a transfer in excess of the \$5000 limitation from an unaffiliated committee (See Attachment 5).

While the Commission has made a determination concerning affiliation between CALMEDPAC and AMPAC, there is no such determination of affiliated status between CALMEDPAC and Physicians for Younger. CALMEDPAC has not disclosed Physicians for Younger as an affiliated committee on its Statement of Organization or amendments.

There has been some discussion as to whether the loan repayment to CALMEDPAC constitutes a contribution as defined by 2 U.S.C. 431(e) and 11 C.F.R. 100.4. Although this kind of repayment is not specifically mentioned within the definition of a contribution, it is not excluded by 11 C.F.R. 100.4(b).

Commission Directive 19 (February 1979) states that "when unregistered political organizations transfer an amount exceeding or aggregating in excess of \$1000 within a calendar year to a federal candidate(s) or federal committee(s), a surface violation letter is sent by the Reports Analysis Division." Since the Directive does not differentiate between types of receipts from unregistered entities, the Reports Analysis Division has treated these receipts universally by sending the letters.

An analogous situation occurred in closed MUR 623 involving the Vermont Republican Federal Election Committee. That committee loaned \$5000 to the Vermont Republican State Committee, an unregistered entity supporting state and local candidates. The loan was repaid in full. Further, the Vermont Republican State Committee accepted corporate contributions permitted under state law. The final report from the General Counsel, including the Consultation Agreement, stated "the definition of contributions includes "any direct or indirect payment", such as in this case, a loan repayment." The loan repayment was considered to be a contribution; consequently the Vermont Republican Federal Election Committee signed the Agreement, paid a civil penalty, and the case was closed.

The case addressed by MUR 623 is important because in both cases (The Vermont Republican Federal Election Committee and CALMEDPAC), a possibility existed that prohibited funds may have been comingled in the repayments to the registered political committees in violation of 2 U.S.C. 441b. Both California and Vermont state statutes allow corporate and union contributions. The issue of comingled funds has been vigorously pursued by the Commission previously in the suit filed by the FEC in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against AFL-CIO COPE. On June 12, 1978, the Court decided in favor of the FEC that comingled funds transferred to AFL-CIO COPE PCC violated 2 U.S.C. 441b, and further ordered a civil penalty assessed against AFL-CIO COPE PCC.
