SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

Complainant alleges that the National Republican Congressional Committee (NRCC) has violated 2 U.S.C. § 439 by failing to file reports with the Secretaries of State of Texas, Florida and California for the years 1978 through 1982. Mr. Halter claims that this failure to report is intentional on the part of Wyatt Stewart, III, Finance Director of the NRCC, in order to keep from becoming public the fact that the NRCC has paid Wyatt Stewart and Associates, Inc. \$422,456.84 over the past year for "professional services". In light of this, and the fact that the NRCC did file reports with other Secretaries of State, Mr. Halter states that the violation of 2 U.S.C. § 439 is knowing and willful.

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FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 439(a)(1), a copy of each report required to be filed by any person under this Act shall be filed by such person with the Secretary of State (or equivalent State officer) of the appropriate state. Under section 439(a)(2), the term "appropriate state" means for statements in connection with the campaign for nomination for election, or election, of a candidate to the office of Representative in Congress, the state in which the candidate seeks election. However, political committees other than authorized committees are only required to file that portion of the report applicable to candidates seeking election in that state. Pursuant to section 439(b)(2), the Secretary of State (or equivalent State officer) must keep such reports for two years after date of receipt.

On November 22, 1983, this office received a response from William H. Schweitzer and Jan W. Baran, counsel for Wyatt A. Stewart, III, and the NRCC in this matter. See Attachment 1. Enclosed with this response was an affidavit from Lawrence J. Halloran, Legal Counsel to the NRCC.

According to Mr. Halloran, it is the policy and practice of the NRCC to send copies of relevant reports of expenditures to appropriate state election officials, including the state officials of Texas, Florida and California. To substantiate this statement, copies of return receipts for copies of reports sent

by the NRCC to those states in both 1980 and 1982 were attached. However, it was stated that the 1978 receipts had been discarded as permitted by 2 U.S.C. § 432(d) which requires records retention of only 3 years after a report is filed.

On December 6, 1982, a staff member contacted the Political Reform Division of the Office of the Secretary of State of California. According to that office, the NRCC filed reports in 1979, 1980 and 1982. No reports were filed in 1981 and their records did not go back to 1978. It should be noted that until the FEC staff member specifically stated that the NRCC was a federal committee, she was told that the NRCC had not filed any reports.

On December 7, 1982, a staff member contacted the Division of Elections of the Department of State of Florida. At first the FEC staff member was told that the NRCC had not filed any reports. However, it was finally determined that the NRCC was listed under the Republican National Committee. Although it was ascertained that the NRCC had filed two reports in 1982, the FEC staff member was informed that there was no record of any reports filed for the years 1978 through 1981.

This office also contacted the Elections Division of the Office of the Secretary of State of Texas. According to their files, the NRCC filed 6 reports in 1978, 1 report in 1980 and 1 report in 1982. When asked for an explanation of why someone would be told that the NRCC had not filed any reports with their

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office, the Texas office staff member stated that perhaps the distinction was not made that this was a federal committee, as they deal with state committees 98% of the time and the records for federal committees are separate from the state committees. In addition, she also noted that there was some confusion as to why the NRCC had only filed one report in both 1980 and 1982 and, therefore, it was thought that possibly the NRCC had not filed all the required reports. However, it was explained by the FEC staff member that the NRCC was only required to file a copy of its report with the Secretary of State of Texas if the report in question disclosed support for a candidate running in Texas.

Based on the following facts, the General Counsel recommends that the Commission find no reason to believe that Wyatt A. Stewart, III, or the NRCC violated the Act. First, it has been verified that the NRCC has filed reports with the Secretaries of State of California, Florida and Texas. Second, the NRCC has provided return receipts for 1980 and 1982 reports sent to the Secretaries of State in question. Third, until certain information was given to the state offices in question, an FEC staff member had been led to believe that the NRCC had not filed reports and, therefore, there is an explanation for the wrong information given the complainant. Fourth, pursuant to the Act, the Secretaries of State (or equivalent state officers) are only

required to keep the reports for 2 years. Therefore, any report filed by the NRCC over 2 years ago may very well not be on their records.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find no reason to believe that Wyatt A. Stewart, III violated the Act.
2. Find no reason to believe that the National Republican Congressional Committee violated the Act.
3. Approve the attached letters.
4. Close the file.

This office represents the National Republican Congressional Committee ("NRCC") and Mr. Wyatt A. Stewart, III (designations of counsel enclosed). NRCC and Mr. Stewart were notified by you by letters dated November 3, 1982 that they were the subjects of an undated complaint filed by Mr. Ernest Halter, Jr., President of American International Demographic Services, Inc. This proceeding has been designated by you as Matter Under Review ("MUR") 1504.

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) and 11 C.F.P. § 111.6 we submit this response on behalf of NRCC and Mr. Stewart. For the reasons stated below, the complaint by Mr. Halter is groundless. The Federal Election Commission ("FEC") should find no reason to believe that either NRCC or Mr. Stewart violated the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended ("Act").

FACTS

NRCC is a Republican party organization that supports the election of Republican candidates for the United States House of Representatives. Mr. Stewart is Finance Director of NRCC. Mr. Halter alleges in his complaint that NRCC and Mr. Stewart knowingly and willfully failed to file reports required by section 439 of the Act in the states of Texas, Florida and California for the years 1978 through 1982. Complaint paragraphs 5, 10 and 11. The allegation is based on "information" from three named indi-

viduals who purportedly are "in the Secretary of State's Office in each of the respective states." Complaint paragraph 5. The complainant does not indicate the nature of this "information" or how it was obtained. No statements or affidavits from the individuals accompanied the complaint.

It is the policy and practice of the NRCC to send copies of relevant reports of expenditures to appropriate state election officials. Affidavit of Lawrence J. Halloran, NRCC Legal Counsel at ¶ 4 (hereafter "Halloran Aff."). NRCC maintains certain records including receipts for copies of reports sent by NRCC to the appropriate state election officials in Texas, Florida and California on October 22, 1982 and October 20, 1980. Halloran Aff. at ¶¶ 5 & 6, copies of receipts attached as Exhibit A. NRCC no longer maintains similar records for 1978. Records from that time have been discarded in accordance with NRCC's records retention policy and as permitted by the Act, 2 U.S.C. § 432(d), and FEC regulations, 11 C.F.R. §§ 102.9(c) and 104.14(b)(3). Id.

DISCUSSION

Section 439 states that a copy of each report required under the Act be filed with certain officials "of the appropriate State." 2 U.S.C. § 439(a)(1). "Appropriate State" with respect to reports by committees like NRCC means "that State in which an expenditure is made in connection with the campaign of a candidate" for the House. 11 C.F.R. § 108.3. "Only that portion of the report applicable to candidates seeking election in that state" must be filed by NRCC. Id.; 2 U.S.C. § 439(a)(2)(B).

Attached to Mr. Halloran's affidavit are copies of the postal receipts regarding NRCC reports sent to Texas, Florida and California in 1980 and 1982. These receipts controvert Mr. Halter's unsupported allegation that NRCC failed to file copies of reports in those states. It is NRCC's policy and practice to file copies of relevant reports in those states and other appropriate states. Halloran Aff. at ¶ 4.

NRCC has no first hand knowledge of records maintained by the Secretaries of State in Texas, Florida or California. The receipts constitute prima facie proof that reports were in fact sent. We note, however, that the Act and FEC regulations require state officials to preserve such records "for two years after their date of receipt." 2

U.S.C. § 439(b)(2); 11 C.F.P. § 108.6(b). Therefore, copies of NRCC reports received by these officials prior to November 1980 already may have been discarded.

As the Commission knows, Mr. Halter himself is the subject of a separate complaint filed by NRCC on September 22, 1982. In that complaint, NRCC provided evidence that Mr. Halter and others had obtained contributor names and addresses from NRCC reports filed pursuant to the Act and used that information for solicitation and commercial purposes in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 438(a)(4). The instant complaint in MUR 1504 ostensibly is a vindictive act by Mr. Halter in response to NRCC's complaint.

The admission by Mr. Halter that he has undertaken efforts to obtain NRCC reports in various states further implicates him in the illegal conduct of which NRCC has already complained. By all appearances, Mr. Halter and his company (which rents, sells and brokers lists for direct mail commercial use) are actively seeking NRCC contributor data in state offices presumably to advance their unlawful activities. We respectfully request that these admissions be taken into account by the FEC at such appropriate time when it acts on NRCC's complaint.

CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above the FEC should find no reason to believe that NRCC or Mr. Stewart violated the Act.

Lawrence J. Halloran for his Affidavit deposes and says:

1. I have personal knowledge of the facts contained herein and am competent to testify thereto.

2. I am employed by the National Republican Congressional Committee ("NRCC") in the capacity of Legal Counsel and have been so employed since 1981.

3. I have read the complaint filed by Mr. Ernest Falter, Jr. with the Federal Election Commission which has been designated Matter Under Review ("MUR") 1504.

4. It is the policy and practice of NRCC to file copies of relevant FEC reports of NRCC expenditures with appropriate state election officials.

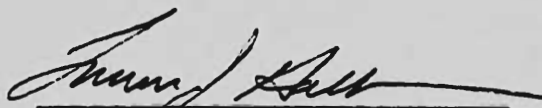
5. NRCC maintains certain records as required by the Federal Election Campaign Act ("Act"). Among these records are return receipts for copies of relevant NRCC reports sent to appropriate state election officials by certified mail.

(See Affidavit attached hereto as Exhibit A.)

4. That upon information and belief, Wyatt A. Stewart, III, has been designated by the treasurer of the NRCC as agent for the purpose of filing reports required by 2 USC 431 et seq.

5. That upon information and belief, the NRCC has not filed reports with the Secretaries of State of the States of Texas, Florida and California for the years 1978 through 1982 as required by 2 USC 439. This information comes from William Tribble in Texas, Dorothy Glisson in Florida and Carl Kasmire in California in the Secretary of States Office in each of the respective states.

6. That Wyatt. A. Stewart, III, and the NRCC filed all reports required to be filed at the Federal Election Commission or in several other states which Complainant has checked and thus had actual knowledge of the filing requirements imposed upon them by 2 USC 439.

7. That Wyatt A. Stewart, III, has formed a corporation by the name of Wyatt Stewart and Associates, Inc., that is engaged in the direct mail business with the NRCC and others. A copy of The Articles of Incorporation are attached hereto as Exhibit B.

8. That in addition, Wyatt A. Stewart, III or Wyatt Stewart and Associates, Inc. receives financial benefit from the sale or rental of Republican contributor lists by other corporations or entities. 9. That from September, 1981, to October, 1982, Wyatt Stewart and Associates, Inc. was paid a total of \$422,456.84 by the NRCC. Attached hereto as Exhibit C are FEC filings reflecting these amounts.

10. That the failure to file the report as required by 2 USC 439 is intentional and part of a design on the part of Wyatt A. Stewart, III to keep this information from becoming public and available to competitors in that no reports are filed by the respondents in any state where such information would be readily available to the public.

11. That the failure of Wyatt A. Stewart, III, and the NRCC to file the reports required by 2 USC 439 was therefore knowing and willful.

WHEREFORE, your Complainant requests that the Federal Election Commission investigate this matter and take all steps necessary to compel compliance with the law and further that this matter be referred to the Attorney General of the United States of America for criminal prosecution pursuant to 2 USC 437(9).

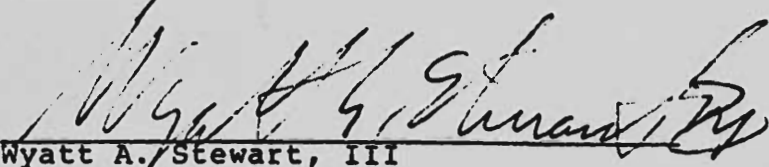
3. On August 16, 1982 a letter from the American Legislative Exchange Council to a fictitious contributor to the NRCC came to my attention.

Mr. Halter also admitted that, after compiling the list, he entered into an agreement whereby Mr. Michael Cohen was to be exclusive manager of the list. Mr. Halter explained that Mr. Cohen, of Working Name, INC., then entered into a commercial transaction by renting the list to various organizations, PAC's, non-profit groups, and party committees. Mr. Halter admitted that Mr. Cohen indicated he was going to rent the list to various groups with the understanding that the people on the list would then be solicited for various purposes, including requests for contributions.

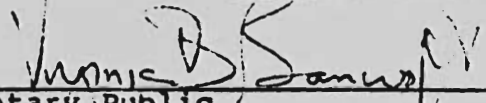

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

WYATT STEWART & ASSOCIATES, INC.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT:

FIRST: The undersigned, being at least eighteen years of age, hereby forms a Close corporation under Title 4 of the Corporations and Associations Article of the Annotated Code of the State of Maryland.

SECOND: The name of the corporation (hereinafter called the "Corporation") is:

WYATT STEWART & ASSOCIATES, INC.

THIRD: The Corporation shall be a close corporation as authorized by said Title 4.

FOURTH: The purpose for which the corporation is formed is to carry on any business not contrary to the Public General Laws of the State of Maryland and to have and exercise all of the powers conferred upon corporations formed thereunder, including, but not limited to, the following:

To buy, create, acquire, own, operate, manage, invest in and generally engage in and conduct any and all branches and phases of the business of advertising, public relations, sales, promotion, marketing, publishing, fund raising, research and consulting, and to create, produce, undertake and perform projects and programs of all kinds in connection therewith.

To perform services of all kinds for its own account and/or for or on behalf of persons, corporations, firms, partnerships, associations, individuals and entities of every description in connection with the advertisement, use, consumption, sale, distribution, marketing, promotion, production and development of products, commodities, property (real, personal or mixed), services and businesses generally.

To employ, use and utilize advertising, promotional and communication media, including direct mail order and methods and techniques of all kinds and in any combination, and to conduct the business of the corporation as principle or agent, on commission or by contract, and in any other capacity or manner, and to undertake

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such other businesses and activities not specified herein as the corporation may from time to time choose to undertake.

To conduct the business of an operating, trading, leasing, holding and/or investment corporation, or otherwise, as principal, agent, representative, manager or in any other capacity.

The corporation shall have the power to do any and all acts and things necessary or useful to its business and purposes, and shall have the general, specific and incidental powers and privileges granted to it by statute, including:

To enter into and perform contracts; to acquire and exploit patents, trademarks, rights of all kinds and related and other interests; to acquire, use, deal in and with, encumber and dispose of real and personal property without limitation, including obligations and securities; to borrow and lend money for its corporate purposes; to invest and reinvest its funds, and to take, hold and deal with real and personal property as security for the payment of funds loaned or invested or otherwise; to vary any investment or employment of capital of the corporation from time to time; to create or participate with other corporations and entities for the performance of all undertakings as partner, joint venturer, or otherwise, and to share or delegate control therewith or thereto.

To pay pensions and establish and carry out pension, profit sharing, stock option, stock purchase, stock bonus, retirement, benefit, incentive or commission plans, trusts and provisions for any or all of its directors, officers and employees and for any or all of the directors, officers and employees of its subsidiaries; and to provide insurance for its benefit on the life of any of its directors, officers or employees, or on the life of any stockholder for the purpose of acquiring at his death shares of its stock owned by such stockholder.

The corporation shall not issue any convertible stock or other securities which are convertible into its stock, any voting securities other than stock, or any options, warrants or other rights to subscribe for or purchase any of its stock WHICH ARE OTHER THAN NONTRANSFERABLE.

Each issued and outstanding share of stock of the corporation shall entitle the owner thereof to cast one vote in all matters which stockholders are entitled or required by statute to determine by vote, and in each election for directors, if any.

EIGHTH: Upon approval of the issuance of the authorized shares of the corporation in the manner and subject to the terms specified herein or as specified by law or by any stockholders agreement relating thereto duly adopted as provided by law, the corporation is hereby empowered to issue such shares from time to time for such lawful consideration, whether money or otherwise, as the Board of Directors or stockholders, as the case may be, shall approve. Any shares issued for which the consideration so fixed has been paid or delivered shall be fully paid stock and the holder of such shares shall not be liable for any further call or assessment or any other payment thereon.

Each stockholder for the corporation shall have the preemptive right to subscribe to and purchase any additional issuance of the authorized and/or Treasury shares to be sold by the corporation, in proportion to the then stock ownership of said stockholder.

TENTH: The following provisions are hereby adopted for the purpose of defining, limiting and regulating the powers and liabilities of the corporation and of the directors and stockholders.

1) The private property of the stockholders shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any extent whatever.

2) The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

3) The directors and stockholders shall have power, if the By-Laws so provide, to hold their meetings either within or without the State of Maryland. The corporation may have one or more offices in addition to the principal office in Maryland, and may keep its books (subject to the provisions of the statutes) outside of the State of Maryland at such places as may from time to time be designated by the board.

4) No stockholder shall have the right to require dissolution of the corporation in connection with the offer, sale or transfer of his shares of stock in the corporation, or at will, or upon the occurrence of a specified event or contingency. Dissolution shall be authorized only by resolution of the owners of not less than a majority of the issued and outstanding shares authorized to vote.
