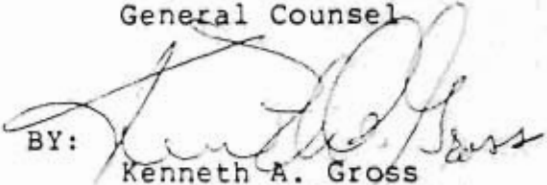

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by a signed, sworn, and notarized complaint by Robert Blaemire. An investigation was conducted, and reason to believe was found that the Mid-America Conservative Political Action Committee ("Respondent") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) by failing to file its semi-annual reports as required.

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondent, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondent, and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C.

§ 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondent has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondent enters voluntarily into this Agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent is a registered unauthorized political committee.

2. That as an unauthorized committee, respondent is required to file either quarterly reports in a calendar year in which a regularly scheduled general election is held or in any other calendar year, a report concerning the period beginning January 1 and ending June 30 and a report concerning the period beginning July 1 and ending December 31.

V. That in 1981, a non-election year, respondent failed to file either of its semi-annual reports of receipts and expenditures in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv).

VI. Respondent will pay a civil penalty to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. Respondent agrees that it shall not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

VIII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

X. Respondent shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

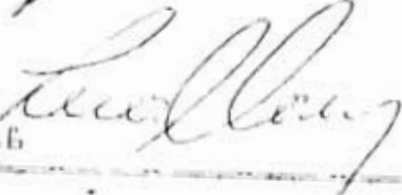

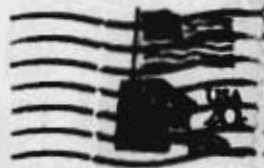

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, the Commission, on March , 1982, determined that there is reason to believe that your committee has violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv), a provision of the Act.

Specifically, it appears that you failed to file the semi-annual reports due from all unauthorized committees in a non-election year.

As of this date, we have received no written response from you in connection with this matter. The Office of General Counsel would like to settle this matter through conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause. However in the absence of any information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee, the Office of General Counsel must proceed to the next compliance stage as noted on page 2, paragraph 2 of the enclosed procedures.

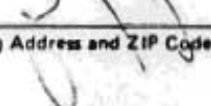

COMPLAINT

1) The Mid-America Conservative Political Action Committee (MACPAC) filed its statement of organization with the Commission on February 3, 1981 as an "unauthorized committee". (see Exhibit A)

2) The MACPAC states in its mailing that it is an independent committee with the express intention of making independent expenditures opposed to the reelection of certain Members of Congress. (see Exhibit B)

3) The Commission records reveal no semi-annual report on file from the MACPAC as required by 11CFR 104.5(c)(2)(i)(A).

4) Commission regulations require the filing of non-election year reports by all unauthorized committees for the period of January 1-June 30 of the non-election year and July 1-December 31 of the non-election year. 11CFR 104.5(c)(a)(i)(A) states; "Each political committee which is not the authorized committee of a candidate shall file either: election year and non-election year reports as prescribed at 11CFR 104.5(c)(1) and (2); or monthly

reports as prescribed at 11CFR 104.5(c)(3)."

5) Thus, the Mid-America Conservative Political Action Committee violated the Act by failing to file reports as required by the regulations, for the period of January 1-June 30, 1981.

Wherefore, I hereby request that the Commission initiate a compliance matter on this Complaint pursuant to 2USC Sec.437g and 11CFR Part III.

Dear Conservative Friend,

You are a very important person!!!! You are important because of your proven dedication to preserving our God-given freedom.

Now, you are a very important person because you have the opportunity to help remove from Congress some of the very worst liberals.

We at MACPAC have just targeted two more very extreme liberals for defeat next year---- Congressmen Robert Kastenmeier of Wisconsin and Tom Daschle of South Dakota.

The 1982 race will be between long-time liberal Rep. Tom Daschle, whom we have already described, and freshman Rep. Clint Roberts, a strong conservative. Because Daschle has had many years to build himself up, the Republican Congressional

Campaign Committee has called the conservative Roberts the most vulnerable Republican Congressman in the nation!!!!

There is something else which makes Roberts vulnerable also. Daschle is the last of the McGovernite major office-holders in South Dakota. He is a personal friend and long-time ally of McGovern and liberal groups all over America are going to work very hard to keep him in office.

This means the labor union bosses and left-wing groups like the new one McGovern has organized will provide Daschle with a huge warchest and a lot of campaign help.

IT ALSO MEANS WE HAVE TO START EARLIER AND WORK EVEN HARDER OURSELVES!!!!

South Dakota voters threw McGovern out of office when they learned the truth about how he really voted.

They will throw Daschle out too--- if they learn the truth about him. Daschle knows this so he has started the old liberal trick of voting one way in Washington and talking the opposite at home.

We have to go to work right now to keep Roberts in office and defeat the McGovernite Daschle!!!! If we can do this, we will strike a mighty blow for freedom right under the nose of George McGovern!!!!

We have commitments from major conservative and pro-family leaders to work with us in a concerted effort to remove Kastenmeier and Daschle.

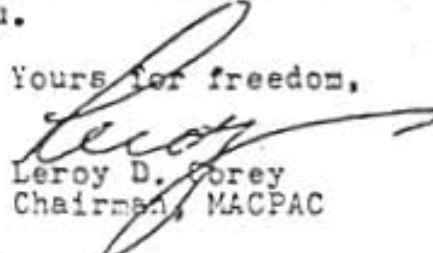

Last year, I managed the two independent efforts in Iowa (NCPAC and Christian Voice/ECF) against our ultra-liberal Senator John Culver.

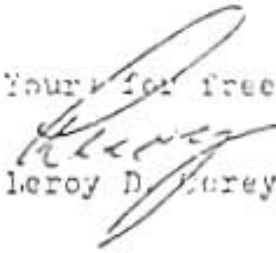

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by sending a letter of representation stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

1) The Mid-America Conservative Political Action Committee (MACPAC) filed its statement of organization with the Commission on February 3, 1981 as an "unauthorized committee". (see Exhibit A)

2) The MACPAC states in its mailing that it is an independent committee with the express intention of making independent expenditures opposed to the reelection of certain Members of Congress. (see Exhibit B)

3) The Commission records reveal no semi-annual report on file from the MACPAC as required by 11CFR 104.5(c)(2)(1)(A).

4) Commission regulations require the filing of non-election year reports by all unauthorized committees for the period of January 1-June 30 of the non-election year and July 1-December 31 of the non-election year. 11CFR 104.5(c)(a)(i)(A) states: "Each political committee which is not the authorized committee of a candidate shall file either: election year and non-election year reports as prescribed at 11CFR 104.5(c)(1) and (2); or monthly

reports as prescribed at 11CFR 104.5(c)(3)."

5) Thus, the Mid-America Conservative Political Action Committee violated the Act by failing to file reports as required by the regulations, for the period of January 1-June 30, 1981.

Wherefore, I hereby request that the Commission initiate a compliance matter on this Complaint pursuant to 2USC Sec.437g and 11CFR Part III.

We have commitments from major conservative and pro-family leaders to work with us in a concerted effort to remove Kastenmeier and Daschle.

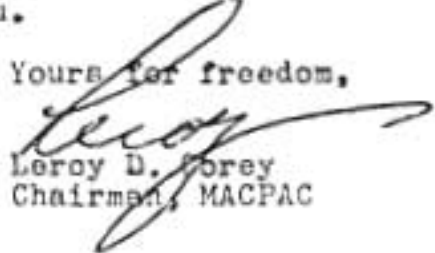

Midwesterners are mostly conservative and they will not usually send liberals to Congress---if they know what they are!!

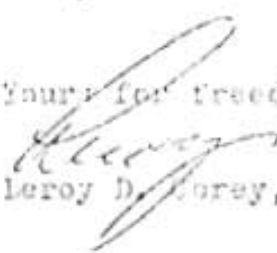

COMPLAINT

1) The Mid-America Conservative Political Action Committee (MACPAC) filed its statement of organization with the Commission on February 3, 1981 as an "unauthorized committee". (see Exhibit A)

2) The MACPAC states in its mailing that it is an independent committee with the express intention of making independent expenditures opposed to the reelection of certain Members of Congress. (see Exhibit B)

3) The Commission records reveal no semi-annual report on file from the MACPAC as required by 11CFR 104.5(c)(2)(i)(A).

4) Commission regulations require the filing of non-election year reports by all unauthorized committees for the period of January 1-June 30 of the non-election year and July 1-December 31 of the non-election year. 11CFR 104.5(c)(a)(i)(A) states: "Each political committee which is not the authorized committee of a candidate shall file either: election year and non-election year reports as prescribed at 11CFR 104.5(c)(1) and (2); or monthly

reports as prescribed at 11CFR 104.5(c)(3)."

5) Thus, the Mid-America Conservative Political Action Committee violated the Act by failing to file reports as required by the regulations, for the period of January 1-June 30, 1981.

Wherefore, I hereby request that the Commission initiate a compliance matter on this Complaint pursuant to 2USC Sec.437g and 11CFR Part III.
