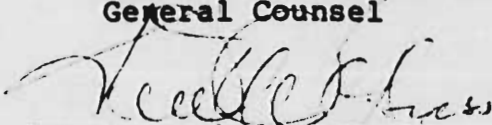
Dear Mr. Wewer:

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission (hereinafter "the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that the National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC and Blanche J. Kelly, as treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) by failing to file their 1984 Pre-General Election Report in a timely manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents, and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C.

§ 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent, the National Committee to Preserve Social Security- PAC is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4)(A).
2. Respondent, Blanche J. Kelly, is the treasurer of the National Committee to Preserve Social Security- PAC.
3. Section 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) of Title 2, United States Code, provides that during an election year the treasurer of a political committee is required to file a pre-election report no later than 12 days before any primary or general election in which the committee makes a contribution to or expenditure on behalf of a candidate in such election.
4. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) Respondents were required to file a Pre-General Election Report, covering the period of October 1 through October 17, 1984, no later than by October 25, 1984.
5. During the coverage of the Pre-General Election Report, the National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC made expenditures of at least \$319,540 in connection with the 1984 general election. Respondents did not disclose this information to the Commission until January 22, 1985, on which date the Respondents filed a report disclosing the activity occurring during the period of October 1, 1984 and November 26, 1984.

V. Respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) by failing to file their 1984 Pre-General Election Report in a timely manner.

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. Respondents agree that they shall not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431 et seq.

VIII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

X. Respondents shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

XI. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or

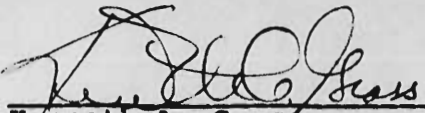

Responding to notification, the Respondents request to enter into conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe (Attachment 1).

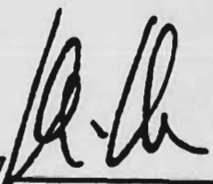

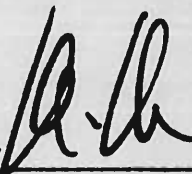

On June 10, 1985, the Federal Election Commission determined that there is reason to believe the National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you and the committee. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials, within ten days of your receipt of this letter.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation. Of course, this does not preclude the settlement of this matter through conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe if so desired. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d).

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form

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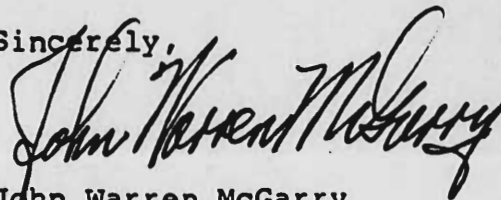

GENERATION OF MATTER

The Reports Analysis Division referred this matter to the Office of the General Counsel on May 10, 1985. The referral alleges that the National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC ("the Committee") and Blanche J. Kelly, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) by failing to file their 1984 Pre-General Election Report in a timely manner.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

1. The Law

During an election year the treasurer of a political committee is required to file a pre-election report no later than 12 days before any primary or general election in which the committee makes a contribution to or expenditure on behalf of a candidate in such election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(c)(1)(ii).

2. The Facts

The National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4)(A) and Blanche J. Kelly is its treasurer.^{1/}

^{1/} Blanche J. Kelly has been the treasurer of record since November 15, 1983, the date on which the Committee registered with the Commission.

During the 1983-84 election cycle, the Committee filed quarterly reports with the Commission. On October 1, 1984 the Commission sent a general notice to the Committee advising them that all quarterly filing committees that made contributions or expenditures in connection with the general election were required to file a pre-election report, covering the period October 1 through October 17, 1984, no later than by October 25, 1984.

During the coverage dates of the pre-election report, the Committee made expenditures of at least \$319,540 in connection with the general election. The Committee did not disclose this information to the Commission until January 22, 1985, on which date the Committee filed a report disclosing the activity occurring between the date of October 1, 1984 and November 26, 1984.^{2/}

3. Application of the Law to the Facts

The record in this case reveals that the Respondents, having made contributions and expenditures in connection with the general election, were subject to the reporting requirements of a pre-election report. The Respondents failed to file their pre-election report within the time-frame required by 2 U.S.C.

§ 434(a)(4)(A)(ii). Failure to file reports within the time-frame required is a violation of this section. Accordingly, the

Office of the General Counsel recommends that the Commission open a matter under review and find reason to believe that the Committee and its treasurer, Blanche J. Kelly, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).

DESCRIPTION OF PRELIMINARY PROCEDURES
FOR PROCESSING POSSIBLE VIOLATIONS DISCOVERED BY THE
FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION

Possible violations discovered during the normal course of the Commission's supervisory responsibilities shall be referred to the Enforcement Division of the Office of General Counsel where they are assigned a MUR (Matter Under Review) number, and assigned to a staff member.

Following review of the information which generated the MUR, a recommendation on how to proceed on the matter, which shall include preliminary legal and factual analysis, and any information compiled from materials available to the Commission shall be submitted to the Commission. This initial report shall recommend either: (a) that the Commission find reason to believe that a possible violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act (FECA) may have occurred or is about to occur and that the Commission conduct an investigation of the matter; or (b) that the Commission find no reason to believe that a possible violation of the FECA has occurred and that the Commission close the file on the matter.

Thereafter, if the Commission decides by an affirmative vote of four (4) Commissioners that there is reason to believe that a violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act (FECA) has been committed or is about to be committed, the Office of the General Counsel shall open an investigation into the matter. Upon notification of the Commission's finding(s), within 15 days a respondent(s) may submit any factual or legal materials relevant to the allegations. During the investigation, the Commission shall have the power to subpoena documents, to subpoena individuals to appear for depositions, and to order answers to interrogatories. The respondent(s) may be contacted more than once by the Commission in its investigation.

GENERATION OF MATTER

The Reports Analysis Division referred this matter to the Office of the General Counsel on May 10, 1985. The referral alleges that the National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC ("the Committee") and Blanche J. Kelly, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) by failing to file their 1984 Pre-General Election Report in a timely manner. See Attached Referral at 1-33.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

1. The Law

During an election year the treasurer of a political committee is required to file a pre-election report no later than 12 days before any primary or general election in which the committee makes a contribution to or expenditure on behalf of a candidate in such election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(c)(1)(ii).

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2. The Facts

The National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4)(A) and Blanche J. Kelly is its treasurer.^{1/}

During the 1983-84 election cycle, the Committee filed quarterly reports with the Commission. On October 1, 1984 the Commission sent a general notice to the Committee advising them that all quarterly filing committees that made contributions or expenditures in connection with the general election were required to file a pre-election report, covering the period October 1 through October 17, 1984, no later than by October 25, 1984. See Attachments at 7.

During the coverage dates of the pre-election report, the Committee made expenditures of at least \$319,540 in connection with the general election. See Attachments at 11-33. The Committee did not disclose this information to the Commission until January 22, 1985, on which date the Committee filed a report disclosing the activity occurring between the date of October 1, 1984 and November 26, 1984.^{2/}

3. Application of the Law to the Facts

The record in this case reveals that the Respondents, having made contributions and expenditures in connection with the general election, were subject to the reporting requirements of a

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pre-election report. The Respondents failed to file their pre-election report within the time-frame required by 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii). Failure to file reports within the time-frame required is a violation of this section. Accordingly, the Office of the General Counsel recommends that the Commission open a matter under review and find reason to believe that the Committee and its treasurer, Blanche J. Kelly, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Open a matter under review.
2. Find reason to believe that the National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC and Blanche J. Kelly, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).
3. Approve and send the attached letter and General Counsel's Factual and Legal Analysis.

WHO MUST FILE THE PRE-GENERAL ELECTION REPORT

All committees that file monthly reports must file the pre-general election report due October 25, 1984.

In addition all quarterly filing committees that have made contributions or expenditures (including independent expenditures) in connection with the general election must file a pre-election report, if such activity has not previously been reported. See below for post-general filing information.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

The report must disclose all financial activity of the committee from the later of, the last report filed or the date of registration* through October 17, 1984. (Monthly filers must disclose all financial activity from the later of October 1 or the date of registration* through October 17, 1984.)

WHEN TO FILE

Pre-general election reports sent registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than October 22, 1984. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business October 25, 1984.

* * * * *

WHO MUST FILE THE POST-GENERAL ELECTION REPORT

All committees must file the post-general election report due December 6, 1984, regardless of election activity.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

The post-general election report must cover all financial activity of the committee from either the date of the last report filed or the date of registration, whichever is later* through November 26, 1984.

WHEN TO FILE

Post-general election reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than December 6, 1984. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business December 6, 1984.

*The first report filed by a committee shall include all amounts received or disbursed prior to becoming a political committee, even if such amounts were not received during the current reporting period. See 11 CFR 104.3(a) and (b).

On , 1985, the Federal Election Commission determined that there is reason to believe the National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you and the committee. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials, within ten days of your receipt of this letter.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation. Of course, this does not preclude the settlement of this matter through conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe if so desired. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d).

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form

GENERAL COUNSEL'S FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

RESPONDENTS: National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC MUR No.
Blanche J. Kelly, as treasurer

GENERATION OF MATTER

The Reports Analysis Division referred this matter to the Office of the General Counsel on May 10, 1985. The referral alleges that the National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC ("the Committee") and Blanche J. Kelly, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) by failing to file their 1984 Pre-General Election Report in a timely manner.

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

1. The Law

During an election year the treasurer of a political committee is required to file a pre-election report no later than 12 days before any primary or general election in which the committee makes a contribution to or expenditure on behalf of a candidate in such election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.5(c)(1)(ii).

2. The Facts

The National Committee to Preserve Social Security-PAC is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4)(A) and Blanche J. Kelly is its treasurer.^{1/}

^{1/} Blanche J. Kelly has been the treasurer of record since November 15, 1983, the date on which the Committee registered with the Commission.

During the 1983-84 election cycle, the Committee filed quarterly reports with the Commission. On October 1, 1984 the Commission sent a general notice to the Committee advising them that all quarterly filing committees that made contributions or expenditures in connection with the general election were required to file a pre-election report, covering the period October 1 through October 17, 1984, no later than by October 25, 1984.

During the coverage dates of the pre-election report, the Committee made expenditures of at least \$319,540 in connection with the general election. The Committee did not disclose this information to the Commission until January 22, 1985, on which date the Committee filed a report disclosing the activity occurring between the date of October 1, 1984 and November 26, 1984.^{2/}

3. Application of the Law to the Facts

The record in this case reveals that the Respondents, having made contributions and expenditures in connection with the general election, were subject to the reporting requirements of a pre-election report. The Respondents failed to file their pre-election report within the time-frame required by 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii). Failure to file reports within the time-frame required is a violation of this section. Accordingly, the

^{2/} This report covered the period of the 12 Day Pre-election and 30 Day Post-election reports.

Office of the General Counsel recommends that the Commission open a matter under review and find reason to believe that the Committee and its treasurer, Blanche J. Kelly, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).
