GENERATION OF MATTER

Attorney Dave Jenkins contacted the Office of General Counsel and requested a meeting with staff to discuss a possible violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (hereinafter the "Act") by his client, Cutter Laboratories, Inc. Political Action Committee (hereinafter "CLIPAC"). Staff met with Mr. Jenkins on October 29, 1980, and discussed the situation of the PAC and the connected organization, Cutter Laboratories, Inc. Mr. Jenkins brought with him the PAC's statement of organization and filed it that day with the Commission. The problem which Mr. Jenkins presented to staff was that although certain statutory formalities concerning the establishment of the PAC were followed, CLIPAC was not registered with the Commission before the PAC began making contributions to candidates.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

The violations which appear to arise from the situation described by respondent is one of 2 U.S.C. § 433 for failing to register with and § 434 for failing to report to the Commission.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434 require any "separate segregated fund established under the provisions of 2 U.S.C. § 441b(b) to file a statement of organization no later than 10 days after establishment" and report to the Commission. Since according to CLIPAC's initial report, the fund was established at least as early as July 24, 1980, CLIPAC violated the Act by failing to register with and report to the Commission until October 27, 1980.

All of CLIPAC's disbursements were made on October 10, 1980. In making these contributions to candidates and in accepting contributions (both unitemized and itemized), CLIPAC was clearly acting in the capacity of a separate segregated fund (see initial report and statement of organization attached as Exhibit 1). Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission find reason to believe that CLIPAC violated 2 U.S.C. § 433 by failing to register with the Commission within 10 days of its establishment as a separate segregated fund and § 434 by failing to file the required reports with the Commission. However, since the respondent did ultimately register with the Commission, and since the respondent came forward with the information relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter and acted cooperatively with the Commission, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission take no further action, close the file in this matter and send the respondent a letter of admonition (see letter attached as Exhibit 2).

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find reason to believe that Cutter Laboratories Inc. Political Action Committee violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 433 and 434.

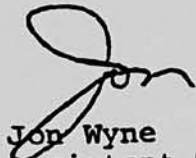

GENERATION OF MATTER

Attorney Dave Jenkins contacted the Office of General Counsel and requested a meeting with staff to discuss a possible violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (hereinafter the "Act") by his client, Cutter Laboratories, Inc. Political Action Committee (hereinafter "CLIPAC"). Staff met with Mr. Jenkins on October 29, 1980, and discussed the situation of the PAC and the connected organization, Cutter Laboratories, Inc. Mr. Jenkins brought with him the PAC's statement of organization and filed it that day with the Commission. The problem which Mr. Jenkins presented to staff was that although certain statutory formalities concerning the establishment of the PAC were followed, CLIPAC was not registered with the Commission before the PAC began making contributions to candidates.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

The violations which appear to arise from the situation described by respondent is one of 2 U.S.C. § 433 for failing to register with and § 434 for failing to report to the Commission.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434 require any "separate segregated fund established under the provisions of 2 U.S.C. § 441b(b) to file a statement of organization no later than 10 days after establishment" and report to the Commission. Since according to CLIPAC's initial report, the fund was established at least as early as July 24, 1980, CLIPAC violated the Act by failing to register with and report to the Commission until October 27, 1980.

All of CLIPAC's disbursements were made on October 10, 1980. In making these contributions to candidates and in accepting contributions (both unitemized and itemized), CLIPAC was clearly acting in the capacity of a separate segregated fund (see initial report and statement of organization attached as Exhibit 1). Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission find reason to believe that CLIPAC violated 2 U.S.C. § 433 by failing to register with the Commission within 10 days of its establishment as a separate segregated fund and § 434 by failing to file the required reports with the Commission. However, since the respondent did ultimately register with the Commission, and since the respondent came forward with the information relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter and acted cooperatively with the Commission, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission take no further action, close the file in this matter and send the respondent a letter of admonition (see letter attached as Exhibit 2).

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find reason to believe that Cutter Laboratories Inc. Political Action Committee violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 433 and 434.

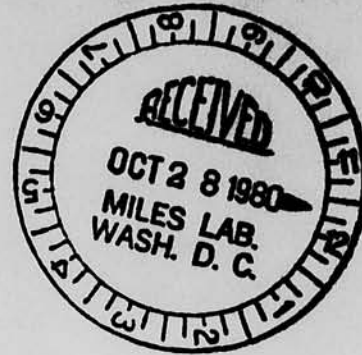
