GENERATION OF MATTER

During a normal review of the June, 1980 report filed by the Political Action Committee of the American Hospital Association ("PAC"), the Reports Analysis Division discovered that a corporation, the American Hospital Association ("AHA") loaned the PAC \$4,000 for a period of six days during June, 1980. On December 17, 1981, the Commission voted to make this matter a MUR.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

2 U.S.C. § 441b prohibits any political committee from receiving any contribution from a corporation. The term "contribution" includes any loan as stated in 2 U.S.C. § 431(8)(A).

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

The June 30, 1980 report disclosed the \$4,000 loan from AHA and the repayment six days later and stated that the loan was for "temporary working capital during the assistant treasurer's

absence". The PAC disclosed approximately \$60,000 cash on hand (in its savings account) during the period. Upon determining that the loan was prohibited and the return of the assistant treasurer, the PAC immediately returned the funds to AHA.

During the six days that the loan was outstanding, the PAC made 13 expenditures to Federal candidates totaling \$3,425. Total expenditures during the month totaled \$9,381, and total expenditures during 1980 totaled \$139,956.

Based on information disclosed by the PAC, it is clear that the PAC received a prohibited contribution from AHA during June, 1980. However, after considering the facts that (1) the loan was repaid as soon as the PAC realized the loan was prohibited - six days later; (2) the transaction was fully disclosed prior to Commission notification; (3) the PAC had approximately \$60,000 cash on hand during the period, an amount well over the \$4,000 loaned; and (4) the expenditures made during the six day period comprised approximately 2% of the expenditures made during the year. Thus, we recommend that the Commission find reason to believe that a prohibited contribution was made and received; however, for the reasons discussed, no further action should be taken.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find reason to believe that the Political Action Committee of the American Hospital Association violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

2. Take no further action and close the file.
3. Approve attached letter.

The file will be made part of the public record within 30 days. Should you wish to submit any materials to appear on the public record, please do so within 10 days.

The Commission reminds you that receiving a contribution from a corporation nevertheless appears to be a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b and you should take immediate steps to insure that this activity does not occur in the future.

The General Counsel's Factual and Legal Analysis which formed a basis for the Commission's finding is attached for your information.

The following are statements made by the PAC officials or are contained in the PAC's report for the month of June, 1980:

- The PAC had approximately \$60,000 cash on hand during the period (Att. 3)
- The Association (a corporation) loaned the PAC \$4,000 on June 3 (Att. 2)
- The reports show 13 expenditures (contributions) to Federal candidates on June 3 totaling \$3425 (Att. 3)
- The loan was repaid June 9 (Att. 2)
- The PAC said that the money was needed for operating expenses while the Assistant Treasurer was out of town (Att. 2 & 6)
- The reports do not reveal any disbursements for operating expenditures (Att. 3)

Based on the above there are two possibilities, at least, which may be inferred. First, because the PAC could not issue checks due to the absence of the Assistant Treasurer, the Association issued checks directly to the candidates. A cursory check of some of the candidates' reports show receipt from the PAC and not the Association. Was there a covering letter attached to the Association's check?

Second, the Association could have deposited funds into a separate or personal account.

Thus, there is a possibility of direct corporate contributions and not just a simple loan that was refunded once the error was discovered. Does the PAC consider contributions as operating expenses and why was it so necessary to make so many contributions on June 3?

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of your August Monthly Report. The review raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act. An itemization of these areas follows:

- The Commission notes that on your July Monthly Report (6/1/80-6/31/80) a prohibited contribution received by your committee from the American Hospital Association (2 U.S.C. 441b) in the form of a \$4,000 loan was refunded in full six (6) days after receipt. Although the Commission may take legal steps concerning the acceptance of that contribution, your refund of the \$4,000 loan will be taken into consideration.
- The Detailed Summary Page of your July Monthly Report disclosed a calendar year to date total of \$4,000 in loan repayments (Line 24, Column B). However, this report shows both Lines 13 and 24, Column B, blank and the \$4,000 transaction is not included in the summary of total receipts nor total disbursements. This error is then carried over onto the Summary Page on Lines 6(c), 6(d), and 7, Column B. This error should be corrected on all subsequent reports.

An amendment to your original report correcting the above problems should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. If you need assistance, please feel

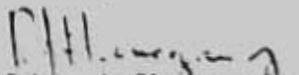

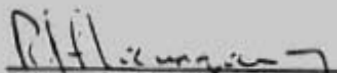

On June 3, 1980, the Political Action Committee of the AHA received a temporary loan from the American Hospital Association in the amount of \$4,000.00. This loan was made in order to provide funds for the PAC of AHA to meet working capital needs during the absence of the PAC's assistant treasurer. At the time of this loan, funds in excess of the \$4,000.00 were present in the PAC of AHA's savings account at the First Security Bank of Chicago, but were inaccessible to the PAC because of the assistant treasurer's absence. Upon determining that such a loan was not allowable under the regulations of the FEC and the return of the assistant treasurer, the PAC of AHA immediately returned said funds to the American Hospital Association. This was done on June 9, 1980, only 6 days after the funds were received.

At that time, the PAC of AHA felt that its actions were entirely in good faith. As evidence of this we offer our swift return of the loaned funds, and our full disclosure of this transaction on the June 30, 1980 FEC report. All subsequent monthly reports have now been corrected to show this transaction in its proper format.

The June 30, 1980 report filed by the Political Action Committee of the American Hospital association ("PAC") revealed receipt of a \$4,000 loan from a corporation, the American Hospital Association ("AHA"). 2 U.S.C. § 441b prohibits a political committee from receiving contributions (including loans) from any corporation.

The PAC's June 30, 1980 monthly report, and the Treasurer of the PAC, Robert J. Flanagan, have disclosed that the PAC received a \$4,000 loan from a corporation, the American Hospital Association, for a period of six days during June, 1980. The loan was made by AHA for temporary working capital for the PAC during the assistant treasurer's absence. Therefore, the General Counsel recommends that the Commission find reason to believe that the Political Action Committee of the American Hospital Association violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b.

GENERATION OF MATTER

During a normal review of the June, 1980 report filed by the Political Action Committee of the American Hospital Association ("PAC"), the Reports Analysis Division discovered that a corporation, the American Hospital Association ("AHA") loaned the PAC \$4,000 for a period of six days during June, 1980. On December 17, 1981, the Commission voted to make this matter a MUR.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

2 U.S.C. § 441b prohibits any political committee from receiving any contribution from a corporation. The term "contribution" includes any loan as stated in 2 U.S.C. § 431(8)(A).

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

The June 30, 1980 report disclosed the \$4,000 loan from AHA and the repayment six days later and stated that the loan was for "temporary working capital during the assistant treasurer's

absence". The PAC disclosed approximately \$60,000 cash on hand (in its savings account) during the period. Upon determining that the loan was prohibited and the return of the assistant treasurer, the PAC immediately returned the funds to AHA.

During the six days that the loan was outstanding, the PAC made 13 expenditures to Federal candidates totaling \$3,425. Total expenditures during the month totaled \$9,381, and total expenditures during 1980 totaled \$139,956.

Based on information disclosed by the PAC, it is clear that the PAC received a prohibited contribution from AHA during June, 1980. However, after considering the facts that (1) the loan was repaid as soon as the PAC realized the loan was prohibited - six days later; (2) the transaction was fully disclosed prior to Commission notification; (3) the PAC had approximately \$60,000 cash on hand during the period, an amount well over the \$4,000 loaned; and (4) the expenditures made during the six day period comprised approximately 2% of the expenditures made during the year. Thus, we recommend that the Commission find reason to believe that a prohibited contribution was made and received; however, for the reasons discussed, no further action should be taken.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find reason to believe that the Political Action Committee of the American Hospital Association violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

2. Take no further action and close the file.
3. Approve attached letter.

The following are statements made by the PAC officials or are contained in the PAC's report for the month of June, 1980:

- The PAC had approximately \$60,000 cash on hand during the period (Att. 3)
- The Association (a corporation) loaned the PAC \$4,000 on June 3 (Att. 2)
- The reports show 13 expenditures (contributions) to Federal candidates on June 3 totaling \$3425 (Att. 3)
- The loan was repaid June 9 (Att. 2)
- The PAC said that the money was needed for operating expenses while the Assistant Treasurer was out of town (Att. 2 & 6)
- The reports do not reveal any disbursements for operating expenditures (Att. 3)

Based on the above there are two possibilities, at least, which may be inferred. First, because the PAC could not issue checks due to the absence of the Assistant Treasurer, the Association issued checks directly to the candidates. A cursory check of some of the candidates' reports show receipt from the PAC and not the Association. Was there a covering letter attached to the Association's check?

Second, the Association could have deposited funds into a separate or personal account.

Thus, there is a possibility of direct corporate contributions and not just a simple loan that was refunded once the error was discovered. Does the PAC consider contributions as operating expenses and why was it so necessary to make so many contributions on June 3?

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of your August Monthly Report. The review raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act. An itemization of these areas follows:

-The Commission notes that on your July Monthly Report (6/1/80-6/31/80) a prohibited contribution received by your committee from the American Hospital Association (2 U.S.C. 441b) in the form of a \$4,000 loan was refunded in full six (6) days after receipt. Although the Commission may take legal steps concerning the acceptance of that contribution, your refund of the \$4,000 loan will be taken into consideration.

-The Detailed Summary Page of your July Monthly Report disclosed a calendar year to date total of \$4,000 in loan repayments (Line 24, Column B). However, this report shows both Lines 13 and 24, Column B, blank and the \$4,000 transaction is not included in the summary of total receipts nor total disbursements. This error is then carried over onto the Summary Page on Lines 6(c), 6(d), and 7, Column B. This error should be corrected on all subsequent reports.

An amendment to your original report correcting the above problems should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. If you need assistance, please feel

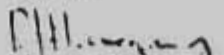

At the time of this loan, funds in excess of the \$4,000.00 were present in the PAC of AHA's savings account at the First Security Bank of Chicago, but were inaccessible to the PAC because of the assistant treasurer's absence. Upon determining that such a loan was not allowable under the regulations of the FEC and the return of the assistant treasurer, the PAC of AHA immediately returned said funds to the American Hospital Association. The following are statements made by the PAC officials or are contained in the PAC's report for the month of June, 1980:

- The PAC had approximately \$60,000 cash on hand during the period (Att. 3)
- The Association (a corporation) loaned the PAC \$4,000 on June 3 (Att. 2)
- The reports show 13 expenditures (contributions) to Federal candidates on June 3 totaling \$3425 (Att. 3)
- The loan was repaid June 9 (Att. 2)
- The PAC said that the money was needed for operating expenses while the Assistant Treasurer was out of town (Att. 2 & 6)
- The reports do not reveal any disbursements for operating expenditures (Att. 3)

Based on the above there are two possibilities, at least, which may be inferred. First, because the PAC could not issue checks due to the absence of the Assistant Treasurer, the Association issued checks directly to the candidates. A cursory check of some of the candidates' reports show receipt from the PAC and not the Association. Was there a covering letter attached to the Association's check?

Second, the Association could have deposited funds into a separate or personal account.

Thus, there is a possibility of direct corporate contributions and not just a simple loan that was refunded once the error was discovered. Does the PAC consider contributions as operating expenses and why was it so necessary to make so many contributions on June 3?

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of your August Monthly Report. The review raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act. An itemization of these areas follows:

- The Commission notes that on your July Monthly Report (6/1/80-6/31/80) a prohibited contribution received by your committee from the American Hospital Association (2 U.S.C. 441b) in the form of a \$4,000 loan was refunded in full six (6) days after receipt. Although the Commission may take legal steps concerning the acceptance of that contribution, your refund of the \$4,000 loan will be taken into consideration.
- The Detailed Summary Page of your July Monthly Report disclosed a calendar year to date total of \$4,000 in loan repayments (Line 24, Column P). However, this report shows both Lines 13 and 24, Column P, blank and the \$4,000 transaction is not included in the summary of total receipts nor total disbursements. This error is then carried over onto the Summary Page on Lines 6(c), 6(d), and 7, Column P. This error should be corrected on all subsequent reports.

-The Detailed Summary Page of your July Monthly Report disclosed a calendar year to date total of \$4,000 in loan repayments (Line 24, Column P). However, this report shows both Lines 13 and 24, Column P, blank and the \$4,000 transaction is not included in the summary of total receipts nor total disbursements. This error is then carried over onto the Summary Page on Lines 6(c), 6(d), and 7, Column P. This error should be corrected on all subsequent reports.

An amendment to your original report correcting the above problems should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. If you need assistance, please feel

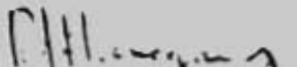

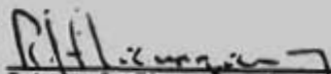

On June 3, 1980, the Political Action Committee of the AHA received a temporary loan from the American Hospital Association in the amount of \$4,000.00. This loan was made in order to provide funds for the PAC of AHA to meet working capital needs during the absence of the PAC's assistant treasurer. At the time of this loan, funds in excess of the \$4,000.00 were present in the PAC of AHA's savings account at the First Security Bank of Chicago, but were inaccessible to the PAC because of the assistant treasurer's absence. Upon determining that such a loan was not allowable under the regulations of the FEC and the return of the assistant treasurer, the PAC of AHA immediately returned said funds to the American Hospital Association. This was done on June 9, 1980, only 6 days after the funds were received.

At that time, the PAC of AHA felt that its actions were entirely in good faith. As evidence of this we offer our swift return of the loaned funds, and our full disclosure of this transaction on the June 30, 1980 FEC report. All subsequent monthly reports have now been corrected to show this transaction in its proper format.
