On September 17, 1985, the Commission found reason to believe that the LaRouche Campaign and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(4), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. However, after considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission has determined to take no further action and close the file. The file in this matter will be made part of the public record within 30 days. Should you wish to submit any materials to appear on the public record, please do so within 10 days.

The Commission reminds you that your failing to correct a mathematical discrepancy in a timely manner nevertheless appears to be a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(4) and you should take immediate steps to insure that this activity does not occur in the future.

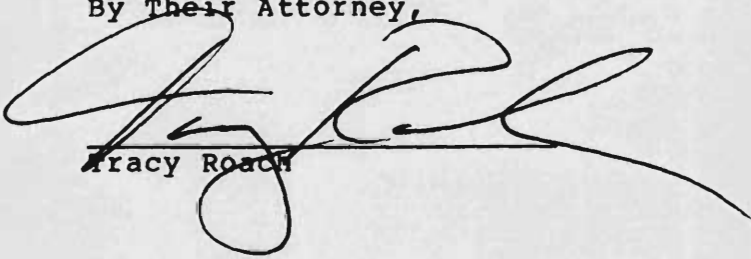

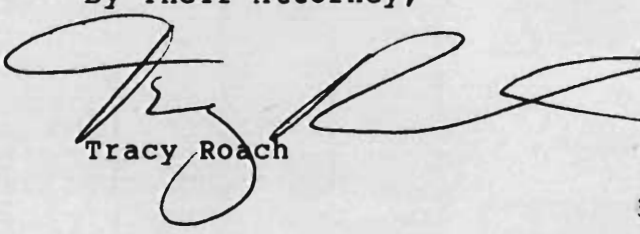

Dear Mr. Steele;

This letter is in response to notification from the Commission that there is reason to believe that The LaRouche Campaign ("TLC") and its Treasurer Edward Spannaus have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), by failing to report the total amount of all disbursements as set forth in 2 U.S.C. 434(b)(4) and 11 C.F.R. 104.3(b). The finding was made on September 17, 1985 and is based upon TLC's delay in filing amended reports to correct an apparent discrepancy in the reporting of said disbursements.

The arithmetical error which resulted in the apparent discrepancy has been ascertained and amended reports to remedy its effect upon subsequent calculations are currently being prepared. The delay in resolving this situation is admittedly regrettable but it was unavoidable due to limited resources. It would appear that this matter can be dismissed as soon as the amended reports are submitted and therefore a formal request for such action will be made when the amended reports are completed.

On September 17, 1985, the Federal Election Commission determined that there is reason to believe that The LaRouche Campaign and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(4), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you and the committee. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Line 30 (Total Disbursements) for Columns A and B (\$1,212,980.28 and \$3,281,297.63, respectively) did not equal the sum of the line totals noted for the disbursement categories (\$1,222,980.28 and \$3,291,297.63, respectively) (Attachment 2). The figure on Line 30, Column A was also noted on Line 9 of the Summary Page as part of the cash summary (Attachment 3).

A Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") was sent on April 23, 1985 notifying the Committee of the apparent discrepancy. The RFAI advised the Committee that changes made to the Detailed Summary Page could also affect the Total Disbursement line on the Summary Page and figures on all subsequent filings (Attachment 4).

A letter received from the Committee's counsel, Tracy Roach, on May 9, 1985 indicated that the Committee needed additional time to resolve the apparent discrepancy. Ms. Roach indicated that an amended report would be filed as soon as the discrepancy was solved ~~(Attachment 5)~~. A Second Notice was sent to the Committee on May 16, 1985 advising the treasurer that the response was considered incomplete and that clarifying information was needed for the mathematical discrepancy ~~(Attachment 6)~~.

The LaRouche Campaign ("the Committee") has reviewed your letter of April 23, 1984 concerning the above referenced preliminary review. With respect to the itemized questions raised, the following response is made.

1. Amended State Allocation Schedule for
May Monthly Report:

The amended schedule is enclosed.

2. Apparent arithmetic discrepancy in
June Monthly Report:

The Committee requests additional time to resolve the apparent \$10,000 discrepancy in the amended June Monthly Report. This is to insure that the discrepancy is simply an arithmetical error in the lines and columns cited in your letter, and that its correction does not result in the creation of further errors, for example in reported closing cash balances. Initial investigation suggests that resolution of the discrepancy may bear upon minor cash balance errors raised in the course of the FEC's audit of the Committee books and records, though not deemed sufficiently material to include in the Audit Report. Amended Monthly Report(s) will be submitted as soon as the apparent discrepancy is solved.

3. Apparent excess contributions:

With respect to the instances highlighted for Schedules A-P of over-limit contributions and/or loans, please find enclosed a table showing the current status of the items

identified in your attachments, which includes each individual's current (4/85) aggregate.

Since a reporting error was the reason for one item appearing to exceed the \$1,000 limit, we also include an amended Schedule 17A to that of the 8/20/84 Report (period 7/1-7/31/84). The error involved was one of attributing a \$200 contribution to the wrong individual. Therefore the correction has the following effects on the 8/20/84 Report: 1) the correctly-attributed contribution will not appear on the itemized Schedule 17A (since this was the individual's initial contribution), and will thereby reduce the total itemized contributions; 2) the overall contributions total for Line 17A will remain the same.

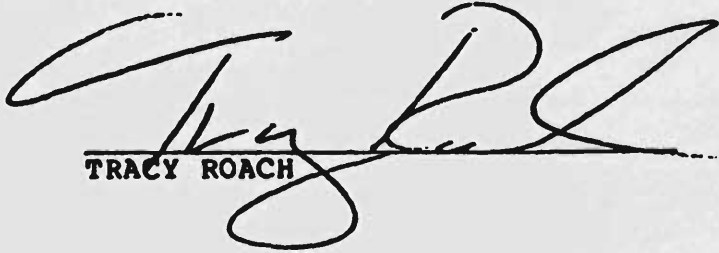
As has been reflected in the Committee's reports (including that covering the first quarter of 1985), many over-limit contributions and/or loans have been repaid. The Committee will reimburse any remaining over-limit items as rapidly as it can raise the funds to do so.

4. Outstanding balances on overdue loans:

With respect to Schedules C-P, it is correct that the due dates for repayment of several loans have passed without full satisfaction of the debt. In most cases, the lender has agreed informally to an extension of time for repayment. Due to the informality of this arrangement and the absence of written, signed documentation, the Committee felt it misleading and incorrect to report verbal discussions as formal charges to the conditions of the loan. Debt retirement has been undertaken in good faith and is proceeding as rapidly as our fundraising effort allows. The majority of our loaners are aware of this fact and have been patient and understanding.

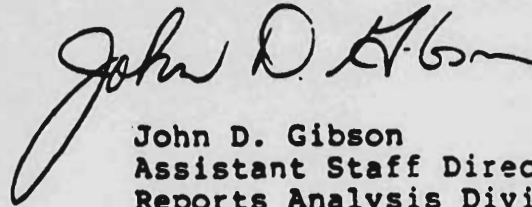

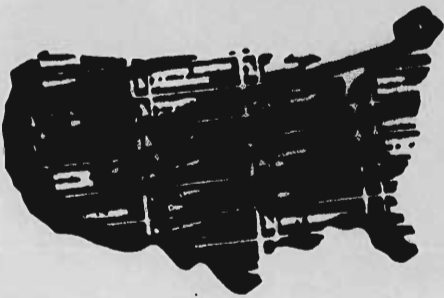

On , 1985, the Federal Election Commission determined that there is reason to believe that The LaRouche Campaign and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(4), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you and the committee. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials within fifteen days of your receipt of this letter.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

If you are interested in pursuing pre-probable cause conciliation, you should so request in writing. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d). Upon receipt of the request, the Office of General Counsel will make recommendations to the Commission either proposing an agreement in settlement of the matter or recommending declining that pre-probable cause conciliation be pursued. The Office of General Counsel may recommend that pre-probable cause conciliation not be entered into at this time so that it may complete its investigation of the matter. Further, requests for pre-probable conciliation after briefs on probable cause have been mailed to the respondent will not be entertained.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of General Counsel is not authorized to give extensions beyond 20 days.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

The Detailed Summary Page of the Committee's report disclosed Total Disbursements (Line 30) of \$1,212,980.28 (Column A) and \$3,281,297.63 (Column B). These figures, however, did not equal the sum of the line totals noted for the disbursement categories (\$1,222,980.28 and \$3,291,297.63, respectively).

An RFAI, sent on April 23, 1985, notified the Committee of the apparent discrepancy, and advised the Committee that changes made to the Detailed Summary Page could also affect the Total Disbursement Line on the Summary Page and figures on subsequent filings.

The Committee's counsel contacted the Commission on May 9, 1985, and again on June 6, 1985 (a Second Notice was sent on May 16, 1985, to advise that additional time was needed to rectify the apparent discrepancy.

In a cover letter submitted with the 1985 July Quarterly Report, received on July 16, 1985, the Committee's treasurer noted that additional time was needed to respond.

As of this date, the Commission has received no further response.

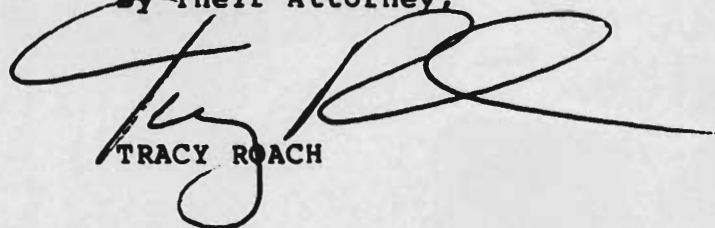

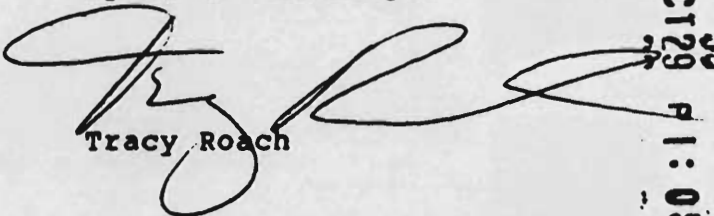

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The LaRouche Campaign ("the Committee") and Edward Spannus, as Treasurer, was referred to OGC by RAD for failing to correct a \$10,000 mathematical discrepancy which was disclosed on its amended 1984 June Monthly Report.

The Detailed Summary Page of the Committee's report disclosed Total Disbursements (Line 30) of \$1,212,980.28 (Column A) and \$3,281,297.63 (Column B). These figures, however, did not equal the sum of the line totals noted for the disbursement categories (\$1,222,980.28 and \$3,291,297.63, respectively).

An RFAI, sent on April 23, 1985, notified the Committee of the apparent discrepancy, and advised the Committee that changes made to the Detailed Summary Page could also affect the Total Disbursement Line on the Summary Page and figures on subsequent filings.

The Committee's counsel contacted the Commission on May 9, 1985, and again on June 6, 1985 (a Second Notice was sent on

May 16, 1985), to advise that additional time was needed to rectify the apparent discrepancy.

In a cover letter submitted with the 1985 July Quarterly Report, received on July 16, 1985, the Committee's treasurer noted that additional time was needed to respond.

As of this date, the Commission has received no further response.

LEGAL AND FACTUAL ANALYSIS

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434b(4) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(b) each report filed by a political committee must include the total amount of all disbursements for that reporting period and for the entire calendar year.

Because the Committee failed to file an amended report correcting the apparent discrepancy, it is the recommendation of the Office of General Counsel that the Commission find reason to believe that the LaRouche Campaign violated 2 U.S.C. § 434b(4).

Mathematical Discrepancies

The Detailed Summary Page of The LaRouche Campaign's ("the Committee") amended 1984 June Monthly Report disclosed a \$10,000 mathematical discrepancy. Line 30 (Total Disbursements) for Columns A and B (\$1,212,980.28 and \$3,281,297.63, respectively) did not equal the sum of the line totals noted for the disbursement categories (\$1,222,980.28 and \$3,291,297.63, respectively) (Attachment 2). The figure on Line 30, Column A was also noted on Line 9 of the Summary Page as part of the cash summary (Attachment 3).

A Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") was sent on April 23, 1985 notifying the Committee of the apparent discrepancy. The RFAI advised the Committee that changes made to the Detailed Summary Page could also affect the Total Disbursement line on the Summary Page and figures on all subsequent filings (Attachment 4).

A letter received from the Committee's counsel, Tracy Roach, on May 9, 1985 indicated that the Committee needed additional time to resolve the apparent discrepancy. Ms. Roach indicated that an amended report would be filed as soon as the discrepancy was solved (Attachment 5). A Second Notice was sent to the Committee on May 16, 1985 advising the treasurer that the response was considered incomplete and that clarifying information was needed for the mathematical discrepancy (Attachment 6).

Ms. Roach called the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst on June 6, 1985 and indicated that the Committee would be working on a response within the next ten (10) days (Attachment 7). In a cover letter submitted with the 1985 July Quarterly Report and received on July 16, 1985, the Committee's treasurer noted that additional time was needed to respond. He explained that part of the delay was "due to matters left unresolved in the field audit staff's bank reconciliation workpapers, which appear to bear upon the discrepancy."

As of this date, no further response has been received.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-A review of all state allocation schedules submitted for your committee indicates that an amended schedule was not filed for your May Monthly amended report (covering 4/1/84-4/30/84). Please provide Page 3 of FEC Form 3-P for this report.

-The amended June Monthly report (signed August 2, 1984) reveals a mathematical discrepancy on the Summary and Detailed Summary Pages. Line 30 of the Detailed Summary Page (Columns A and B) does not equal the sum of Lines 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 and 29. There appears to be a \$10,000 discrepancy.

Please amend your report to clarify these totals. Note that changes made to this schedule may affect Line 9 of the Summary Page and all subsequent filings.

-Review of your 1984 reports covering 7/1/84-12/31/84 (pertinent portions attached) disclose contributions and loans which appear to exceed the limits set forth in the Act. The attached schedules indicate contributions and loans that do not appear to have been refunded or repaid. An individual or a political committee other than a multicandidate committee may not make contributions to a candidate for Federal office in excess of \$1,000 per election. If you have received a contribution(s) which exceeds the limits, the Commission recommends that you refund to the donor(s) the amount in excess of \$1,000. The Commission should be notified in writing if a refund is necessary. In

The LaRouche Campaign ("the Committee") has reviewed your letter of April 23, 1984 concerning the above referenced preliminary review. With respect to the itemized questions raised, the following response is made.

1. Amended State Allocation Schedule for
May Monthly Report:

The amended schedule is enclosed.

2. Apparent arithmetic discrepancy in
June Monthly Report:

The Committee requests additional time to resolve the apparent \$10,000 discrepancy in the amended June Monthly Report. This is to insure that the discrepancy is simply an arithmetical error in the lines and columns cited in your letter, and that its correction does not result in the creation of further errors, for example in reported closing cash balances. Initial investigation suggests that resolution of the discrepancy may bear upon minor cash balance errors raised in the course of the FEC's audit of the Committee books and records, though not deemed sufficiently material to include in the Audit Report. Amended Monthly Report(s) will be submitted as soon as the apparent discrepancy is solved.

3. Apparent excess contributions:

With respect to the instances highlighted for Schedules A-P of over-limit contributions and/or loans, please find enclosed a table showing the current status of the items

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identified in your attachments, which includes each individual's current (4/85) aggregate.

Since a reporting error was the reason for one item appearing to exceed the \$1,000 limit, we also include an amended Schedule 17A to that of the 8/20/84 Report (period 7/1-7/31/84). The error involved was one of attributing a \$200 contribution to the wrong individual. Therefore the correction has the following effects on the 8/20/84 Report: 1) the correctly-attributed contribution will not appear on the itemized Schedule 17A (since this was the individual's initial contribution), and will thereby reduce the total itemized contributions; 2) the overall contributions total for Line 17A will remain the same.

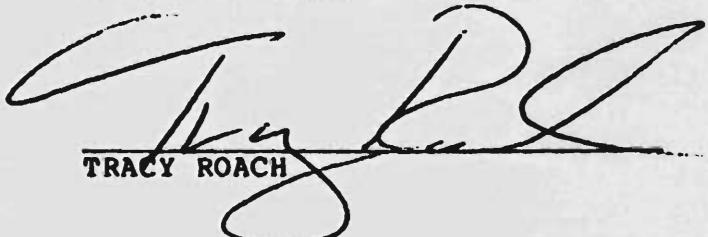
As has been reflected in the Committee's reports (including that covering the first quarter of 1985), many over-limit contributions and/or loans have been repaid. The Committee will reimburse any remaining over-limit items as rapidly as it can raise the funds to do so.

4. Outstanding balances on overdue loans:

With respect to Schedules C-P, it is correct that the due dates for repayment of several loans have passed without full satisfaction of the debt. In most cases, the lender has agreed informally to an extension of time for repayment. Due to the informality of this arrangement and the absence of written, signed documentation, the Committee felt it misleading and incorrect to report verbal discussions as formal charges to the conditions of the loan. Debt retirement has been undertaken in good faith and is proceeding as rapidly as our fundraising effort allows. The majority of our loaners are aware of this fact and have been patient and understanding.

Should further clarification be needed, please contact the Committee immediately.

Your May 9, 1985 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-The amended June Monthly Report (signed August 2, 1984) reveals a mathematical discrepancy on the Summary and Detailed Summary Pages. Line 30 of the Detailed Summary Page (Columns A and B) does not equal the sum of Lines 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 and 29. There appears to be a \$10,000 discrepancy.

Please amend your report to clarify these totals. Note that changes made to this schedule may affect Line 9 of the Summary Page and all subsequent filings.

-The Commission notes your statement that you "will reimburse any remaining over-limit items as rapidly as it can raise the funds". However, until the respective excessive contributions have been refunded, these transactions should be shown as outstanding debts owed by your committee, on the debt schedule (Schedule D), and included in the totals for Line 10 for the Summary Page.

Although the Commission may take further legal steps concerning the acceptance of excessive contributions, prompt action by you to refund or repay the excessive amount will be taken into consideration.

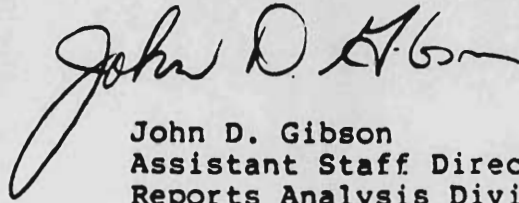

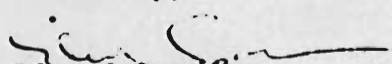
This cover letter to The LaRouche Campaign's July 15, 1985 Quarterly Report to the Federal Election Commission is a further response by TLC to your letter of April 23, 1985.

Regarding the apparent \$10,000.00 discrepancy in the amended June Monthly Report, while TLC's accounting volunteers continue to work to resolve it, additional time is required to ensure a correct amendment is made. This is in part due to matters left unresolved in the field audit staff's bank reconciliation workpapers, which appear to bear upon the discrepancy.

In my first response to you on May 8, 1985, by my attorney, it was noted that TLC is reimbursing persons who were found to have made contributions over the legal limit as rapidly as it can raise the fund to do so. With respect to Schedules A-P of the referenced reports, as of June 30, 1985, TLC has reduced its over limit items as is reflected in the accompanying Quarterly report.

With respect to Schedules C-P of the referenced reports, the enclosed Quarterly report shows that the campaign committee continues to retire its debts to the extent that it has funds to do so.
