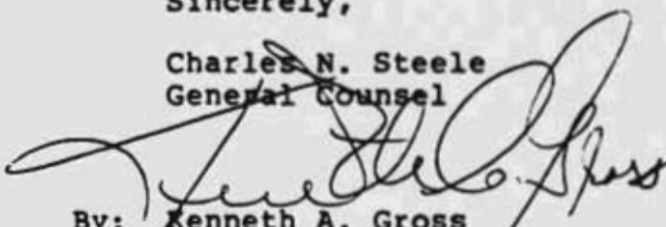

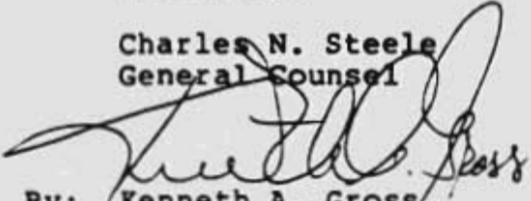

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

Complainant alleged that none of the nine Respondent
Committees filed the 1981 Year End Report nor completed line 6 of
their statements of organization which asks for connected
organizations and/or affiliated committees.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

On August 21, 1981, the above-mentioned political committees
filed statements of organization with the Commission. Each
listed an address in Alexandria, Virginia 22313 with P.O. Box
numbers ranging between 1753 and 1861. Salvatore J. Guzzetta

was listed as the Executive Director and Custodian of Records for each of these committees. In addition, Kathleen Daugherty, who was listed as the Treasurer of the American Conservative Alliance PAC, was also listed as the Assistant Treasurer for all the other committees.

It should be noted that prior to the filing of the instant complaint, the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) had communicated with the named respondents. As none of the committees filled in line 6 of the statement of organization, a notice was sent to each of these committees by RAD on October 21, 1981 requesting more information regarding connected organizations and/or affiliated committees. As no response was received, a second letter was sent on November 20, 1981. No written response was received.

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 433(b)(2), the statement of organization of a political committee shall include the name, address, relationship, and type of any connected organization or affiliated committee. Pursuant to 11 C.F.R. § 100.5, all political committees established by the same person or group of persons are affiliated. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv), all political committees other than authorized committees of a candidate shall file, in a non-election year, a report covering the period beginning July 1 and ending December 31, which shall be filed no later than January 31 of the following calendar year.

In response to notification of the complaint, Mr. Guzzetta replied that his was a business relationship with each of the committees in question and that they were not affiliated. See Attachment 1. In addition, he explained that since the committees had not had any activity, he thought a report was not required. Enclosed with his letter were 1981 Year End Reports for all of the committees, all disclosing no activity. On April 1, 1982, Mr. Guzzetta furnished sample copies of the contracts between his firm, Campaign Services of America, Inc. and the committees. See Attachment 2. In addition, he asked that the Year End Reports previously filed be designated as Termination Reports. He explained over the phone that the committees have had no activity nor is there any planned. He further stated that he does not know how to get in touch with many of the treasurers but that he would go ahead and file the reports.

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 431(4)(A), the term "political committee" means any committee, club, association, or other group of persons which receives contributions aggregating in excess of \$1,000 during a calendar year or which makes expenditures aggregating in excess of \$1,000 during a calendar year.

As none of the committees met the definition of a political committee, they were not required to register and report with the Commission. In light of this fact, the General Counsel

recommends that the Commission find no reason to believe that the respondents violated the Act.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find no reason to believe that the American Freedom Alliance PAC, American Conservative Alliance PAC, National Freedom Foundation PAC, Moderate Americans' Coalition PAC, Business, Industry, Commerce PAC, American Senior Citizens' PAC, The Real Majority PAC, National Women's Alliance PAC and National Taxpayers' and Consumers' PAC violated the Act.
2. Close the file.
3. Approve the attached letters.

Dear Mr. Gross,

This letter is in response to your notification of a complaint filed regarding the above PACs on March 9, 1982 and your letter of March 16, 1982.

Please be advised that I had discussed this matter of possible affiliation with Mr. Roberto Garcia of your office in November 1981. After considerable analysis of this situation, his conclusion was that these PACs were not affiliated per the definition of Section 100.5 (G)(2)(1)(E) of the Commission's regulations. As FEC form 1, Statement of Organization, question 6 does not require an answer unless there is an affiliation one is not necessary and therefore not attached. In summary of my previous conversation with Mr. Garcia, the individual Treasurers were simply planning to use my facilities and myself to do fund raising and administration for their PACs. This arrangement does not appear to fall within the definition of the previous references to sections of the Committee's regulations.

As to the matter of our failure to file the year-end report, please be advised that this was simply a misunderstanding of our obligations. Since these PACs did not file until after mid-year 1981 and there was no activity of any kind during that year, it was our impression that the first report would not be due

This letter is in response to your notification of a complaint filed regarding the above PACs on March 9, 1982 and your letter of March 16, 1982.

Please be advised that I had discussed this matter of possible affiliation with Mr. Roberto Garcia of your office in November 1981. After considerable analysis of this situation, his conclusion was that these PACs were not affiliated per the definition of Section 100.5 (G)(2)(i)(E) of the Commission's regulations. As FEC form 1, Statement of Organization, question 6 does not require an answer unless there is an affiliation one is not necessary and therefore not attached. In summary of my previous conversation with Mr. Garcia, the individual Treasurers were simply planning to use my facilities and myself to do fund raising and administration for their PACs. This arrangement does not appear to fall within the definition of the previous references to sections of the Committee's regulations.

As to the matter of our failure to file the year-end report, please be advised that this was simply a misunderstanding of our obligations. Since these PACs did not file until after mid-year 1981 and there was no activity of any kind during that year, it was our impression that the first report would not be due
