Dear Lyn Oliphant:

Let this letter confirm my phone call to your office this morning. In John G. Murphy's letter of July 7 1976, he noted, "Should additional information come to your attention -- please contact me." This letter is my contact.

I enclose three letters and make reference to them.

Letter A notes that the apparent violation is barred by the three year statute of limitation, but asks more recent happenings.

Letter B is from the State of California and states that federal statements are governed by federal law and investigation plus prosecution is the realm of federal authorities.

Letter C is my letter showing inconsistencies between federal and state reports. My letter notes that \$51,920.37 has not been explained - this has been adjudged free from prosecution by virtue of the three year statute. The audit of Johnson's reports cost me several hundred dollars and I am reluctant to spend hundreds more on an audit of Johnson's 1974 records, in fact I believe investigation of the records should be made by the Election Commission as this is supposedly why it was formed.

Fortunately, Clifford Welch of 110 West Bellvue Street in San Mateo, Ca94402 was employed by the Sierra Club to make a study of Johnson's records and in the 1974 reports, Welch again found a discrepancy between what was reported to the state and what was reflected in the federal report. Welch did not do a full study as he too feels this is the realm of the Election Commission, however the situation exists in 1974. 1976 will not show a similar situation in-as-much as the State of California changed its reporting requirements in 1976.

Isn't it strange that you can break a Federal law as long as you do it on a state report - and Washington, D.C. is 3000 miles away?

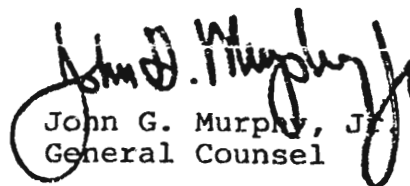

I received your letter and attachments of June 4, 1976, and have analyzed the allegations. My conclusion is that there is no evidence that state law was violated.

The Waxman-Dymally Campaign Disclosure Act, Elections Code section 11500, et seq., required federal candidates to file copies of federal campaign statements with state and local authorities. Failure to file could be enforced by injunctive actions brought by state or local authorities. However, the content requirements of federal statements are governed by federal law, and violations are investigated and prosecuted by federal authorities.

Dear Paul:

As you requested in our telephone conversation this morning, I am forwarding copies of all the relevant documents which we feel demonstrate substantial irregularities in the financing of Congressman Harold T. Johnson's (Democrat, 2nd District of California) 1972 campaign.

The documents copied here were on file with the Political Reform Division of the California Secretary of State's office and in the State Archives and may be consulted there.

I am also enclosing a copy of the full list of the "Friends of Bizz Johnson" from the Secretary's files in the Archives which I suspect may contain names of lobbyists and others who have shown up or will show up as conduits for illegal donations under Title 15, Section 791 and Title 18, Sections 610 and 611 of the U.S. Code.

The California documents were filed under provisions of California's Waxman-Dymally Act which forced at least partial disclosure of the source of campaign funds several years before the '72 federal disclosure requirements.

Copies of everything we've been able to find are included (excluding some Clerk of the House reports that showed nothing - i.e., no contributions or expenditures for the period in question). Portions are organized together and labeled Exhibit A, B and C.

Exhibit A is the simplest. This covers the omission in the Clerk of the House's Report of Receipts of contributions of \$6,371.96 shown in California records as having been received April 4 and 5, 1972 from the "Friends of Bizz Johnson."

However, the Clerk's report, 5/17/72, covering the period 4/7-5/15/72 shows a total for the calendar year to date of only \$253. The Clerk's reports of 5/27/72, covering 5/16-5/25/72, shows a total for the year of \$303.00. The report of 6/6/72 covering 5/26-5/31/72, a total of \$403.00. The report of 9/4/72, covering 6/1-8/31/72, a total of \$5,700.50 (including \$2,797.50 in itemized contributions attached, \$940.00 in unitemized contributions for the period and \$1,560.00 from a testimonial dinner for a total of \$5,297.50).

In fact, this \$6,371.96 never shows in any Clerk of the House report for Johnson's Committee. This money never appeared in any Committee report that we could find, or any other Federal Record.

Exhibit B shows an accounting error (we assume) amounting to \$500.00 in a contribution shown on Schedule A of the Committee's Summary Report of 9/4/72 but not reflected in the report's totals.

Exhibit C consists of three California law-mandated Committee Post-Election Campaign statements. The total amount shown by these statements is \$51,920.37.

The total contributions (from State and Federal reports) we find for the year is \$85,202.74. The total shown on the Clerk's records is \$33,281.37. Thus we find a total of \$51,920.37 in federally unreported contributions for the year 1972 in Johnson for Congress Committee reports.

In view of these inconsistencies we request a formal audit and investigation of all Johnson's financial records to date and hereby file a formal complaint with the Federal Election Commission/Attorney General of the State of California.

Dear Paul:

As you requested in our telephone conversation this morning, I am forwarding copies of all the relevant documents which we feel demonstrate substantial irregularities in the financing of Congressman Harold T. Johnson's (Democrat, 2nd District of California) 1972 campaign.

The documents copied here were on file with the Political Reform Division of the California Secretary of State's office and in the State Archives and may be consulted there.

I am also enclosing a copy of the full list of the "Friends of Bizz Johnson" from the Secretary's files in the Archives which I suspect may contain names of lobbyists and others who have shown up or will show up as conduits for illegal donations under Title 15, Section 791 and Title 18, Sections 610 and 611 of the U.S. Code.

The California documents were filed under provisions of California's Waxman-Dymally Act which forced at least partial disclosure of the source of campaign funds several years before the '72 federal disclosure requirements.

Copies of everything we've been able to find are included (excluding some Clerk of the House reports that showed nothing - i.e., no contributions or expenditures for the period in question). Portions are organized together and labeled Exhibit A, B and C.

Exhibit A is the simplest. This covers the omission in the Clerk of the House's Report of Receipts of contributions of \$6,371.96 shown in California records as having been received April 4 and 5, 1972 from the "Friends of Bizz Johnson."

However, the Clerk's report, 5/17/72, covering the period 4/7-5/15/72 shows a total for the calendar year to date of only \$253. The Clerk's reports of 5/27/72, covering 5/16-5/25/72, shows a total for the year of \$303.00. The report of 6/6/72 covering 5/26-5/31/72, a total of \$403.00. The report of 9/4/72, covering 6/1-8/31/72, a total of \$5,700.50 (including \$2,797.50 in itemized contributions attached, \$940.00 in unitemized contributions for the period and \$1,560.00 from a testimonial dinner for a total of \$5,297.50).

In fact, this \$6,371.96 never shows in any Clerk of the House report for Johnson's Committee. This money never appeared in any Committee report that we could find, or any other Federal Record.

✓ Exhibit B shows an accounting error (we assume) amounting to \$500.00 in a contribution shown on Schedule A of the Committee's Summary Report of 9/4/72 but not reflected in the report's totals.

Exhibit C consists of three California law-mandated Committee Post-Election Campaign statements. The total amount shown by these statements is \$51,920.37.

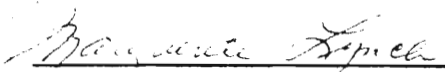
The total contributions (from State and Federal reports) we find for the year is \$85,202.74. The total shown on the Clerk's records is \$33,281.37. Thus we find a total of \$51,920.37 in federally unreported contributions for the year 1972 in Johnson for Congress Committee reports.

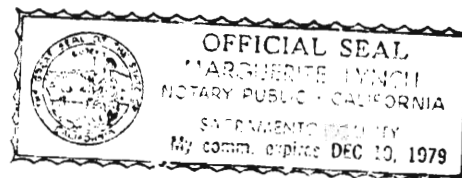

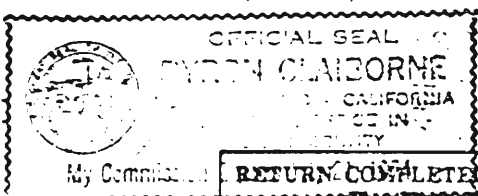
