2. Respondent Marilyn W. Pearson currently serves as treasurer for respondent GTE Good Government Club.

3. Respondent was required to file a 12 Day Pre-general Election Report with the Commission by October 25, 1984.

4. Respondent filed a November Monthly Report on November 12, 1984, covering Respondent's activities between October 1 and October 31, 1984.

5. Section 434(a)(4), Title 2, United States Code, requires all unauthorized political committees to file a Pre-general Election Report no later than the 12th day before any general election in which the committee makes a contribution or expenditure.

V. Respondent violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4) by failing to file the information required to be contained in the 12 Day Pre-General Election Report until November 12, 1984, twenty-two (22) days after it was due.

VI. Respondent will pay a civil penalty to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of One Hundred and Seventy-Five dollars (\$175), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. Respondent agrees that it shall not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

VIII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

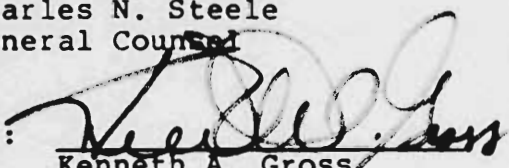
X. Respondent shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

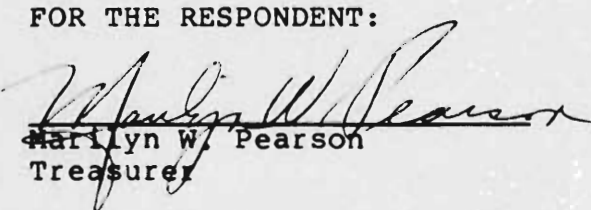

Dear Chairman McGarry:

The GTE Corporation Good Government Club ("GTE-GGC") has received your letter dated March 13, 1985 (received March 19, 1985) in which you state that the Commission has reason to believe that the GTE-GGC violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act") by failing to file with the Commission a pre-general election report of receipts and disbursements no later than the 12th day before the November 6, 1984 general election.

As explained more fully below, the information required to be filed in the pre-election report was submitted by the GTE-GGC on November 12, 1984. The GTE-GGC mistakenly filed the information, a list of contributions for the period October 1-17, 1984, in a monthly report instead of the special pre-election report. Although the GTE-GGC erred by filing late, the information has been filed with the Commission. In order to resolve this matter expeditiously, the GTE-GGC would like to enter into conciliation negotiations with the Commission.

GTE-GGC Reports

The GTE-GGC has been filing reports of receipts and disbursements pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(B). This section requires political committees other than authorized committees of candidates to file a report of receipts and disbursements monthly. In lieu of the reports otherwise due in November and December of any year in which there is a regularly scheduled general election, pre-general election, post-general election and year end reports are required.

The Treasurer of the GTE-GGC filed monthly reports as required during 1984, including a report filed on November 12, 1984 covering the period October 1-31, 1984. On November 19, 1984, the GTE-GGC received a notice from John D. Gibson of the Commission, dated November 16, indicating that the GTE-GGC pre-election report had not been received. Upon receipt of this notice, Marilyn W. Pearson, Treasurer of the GTE-GGC explained by telephone and follow-up letter to a Commission employee, Lisa Stolaruk, that she had been unaware of the requirement to file a pre-general election report. Ms. Stolaruk confirmed at this time that the Commission had received the report filed November 12. It was the GTE-GGC's understanding that since the information was already submitted on November 12, it was not necessary, at that point, to refile the information in a separate report designated as a pre-general election report. On December 3, the GTE-GGC filed a report covering November 1-26, 1984.

The FEC General Counsel's
Factual and Legal Analysis

The FEC General Counsel's Factual and Legal Analysis concludes that because the GTE-GGC failed to file the 1984 pre-general election report, it violated Section 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) of the Act.*/ Nonetheless, the report confirms that information covering the October 1-31 period was filed by the GTE-GGC in November.

Response

Based on the foregoing, it appears that the GTE-GGC mistakenly included the October 1-17 information in the report covering October 1-31 instead of in a separate pre-general election report. Although the required information was submitted, it was filed 22 days late.

*/ The report cites violation of subsection (4)(A)(ii) which appears to apply to quarterly report filers. The GTE-GGC files monthly reports pursuant to subsection (4)(B). While subsection (4)(B) also requires a pre-general election report, this report is to be filed in accordance with subsection (2)(A)(i).

The GTE-GGC admits it erred in filing the information in a monthly report rather than a pre-general election report and that the information was submitted after it was due. However, the GTE-GGC disagrees with the General Counsel's finding that the GTE-GGC failed to file. The GTE-GGC has submitted all required information in the November 12 report. Furthermore, the November 19 telephone call and follow-up letter to Ms. Stolaruk show that the GTE-GGC has been responsive to Commission notices. The GTE-GGC has reviewed the reporting requirements of Section 434(a) and can assure the Commission that this error will not occur in the future.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

The report must disclose all financial activity of the committee from the later of, the last report filed or the date of registration* through October 17, 1984. (Monthly filers must disclose all financial activity from the later of October 1 or the date of registration* through October 17, 1984.)

WHEN TO FILE

Pre-general election reports sent registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than October 22, 1984. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business October 25, 1984.

* * * * *

WHO MUST FILE THE POST-GENERAL ELECTION REPORT

All committees must file the post-general election report due December 6, 1984, regardless of election activity.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

The post-general election report must cover all financial activity of the committee from either the date of the last report filed or the date of registration, whichever is later* through November 26, 1984.

WHEN TO FILE

Post-general election reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than December 6, 1984. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business December 6, 1984.

*The first report filed by a committee shall include all amounts received or disbursed prior to becoming a political committee, even if such amounts were not received during the current reporting period. See 11 CFR 104.3(a) and (b).

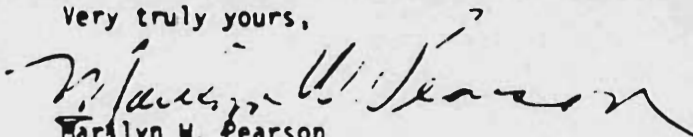
