CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission (hereinafter "the Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that the Friends of Edd Hargett Committee and Earl Wayne Rountree, III, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(5)(A) and § 434(b)(8) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.11(a) by failing to fully disclose debts owed to five creditors and debt payments made to one creditor.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondent, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondent, and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered into pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondent has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondent enters voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

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IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Respondent Friends of Edd Hargett Committee is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4).
2. Respondent Earl Wayne Rountree, III currently serves as treasurer for respondent Friends of Edd Hargett Committee.
3. Respondent Committee is the principal campaign committee for Edd Hargett, a former candidate for the United States House of Representatives.
4. Respondents filed an amended 30 Day Post-runoff report in 1985.
 - a. Respondents disclosed two (2) debts totalling \$43,942.58 and owed to Karl Rove and Company and Praxis List Company, as outstanding at the start of the reporting period. These debts were not previously disclosed (when incurred).
 - b. Respondents disclosed three (3) debts totalling \$30,426.63 and owed to National Media, Inc., Ragland's and Praxis List Company, as outstanding at the close of the reporting period. These debts were not disclosed on the subsequent report filed by respondent, the 1985 Year End report.
 - c. Respondents disclosed a \$142,000 debt payment to National Media, Inc., but of this amount, only \$90,036.20 was itemized on Schedule B of the report. Respondents failed to itemize \$51,963.20 in debt payments.
5. Section 434(b)(8), Title 2, United States Code, requires a political committee to disclose the amount and nature of outstanding debts which it owes. 11 C.F.R. § 104.11(a) requires debts to be continually reported by a political committee until extinguished.

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6. Section 434(b)(5)(A), Title 2, United States Code, requires the disclosure of the name and address of each person to whom an expenditure is made in an amount exceeding \$200, for a committee's operating expenditure together with the date, amount and purpose of the operating expenditure.

V. Respondents failed to fully disclose debts owed to five creditors on their amended 30 Day Post-runoff and Year End reports, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(8) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.11(a). Respondents failed to fully disclose debt payments made to one creditor on their 30 Day Post-runoff report, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(5)(A).

VI. Respondents will file amended reports, fully disclosing all debts owed and all debt payments made.

VII. Respondent will pay a civil penalty to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of Three Thousand dollars (\$3,000), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VIII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

IX. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

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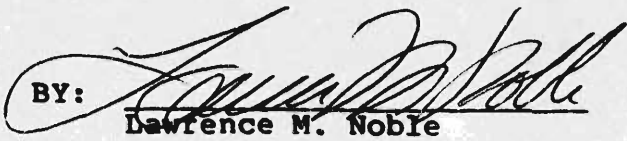
X. Respondent shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

XI. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be valid.

On August 13, 1986, the Federal Election Commission determined there is reason to believe the Friends of Edd Hargett Committee and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(5)(A) and § 434(b)(8), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act") and 11 C.F.R. 104.11(a) of the Commission's regulations. The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you and the committee. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials, within fifteen days of your receipt of this letter. Statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

If you are interested in pursuing pre-probable cause conciliation, you should so request in writing. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d). Upon receipt of the request, the Office of General Counsel will make recommendations to the Commission either

You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials, within fifteen days of your receipt of this letter. Statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

If you are interested in pursuing pre-probable cause conciliation, you should so request in writing. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d). Upon receipt of the request, the Office of General Counsel will make recommendations to the Commission either

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proposing an agreement in settlement of the matter or recommending declining that pre-probable cause conciliation be pursued. The Office of General Counsel may recommend that pre-probable cause conciliation not be entered into at this time so that it may complete its investigation of the matter. Further, requests for pre-probable cause conciliation will not be entertained after briefs on probable cause have been mailed to the respondent.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of General Counsel is not authorized to give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

The investigation now being conducted will be confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

Generation of Matter

On July 16, the Friends of Edd Hargett Committee ("Committee") and Earl Wayne Rountree, III, as treasurer, were referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") for possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act").

Summary of Allegations

The Committee was referred to the Office of General Counsel for failing to disclose outstanding debts and debt payments on various 1985 reports filed with the Commission, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(b).

Factual and Legal Analysis

The Friends of Edd Hargett Committee is the principal campaign committee of Edd Hargett, a candidate in the 1985 run-off election in the First Congressional District of Texas. The basis for this referral is the Committee's failure to disclose

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debts owed to five creditors and debt payments made to one creditor, as required on its 1985 12 Day Pre-runoff, 30 Day Post-runoff and Year End reports.

The Committee filed an amended 30 Day Post-runoff report in 1985. On Schedule D of that report, the Committee disclosed two debts totalling \$43,942.58. These debts were owed to Karl Rove and Company (\$43,156.31) and Praxis List Company (\$786.27). Both of these debts were reported as outstanding at the beginning of the reporting period covered by the 30 Day Post-runoff report, yet neither had been disclosed as outstanding on the Committee's previous Schedule D, as contained in its 12 Day Pre-runoff report. Thus, the Committee failed to disclose the two debts when originally incurred.

The Committee, also on its amended 30 Day Post-runoff report, disclosed three outstanding debts totalling \$30,426.63. As itemized on Schedule D, the closing balance for each of these debts was \$25,000 owed to National Media, Inc., \$4390.04 owed to Ragland's, and \$1733.40 owed to Praxis List Company. On its next report, the 1985 Year End, the Committee failed to disclose any of these debts on Schedule D. According to Schedule B of the same report only a payment of \$696.81 has been made on the Ragland debt, leaving the remainder outstanding. Thus, the Committee failed to disclose these three debts.

Finally, the Committee, also disclosed \$90,036.20 in debt payments to National Media, Inc. on its amended 30 Day Post-runoff report at Schedule B. Schedule D of the same report,

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however, disclosed a \$142,000 debt payment to National Media, Inc. Thus, it appears that the Committee failed to itemize \$51,963.80 in debt payments on Schedule B of its amended 30 Day Post-runoff report.

The amount and nature of outstanding debts owed by a political committee must be disclosed pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(8). Debt payments must also be disclosed pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(5)(A), which requires the disclosure of the name and address of each person to whom an expenditure is made in an amount exceeding \$200, for a committee's operating expenses, together with the date, amount and purpose of this operating expenditure. Additionally, debts owed by a political committee are to be continually reported until extinguished. 11 C.F.R. § 104.11(a).

The Committee failed to disclose, or in some manner misreported, debts owed to five different creditors and debt payments made to one creditor. Two of the debts were reported as outstanding beginning balances on the amended 30 Day Post-runoff report, yet had never been previously disclosed as incurred. Three of the debts were disclosed as outstanding closing balances in the amended 30 Day Post-runoff report, yet were not disclosed on the Committee's next report. Finally, the Committee showed a discrepancy in its debt repayments on its amended 30 Day Post-runoff report, showing a total debt payment of \$142,000 to National Media, Inc., while itemizing only \$90,036 of this amount.

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Thus, the Committee failed to fully disclose its debts and debt payments. Accordingly, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission open a MUR and find reason to believe that the Committee and Earl Wayne Rountree, III, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(5)(A) and § 434(b)(8) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.11(a).

Recommendations

The Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission:

1. Open a MUR.
2. Find reason to believe that the Friends of Edd Hargett Committee and Earl Wayne Rountree, III, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(5)(A) and § 434(b)(8) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.11(a).
3. Approve attached letter.
4. Approve attached factual and legal analysis.

III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to Disclose Debt Payments and Outstanding Debts

The Friends of Ed Hargett Committee (the "Committee") failed to disclose debt payments to a creditor totalling \$51,963.80 on one (1) report and failed to disclose outstanding debts owed to five (5) creditors totalling \$126,342.01 on two (2) reports.

The Committee amended its 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report on January 3, 1986 to disclose two (2) debts with outstanding beginning balances which had not been disclosed as outstanding on Line 10 of the Summary Page and Schedule D of its previous report, the 1985 12 Day Pre-Runoff Report (Attachments 2 and 3).^{1/} These debts totalled \$43,942.58 and were owed to Karl Rove and Company (\$43,156.31) and Praxis List Company (\$786.27).

The amended 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report also disclosed a \$142,000 debt payment to National Media, Inc. on Schedule D; however, Schedule B of the original 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report itemized only \$90,036.20 in debt payments (Attachments 3 and 4). It appeared that the Committee had failed to disclose \$51,963.80 in debt payments on Schedule B. The following table lists the amounts and dates of the debt payments on Schedules B and D:

On February 4, 1986, A Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") was sent to the Committee, which requested clarification regarding the debts which had not been disclosed on the 1985 12 Day Pre-Runoff Report and the debt payments which had not been disclosed on the amended 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report (Attachment 5). No response was received and a Second Notice was mailed to the Committee on February 27, 1986 (Attachment 6).

The Committee's 1985 Year End Report failed to disclose the status of three (3) outstanding debts totalling \$30,426.63 that had been previously itemized on the amended 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report (Attachments 3, 7, 8 and 9). The three (3) debts were not included in the total of debts and obligations on Line 10 of the Summary Page, nor disclosed on Schedule D; and only a partial payment on one of the debts had been itemized on Schedule B. The following table lists the three (3) debts, their closing balances on the amended 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report, debt payments disclosed on Schedule B of the 1985 Year End Report and the amount of debt missing from the 1985 Year End Report:

On March 18, 1986, an RFAI was mailed to the Committee, requesting that its 1985 Year End report be amended to disclose the status of the missing debts (Attachment 10). On March 31, 1986, a telephone call was made by a Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst, to the candidate, Ed Hargett. Mr. Hargett confirmed that the treasurer, Mr. Earl Rountree, had received the letters from the Commission. Mr. Hargett indicated that he would be mailing amendments in on April 11, 1986 (Attachment 11).

Because no response was received for the 1985 Year End Report, a Second Notice was mailed to the Committee on April 10, 1986 (Attachment 12). On July 1, 1986, an attempt by a RAD analyst to contact Mr. Hargett at his home and office was unsuccessful. A message was left at Mr. Hargett's office to contact the RAD analyst regarding the Committee's 1985 reports. The RAD analyst also attempted to contact the treasurer, Mr. Earl Wayne Rountree III, at his office but was told he was unavailable (Attachment 13). On July 3, 1986, the RAD analyst succeeded in contacting Mr. Earl Wayne Rountree III. Mr. Rountree stated that he had thought that Mr. Hargett had mailed the amendments in last April. Mr. Rountree stated that Mr. Hargett was running for a state senate office, and it had been a hectic time for the candidate. Mr. Rountree stated that the amendments were probably sitting in a file, and that he would see to it that the amendments were mailed in immediately (Attachment 14).

As of this date, no response has been received.

On , 1986, the Federal Election Commission determined there is reason to believe the Friends of Edd Hargett Committee and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(5)(A) and § 434(b)(8), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act") and 11 C.F.R. 104.11(a) of the Commission's regulations. The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you and the committee. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials, within fifteen days of your receipt of this letter. Statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against your committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

If you are interested in pursuing pre-probable cause conciliation, you should so request in writing. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d). Upon receipt of the request, the Office of General Counsel will make recommendations to the Commission either

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proposing an agreement in settlement of the matter or recommending declining that pre-probable cause conciliation be pursued. The Office of General Counsel may recommend that pre-probable cause conciliation not be entered into at this time so that it may complete its investigation of the matter. Further, requests for pre-probable cause conciliation will not be entertained after briefs on probable cause have been mailed to the respondent.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of General Counsel is not authorized to give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

The investigation now being conducted will be confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

Summary of Allegations

On July 16, the Friends of Edd Hargett Committee ("Committee") and Earl Wayne Rountree, III, as treasurer, were referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") for possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Committee was referred to the Office of General Counsel for failing to disclose outstanding debts and debt payments on various 1985 reports filed with the Commission, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(b).

Factual Basis and Legal Analysis

The Friends of Edd Hargett Committee is the principal campaign committee of Edd Hargett, a candidate in the 1985 runoff election in the First Congressional District of Texas. The basis for this referral is the Committee's failure to disclose debts owed to five creditors and debt payments made to one creditor, as required on its 1985 12 Day Pre-runoff, 30 Day Post-runoff and Year End reports.

The Committee filed an amended 30 Day Post-runoff report in 1985. On Schedule D of that report, the Committee disclosed two debts totalling \$43,942.58. These debts were owed to Karl Rove and Company (\$43,156.31) and Praxis List Company (\$786.27). Both of these debts were reported as outstanding at the beginning of

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the reporting period covered by the 30 Day Post-runoff report, yet neither had been disclosed as outstanding on the Committee's previous Schedule D, as contained in its 12 Day Pre-runoff report. Thus, the Committee failed to disclose the two debts when originally incurred.

The Committee, also on its amended 30 Day Post-runoff report, disclosed three outstanding debts totalling \$30,426.63. As itemized on Schedule D, the closing balance for each of these debts was \$25,000 owed to National Media, Inc., \$4390.04 owed to Ragland's, and \$1733.40 owed to Praxis List Company. On its next report, the 1985 Year End, the Committee failed to disclose any of these debts on Schedule D. According to Schedule B of the same report only a payment of \$696.81 has been made on the Ragland debt, leaving the remainder outstanding. Thus, the Committee failed to disclose these three debts.

Finally, the Committee, also disclosed \$90,036.20 in debt payments to National Media, Inc. on its amended 30 Day Post-runoff report at Schedule B. Schedule D of the same report, however, disclosed a \$142,000 debt payment to National Media, Inc. Thus, it appears that the Committee failed to itemize \$51,963.80 in debt payments on Schedule B of its amended 30 Day Post-runoff report.

The amount and nature of outstanding debts owed by a political committee must be disclosed pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(8). Debt payments must also be disclosed pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(5)(A), which requires the disclosure of the

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name and address of each person to whom an expenditure is made in an amount exceeding \$200, for a committee's operating expenses, together with the date, amount and purpose of this operating expenditure. Additionally, debts owed by a political committee are to be continually reported until extinguished. 11 C.F.R. § 104.11(a).

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The Committee failed to disclose, or in some manner misreported, debts owed to five different creditors and debt payments made to one creditor. Two of the debts were reported as outstanding beginning balances on the amended 30 Day Post-runoff report, yet had never been previously disclosed as incurred. Three of the debts were disclosed as outstanding closing balances in the amended 30 Day Post-runoff report, yet were not disclosed on the Committee's next report. Finally, the Committee showed a discrepancy in its debt repayments on its amended 30 Day Post-runoff report, showing a total debt payment of \$142,000 to National Media, Inc., while itemizing only \$90,036 of this amount.

Thus, the Committee failed to fully disclose its debts and debt payments. Accordingly, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission open a MUR and find reason to believe that the Committee and Earl Wayne Rountree, III, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(5)(A) and § 434(b)(8) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.11(a).

Failure to Disclose Debt Payments and Outstanding Debts

The Friends of Ed Hargett Committee (the "Committee") failed to disclose debt payments to a creditor totalling \$51,963.80 on one (1) report and failed to disclose outstanding debts owed to five (5) creditors totalling \$126,342.01 on two (2) reports.

The Committee amended its 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report on January 3, 1986 to disclose two (2) debts with outstanding beginning balances which had not been disclosed as outstanding on Line 10 of the Summary Page and Schedule D of its previous report, the 1985 12 Day Pre-Runoff Report (Attachments 2 and 3).^{1/} These debts totalled \$43,942.58 and were owed to Karl Rove and Company (\$43,156.31) and Praxis List Company (\$786.27).

The amended 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report also disclosed a \$142,000 debt payment to National Media, Inc. on Schedule D; however, Schedule B of the original 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report itemized only \$90,036.20 in debt payments (Attachments 3 and 4). It appeared that the Committee had failed to disclose \$51,963.80 in debt payments on Schedule B. The following table lists the amounts and dates of the debt payments on Schedules B and D:

On February 4, 1986, A Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") was sent to the Committee, which requested clarification regarding the debts which had not been disclosed on the 1985 12 Day Pre-Runoff Report and the debt payments which had not been disclosed on the amended 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report (Attachment 5). No response was received and a Second Notice was mailed to the Committee on February 27, 1986 (Attachment 6).

The Committee's 1985 Year End Report failed to disclose the status of three (3) outstanding debts totalling \$30,426.63 that had been previously itemized on the amended 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report (Attachments 3, 7, 8 and 9). The three (3) debts were not included in the total of debts and obligations on Line 10 of the Summary Page, nor disclosed on Schedule D; and only a partial payment on one of the debts had been itemized on Schedule B. The following table lists the three (3) debts, their closing balances on the amended 1985 30 Day Post-Runoff Report, debt payments disclosed on Schedule B of the 1985 Year End Report and the amount of debt missing from the 1985 Year End Report:

On March 18, 1986, an RFAI was mailed to the Committee, requesting that its 1985 Year End report be amended to disclose the status of the missing debts (Attachment 10). On March 31, 1986, a telephone call was made by a Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst, to the candidate, Ed Hargett. Mr. Hargett confirmed that the treasurer, Mr. Earl Rountree, had received the letters from the Commission. Mr. Hargett indicated that he would be mailing amendments in on April 11, 1986 (Attachment 11).

Because no response was received for the 1985 Year End Report, a Second Notice was mailed to the Committee on April 10, 1986 (Attachment 12). On July 1, 1986, an attempt by a RAD analyst to contact Mr. Hargett at his home and office was unsuccessful. A message was left at Mr. Hargett's office to contact the RAD analyst regarding the Committee's 1985 reports. The RAD analyst also attempted to contact the treasurer, Mr. Earl Wayne Rountree III, at his office but was told he was unavailable (Attachment 13). On July 3, 1986, the RAD analyst succeeded in contacting Mr. Earl Wayne Rountree III. Mr. Rountree stated that he had thought that Mr. Hargett had mailed the amendments in last April. Mr. Rountree stated that Mr. Hargett was running for a state senate office, and it had been a hectic time for the candidate. Mr. Rountree stated that the amendments were probably sitting in a file, and that he would see to it that the amendments were mailed in immediately (Attachment 14).

As of this date, no response has been received.
