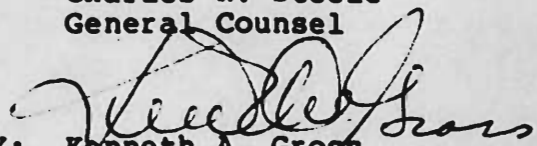
Dear Mr. Braden:

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission (hereinafter "the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that the North Dakota State Republican Committee and Howard Neils, as treasurer (hereinafter "the Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent North Dakota State Republican Committee-Federal Account is a political committee registered with the Commission.

2. La Vonnie Wegner is the treasurer of the Respondent Committee.

3. The Respondents were required to file the 1984 pre-general election report by October 25, 1985. The report was filed on December 6, 1985, 42 days late.

V. Respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) by failing to file timely the 1984 pre-general election report.

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. Respondents agree that they will not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

VIII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date all parties hereto have executed the same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

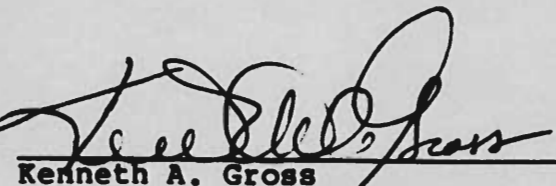

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

On June 6, 1985, the Commission determined that there is reason to believe that the North Dakota State Republican Committee ("the Committee") and Howard Neils, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a) by failing to file the report covering the pre-election period for the 1984 general election in a timely manner.^{1/} By letter dated August 5, 1985, the Committee requested to settle this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe (Attachment 1).

II. DISCUSSION OF CONCILIATION PROVISIONS AND CIVIL PENALTY

^{1/} By amendment to the Statement of Organization, the Committee's treasurer is La Vonnie Wegner.

III. GENERAL COUNSEL'S RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Enter into conciliation with the North Dakota State Republican Committee-Federal Account and La Vonnice Wegner, as treasurer, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe.

On June 6, 1985, the Federal Election Commission determined that there is reason to believe that the North Dakota State Republican Committee-Federal Account and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you and the committee. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials within ten days of your receipt of this matter.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation. Of course, this does not preclude the settlement of this matter through conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe if so desired. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d).

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

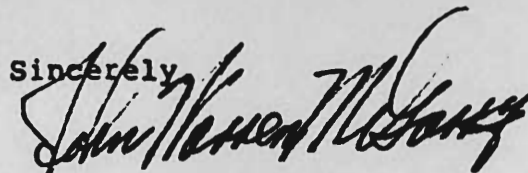

The North Dakota State Republican Committee-Federal Account ("the Committee") and Howard Neils, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) by failing to meet the due date for filing its report covering the pre-election period for the 1984 general election.

FACTUAL BASIS AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) states that committees which are not authorized by a candidate and which file quarterly reports, shall file a pre-election report which shall be filed no later than the 12th day before any election in which the committee makes a contribution or expenditure on behalf of a candidate in such election, and shall be complete as of the 20th day before the election.

The Reports Analysis Division referred the Committee for failure to file its pre-general election report due October 25, 1984. On December 6, 1984, the Committee submitted a post-general election report covering the period October 1 through November 26, 1984, which included the period of the pre-general report (October 1 - October 17, 1984). For the post-general election period as filed, the Committee showed receipts of \$34,984 and disbursements of \$30,316. Ending cash on hand as of November 26, 1984, was reported as \$11,666.

DESCRIPTION OF PRELIMINARY PROCEDURES
FOR PROCESSING POSSIBLE VIOLATIONS DISCOVERED BY THE
FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION

Possible violations discovered during the normal course of the Commission's supervisory responsibilities shall be referred to the Enforcement Division of the Office of General Counsel where they are assigned a MUR (Matter Under Review) number, and assigned to a staff member.

Following review of the information which generated the MUR, a recommendation on how to proceed on the matter, which shall include preliminary legal and factual analysis, and any information compiled from materials available to the Commission shall be submitted to the Commission. This initial report shall recommend either: (a) that the Commission find reason to believe that a possible violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act (FECA) may have occurred or is about to occur and that the Commission conduct an investigation of the matter; or (b) that the Commission find no reason to believe that a possible violation of the FECA has occurred and that the Commission close the file on the matter.

Thereafter, if the Commission decides by an affirmative vote of four (4) Commissioners that there is reason to believe that a violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act (FECA) has been committed or is about to be committed, the Office of the General Counsel shall open an investigation into the matter. Upon notification of the Commission's finding(s), within 15 days a respondent(s) may submit any factual or legal materials relevant to the allegations. During the investigation, the Commission shall have the power to subpoena documents, to subpoena individuals to appear for depositions, and to order answers to interrogatories. The respondent(s) may be contacted more than once by the Commission in its investigation.

If, during this period of investigation, the respondent(s) indicate a desire to enter into conciliation, the Office of General Counsel staff may begin the conciliation process prior to a finding of probable cause to believe a violation has been committed. Conciliation is an informal method of conference and persuasion to endeavor to correct or prevent a violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act (FECA). Most often, the result of conciliation is an agreement signed by the Commission and the respondent(s). The Conciliation Agreement must be adopted by four votes of the Commission before it becomes final. After signature by the Commission and the respondent(s), the Commission shall make public the Conciliation Agreement.

[If the investigation warrants], and no conciliation agreement is entered into prior to a probable cause to believe finding, the General Counsel must notify the respondent(s) of his intent to proceed to a vote on probable cause to believe that a violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act (FECA) has been committed or is about to be committed. Included with the notification to the respondent(s) shall be a brief setting forth the position of the General Counsel on the legal and factual issues of the case. Within 15 days of receipt of such brief, the respondent(s) may submit a brief posing the position of respondent(s) and replying to the brief of the General Counsel. Both briefs will then be filed with the Commission Secretary and will be considered by the Commission. Thereafter, if the Commission determines by an affirmative vote of four (4) Commissioners, that there is probable cause to believe that a violation of the FECA has been committed or is about to be committed conciliation must be undertaken for a period of at least 30 days but not more than 90 days. If the Commission is unable to correct or prevent any violation of the FECA through conciliation the Office of General Counsel may recommend that the Commission file a civil suit against the respondent(s) to enforce the Federal Election Campaign Act (FECA). Thereafter, the Commission may, upon an affirmative vote of four (4) Commissioners, institute civil action for relief in the District Court of the United States.

This is in reply to your letter of June 18, 1985, regarding a possible violation of the pre-election reporting period report for 1984.

Mrs. Barb Gregor, who prepares our Federal Election Commission reports and our former State Chairman Marlys Fleck, held a conference call with Frances Hagen of the Federal Election Commission on Tuesday, June 25, 1985.

Ms. Hagen determined, after several days review following the conference call, that a letter of explanation would suffice in answering your question as to whether there had been a possible violation of our not filing a pre-election report for the period of October 1, 1984 through October 12, 1984.

During that reporting period (October 1 - October 17, 1984) the North Dakota Republican Party Federal Account had not actually spent funds or had an in-kind contribution for our Federal Congressional Candidate Lois Ivers Altenburg.

On October 12, 1984, we deposited \$1,000 in a postal account for the purpose of future bulk mailings. We charged that deposit to allocated monies for Candidate Altenburg. The bulk mailing, however, which mentioned her name went out after that reporting period.

There was no intention to violate the FEC rules and regulations. Mrs. Gregor called your information number and visited with a gentleman at the time that reporting period report should have been in the process of preparation. She was told that no report was necessary unless a cash contribution had been made to Candidate Altenburg.

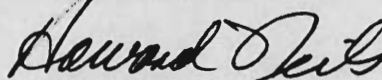
Actually no cash or in-kind contribution was made during the reporting period, as I previously explained.

The attached list of unauthorized committees consists of twenty-three (23) quarterly filers, which failed to submit a 12 Day Pre-General Report by Election Day, November 6, 1984. According to the RAD Review and Referral Procedures for Unauthorized Committees (Standard 3), further examination is required by your office.

Unlike the mandatory reporting requirement placed upon monthly filers, 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(4)(A)(ii) requires quarterly filers to submit 12 Day Pre-General Reports only if the committees make contributions to or expenditures on behalf of Federal candidates involved in the general election.

The Party/Non-Party Branch conducted a thorough examination to identify quarterly filers disclosing contributions or expenditures between October 1 and October 17, 1984. The research revealed committees that submitted either:

- a) 12 Day Pre-General Reports in a untimely manner,
or
- b) 30 Day Post-General Reports indicating that 12 Day
Pre-General Reports should have been filed.

All unauthorized committees were sent prior notification concerning the pre- and post-general filing requirements on October 1, 1984. In addition, twelve (12) of the committees being referred were sent Non-File Notices on December 28, 1984 for failure to file the 30 Day Post-General Report covering October 1 through November 26, 1984.

The attached list of unauthorized committees consists of twenty-three (23) quarterly filers, which failed to submit a 12 Day Pre-General Report by Election Day, November 6, 1984. According to the RAD Review and Referral Procedures for Unauthorized Committees (Standard 3), further examination is required by your office.

Unlike the mandatory reporting requirement placed upon monthly filers, 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(4)(A)(ii) requires quarterly filers to submit 12 Day Pre-General Reports only if the committees make contributions to or expenditures on behalf of Federal candidates involved in the general election.

The Party/Non-Party Branch conducted a thorough examination to identify quarterly filers disclosing contributions or expenditures between October 1 and October 17, 1984. The research revealed committees that submitted either:

- a) 12 Day Pre-General Reports in a untimely manner,
or
- b) 30 Day Post-General Reports indicating that 12 Day
Pre-General Reports should have been filed.

All unauthorized committees were sent prior notification concerning the pre- and post-general filing requirements on October 1, 1984. In addition, twelve (12) of the committees being referred were sent Non-Filer Notices on December 28, 1984 for failure to file the 30 Day Post-General Report covering October 1 through November 26, 1984.
