I received a copy of your letter dated April 16, 1982 in the regular mailed delivered to the post office box address on May 16, 1982.

As you know, Mr. Perry originally filed a complaint in early February of this year. At the time you sent me a copy of his complaint and a copy of your return letter to him. Upon receipt of your letter I responded that the end of year filing had been made and asked if the Commission was in receipt of it. When you responded that the information was not in the files I sent you a copy of the report and directed a second copy directly to the Commission.

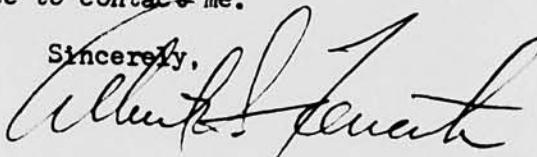
I had not been sending these reports certified or registered but will do so in the future as I said in my last letter to you.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

The complainant alleges that Alamo Political Action Committee ("Alamo PAC") failed to file its 1981 Year-End Report due January 31, 1982 in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(iv) (Attachment I).

A copy of the complaint was forwarded to Albert O. Forrester, treasurer of Alamo PAC, on April 16, 1982. Recently, the letter to Mr. Forrester enclosing a copy of the complaint was returned to the Commission marked "UNCLAIMED." The letter was

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re-sent "Certified Mail-Return Receipt Requested" and a copy sent through the regular mail.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

At the time the complaint was filed, Alamo PAC had not filed its 1981 Year-End Report (See "C" Index dated April 16, 1982 - Attachment II). However, the respondent had submitted a letter to the Commission on February 22, 1982 which stated that the year-end report was mailed to the Commission on January 29, 1982 and that a copy would be provided if necessary (See Attachment III). The February 22, 1982 letter from Mr. Forrester was submitted in response to his receipt of a copy of the improper complaint filed by Mr. Perry on February 9, 1982 and a copy of the improper complaint letter sent to Mr. Perry on February 17, 1982 (See Attachment IV).

On April 28, 1982, Mr. Forrester submitted a copy of the 1981 Year-End Report for Alamo PAC dated January 29, 1982 to the Reports Analysis Division (Attachment V). The report was filed in response to a notice from the Reports Analysis Division dated April 9, 1982 which noted that the year-end report had not been filed. The cover letter from Forrester dated April 26, 1982 stated that "Beginning with the next report ... I will send the reports only by registered mail which should alleviate this type situation."

As the 1981 Year-End Report has been filed by Alamo PAC, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission find

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reason to believe Alamo PAC violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B)(iv),
take no further action, and close the file.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Find reason to believe Alamo Political Action Committee violated 2 U.S.C. 434(a)(4)(A)(iv).
2. Take no further action against Alamo Political Action Committee.
3. Close the file.
4. Send the attached letters.

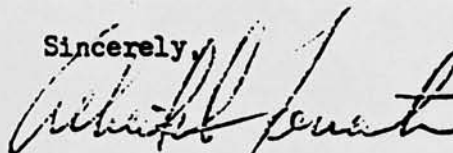
I am in receipt of the letter of complaint from Patrick Perry with Printer's Ink, Inc. and your response of February 17, 1982.

We have received your letter of February 9, 1982 regarding the possibility of a violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

The 1976 amendments to the Act and Commission regulations require that a complaint meet certain specified requirements. Since your letter does not meet these requirements, the Commission can take no action at this time to investigate this matter.

However, if you desire the Commission to look into the matter discussed in your letter of February 9, 1982 to determine if the FECA has been violated, a formal complaint as described in 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) must be filed. Requirements of this section of the law and Commission regulations at 11 C.F.R. § 111.4 which are a prerequisite to Commission action are detailed below:

- (1) A complaint must be in writing. (2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1)).
- (2) Its contents must be sworn to and signed in the presence of a notary public and shall be notarized. (2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1)).
- (3) A formal complaint must contain the full name and address of the person making the complaint. (11 C.F.R. § 111.4).
- (4) A formal complaint should clearly identify as a respondent each person or entity who is alleged to have committed a violation. (11 C.F.R. § 111.4).

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- (5) A formal complaint should identify the source of information upon which the complaint is based. (11 C.F.R. § 111.4).
- (6) A formal complaint should contain a clear and concise recitation of the facts describing the violation of a statute or law over which the Commission has jurisdiction. (11 C.F.R. § 111.4).
- (7) A formal complaint should be accompanied by supporting documentation if known and available to the person making the complaint. (11 C.F.R. § 111.4).

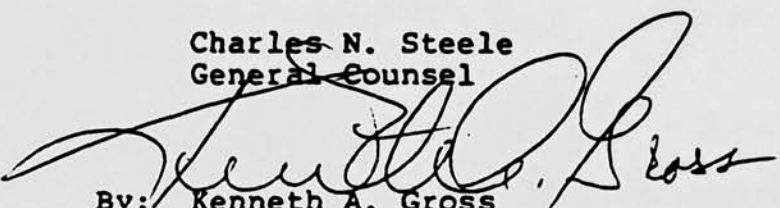
Finally, please include your telephone number, as well as the full names and addresses of all respondents.

Enclosed is a copy of Commission regulations, and your attention is directed to 11 C.F.R. §§ 111.4 through 111.10 that deal with preliminary enforcement procedures. Also, enclosed is a compilation of Federal Election Campaign Laws on which these regulations are promulgated. I trust these materials will be helpful to you should you wish to file a legally sufficient complaint with the Commission. The file regarding this correspondence will remain confidential for a fifteen day time period during which you may file an amended complaint as specified above.
