III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to File a Required Report of Receipts and Disbursements

The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher (the "Committee") has failed to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report of Receipts and Disbursements. Prior Notice was sent on September 19, 1986, informing the Committee that the October Quarterly Report was due on October 15, 1986 (Attachment 2). On November 10, 1986, a letter was received from the candidate, Isaiah Fletcher (Attachment 3). The letter stated that the next report for the period ending September 30, 1986 (October Quarterly Report) would be forwarded to our office within the next two weeks. A Non-Filer Notice was sent to the Committee on November 13, 1986 for failure to file the October Quarterly Report (Attachment 4). The Non-Filer Notice informed the Committee that failure to file this report might result in audit or legal enforcement action.

On December 5, 1986 a Reports Analysis Division analyst attempted to contact Mrs. Fannie Alston, Treasurer. That same day the analyst tried to reach the candidate, but found that the candidate's phone had been disconnected (Attachment 5). The analyst attempted to contact the treasurer on each of the days on and between September 9 and 12, 1986, but was unsuccessful (Attachment 6).

*The Commission was notified of an address change on November 10, 1986.

QUARTERLY REPORT NOTICE

FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION

CANDIDATE COMMITTEES

September 19, 1986

WHO MUST FILE

The principal campaign committee of each Congressional candidate seeking election in 1986 must file a quarterly report by October 15, 1986. All other candidate committees should see below (Semiannual Filers) for their reporting schedule.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

The report must disclose all financial activity that occurred from the close of books for the last report through September 30, 1986. Political committees that have not previously filed a financial disclosure report should report all financial activity through September 30, 1986.* NOTE: In addition, if the campaign has more than one committee, the principal campaign committee must also file a consolidated report (FEC Form 35). For details, see page 14 of the Campaign Guide For Congressional Candidates and Committees, or 11 CFR 104.3(f).

FILING DATE

Reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked no later than midnight October 15, 1986. Reports hand delivered or mailed first class must be received no later than close of business October 15, 1986.

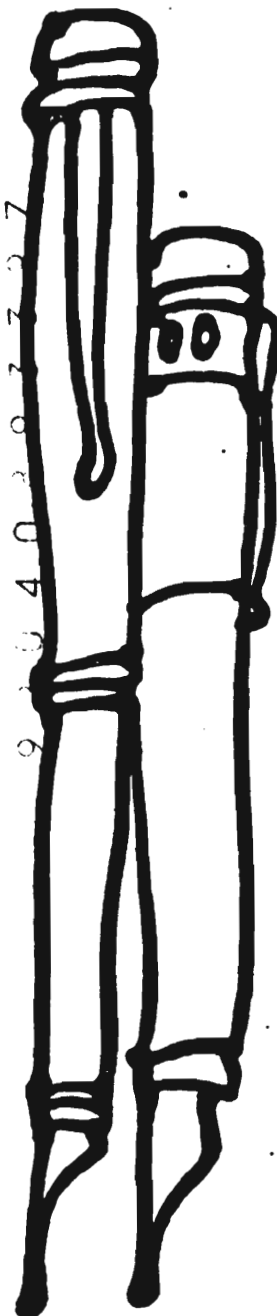
WHERE AND HOW TO FILE

Committees should consult the instructions on the enclosed FEC Form 3, for details.

SEMIANNUAL FILERS

Political Committees authorized by candidates for a Federal election held prior to 1986 or for a future election (i.e., a year other than 1986) need only file a year-end report by January 31, 1987, covering all financial activity from the last report filed through December 31, 1986.

*The first report filed by a committee shall include all amounts received and disbursed prior to reaching the threshold for candidate registration. Activity which occurred prior to 1986, however, should be disclosed separately. See 11 CFR 101.3; 104.3(a) and (b).



A REMINDER

FUTURE REPORTS FOR QUARTERLY FILERS

Principal campaign committees participating in a general election must file a pre-and post-general election report. A notice explaining your filing requirements will be sent to you before the general election.

All committees must file the year-end report by January 31, 1987. The notice explaining this filing requirement will be sent to you after the general election.

COMPLIANCE

Political committees are fully liable for failure to file any report required under the Act. Failure to file in a timely fashion is also a serious violation. Offending committees are subject to enforcement action. Committees must also submit legible reports which can be clearly reproduced. Illegible reports and reports submitted on non-FEC forms will not be accepted, and committees filing such documents will be required to refile.

GENERATION OF MATTER

On December 31, 1986, the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") referred Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer, to the Office of the General Counsel for failure to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report (Attachment 1).

FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

(A) The Facts

Friends of Isaiah Fletcher was notified on September 19, 1986, that the 1986 October Quarterly Report was due by October 15, 1986. On November 10, 1986, a letter was received from the candidate, Isaiah Fletcher, stating that the October

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Quarterly Report would be filed within the next two weeks. On November 13, 1986, a Non-Filer notice was sent to Friends of Isaiah Fletcher for failure to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report. The Non-Filer notice advised that failure to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report might result in an audit or legal enforcement action.

On December 5, 1986, a staff member of RAD attempted to contact the candidate, Isaiah Fletcher, but ascertained that his telephone had been disconnected. On several occasions between December 5 and December 12, 1986, staff of RAD attempted unsuccessfully to contact the treasurer by telephone. At this writing, the 1986 October Quarterly Report has not been filed.

(B) The applicable law

Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii), during any calendar year in which there is a regularly scheduled election for which such candidate is seeking election, or nomination for election, the treasurer of the principal campaign committee of a candidate for the House of Representatives is required to file quarterly reports, which shall be filed no later than the 15th day after the last day of each calendar quarter, and which shall be complete as of the last day of each calendar quarter except that the report for the quarter ending December 31 shall be filed no later than January 31 of the following calendar year.

(c) Application of the law to the facts

The record in this matter demonstrates that the 1986 October Quarterly Report was required to be filed by October 15,

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1986. At this writing, Friends of Isaiah Fletcher has not filed the 1986 October Quarterly Report. In view of this circumstance, it is the recommendation of this Office that the Commission open a Matter Under Review and find reason to believe Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii).

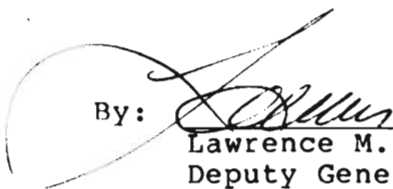

Dear Ms. Alston:

On February 5, 1987, the Federal Election Commission determined that there is reason to believe Friends of Isaiah Fletcher ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The General Counsel's factual and legal analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer. You may submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit any such materials within fifteen days of your receipt of this letter.

In the absence of any additional information which demonstrates that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

If you are interested in pursuing pre-probable cause conciliation, you should so request in writing. See 11 C.F.R. § 111.18(d). Upon receipt of the request, the Office of the General Counsel will make recommendations to the Commission either proposing an agreement in settlement of the matter or recommending declining that pre-probable cause conciliation be pursued. The Office of the General Counsel may recommend that pre-probable cause conciliation not be entered into at this time so that it may complete its investigation of the matter.

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Further, requests for pre-probable cause conciliation will not be entertained after briefs on probable cause have been mailed to the respondent.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel is not authorized to give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address and telephone number of such counsel, and a statement authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

The investigation now being conducted will be confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

For your information, we have attached a brief description of the Commission's procedures for handling possible violations of the Act. If you have any questions, please contact Maura White Callaway, the staff member assigned to this matter, at (202) 376-5690.

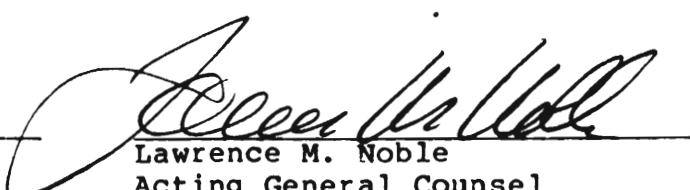

Dear Ms. Alston:

Based on information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, the Federal Election Commission, on February 5, 1987, found reason to believe that The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii), and instituted an investigation in this matter.

After considering all the evidence available to the Commission, the Office of the General Counsel is prepared to recommend that the Commission find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred.

The Commission may or may not approve the General Counsel's recommendation. Submitted for your review is a brief stating the position of the General Counsel on the legal and factual issues of the case. Within 15 days of your receipt of this notice, you may file with the Secretary of the Commission a brief (10 copies if possible) stating your position on the issues and replying to the brief of the General Counsel. (Three copies of such brief should also be forwarded to the Office of the General Counsel, if possible.) The General Counsel's brief and any brief which you may submit will be considered by the Commission before proceeding to a vote of whether there is probable cause to believe a violation has occurred.

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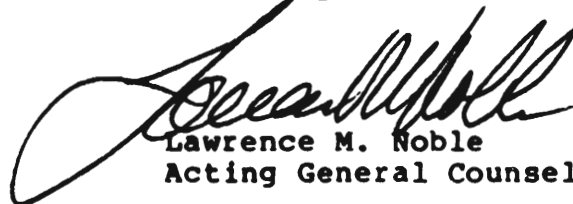

If you are unable to file a responsive brief within 15 days, you may submit a written request to the Commission for an extension of time in which to file a brief. The Commission will not grant any extensions beyond 20 days. All requests for extension of time must be submitted in writing five days prior to the due date. Further, good cause must be shown.

A finding of probable cause to believe requires that the Office of the General Counsel attempt for a period of not less than 30, but not more than 90 days, to settle this matter through a conciliation agreement.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S BRIEF

I. STATEMENT OF THE CASE

This matter arose as a referral from the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD"). The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer ("the Committee"), were referred to the Office of the General Counsel on December 31, 1986, for failure to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report.

The Committee was designated the principal campaign committee for Isaiah Fletcher, pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 432(e)(1). Mr. Fletcher was a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives from the State of Maryland for the 1986 election cycle. He lost the primary election held on September 9, 1986, receiving 35.4 percent of the vote.

The Committee was notified by correspondence from the Commission dated September 19, 1986, that its October Quarterly Report, covering the period from the close of books for its last report through September 30, 1986, was due on October 15, 1986.

A letter was sent on November 13, 1986, informing the Committee it had apparently failed to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report and that said report should be filed immediately. The Committee failed to respond to this letter. The RAD staff made several unsuccessful attempts in December 1986 to contact the treasurer and the candidate by telephone to inform

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them that the October Quarterly Report had not been received. The candidate's telephone had been disconnected.

On February 5, 1987, the Commission found reason to believe that the Committee and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii) by failing to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report. A letter notifying Respondents of the Commission's finding was mailed on February 10, 1987. To date, Respondents have failed to respond to the allegations in the reason to believe finding and have not filed the 1986 October Quarterly Report.

II. ANALYSIS

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act") requires the principal campaign committee of a candidate for the House of Representatives to file quarterly reports in any calendar year during which there is a regularly scheduled election for which the candidate is seeking election. The quarterly reports are in addition to the pre-election and post-election reports required by the Act. The quarterly reports shall be filed no later than the 15th day after the last day of each calendar quarter and shall be complete as of the last day of each calendar quarter. The exception to this filing requirement is that for the quarter ending December 31 the report shall be filed no later than January 31 of the following calendar year. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii).

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In the instant matter, the Committee was informed via regular Commission procedures that its 1986 October Quarterly Report was due no later than October 15, 1986. The Committee was further informed that the report must disclose all financial activity that occurred from the close of books for the last report through September 30, 1986. The last report filed by the Committee covered a period up to and including August 20, 1986. Therefore, its 1986 October Quarterly Report should include financial activity from August 21, 1986 through September 30, 1986. A non-filer notice was mailed to the Committee on December 13, 1986, when the report was not received by the due date. Other attempts to contact the treasurer or the candidate have not been successful.

Although the Committee has not responded to the reason to believe finding, it is clear that it is aware of the filing requirements. In a letter from Mr. Fletcher, the candidate, dated November 4, 1986, the Commission staff was informed that the report for the period ending September 30, 1986 was forthcoming. That report, however, was never received by the Commission.

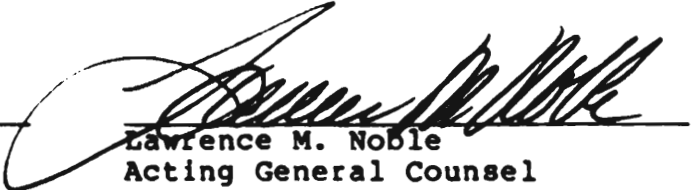
By failing to file its 1986 October Quarterly Report the Committee is, and continues to be, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii).

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

This matter arose as a referral from the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD"). The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer ("the Committee"), were referred to the Office of the General Counsel on December 31, 1986, for failure to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report.

The Committee was designated the principal campaign committee for Isaiah Fletcher, pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 432(e)(1). Mr. Fletcher was a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives from the State of Maryland for the 1986 election cycle. He lost the primary election held on September 9, 1986, receiving 35.4 percent of the vote.

The Committee was notified on September 19, 1986, that its October Quarterly Report, which should have covered the period from the close of books for its last report through September 30, 1986, was due on October 15, 1986.^{1/}

A second notice was sent on November 13, 1986, informing the Committee that it had failed to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report and that said report should be filed immediately. The

^{1/} The respondents filed a Pre-Primary Election Report, covering the period from July 1, 1986, to August 20, 1986.

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Committee failed to respond to this notice. The RAD staff made several unsuccessful attempts in December 1986 to contact the treasurer and the candidate by telephone, to inform them that the October Quarterly Report had not been received. The candidate's telephone had been disconnected.

On February 5, 1987, the Commission found reason to believe that the Committee and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii) by failing to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report. A letter notifying Respondents of the Commission's finding was mailed on February 10, 1987. Respondents did not reply to that notification. On May 13, 1987, the General Counsel's Brief, recommending a finding of probable cause, was mailed to Respondents. To date, Respondents have failed to answer the Brief or to contact the Office of the General Counsel.

II. ANALYSIS

This Office relies upon its analysis set forth in the General Counsel's Brief of May 12, 1987.

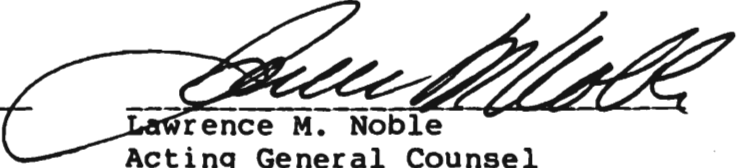

On August 18, 1987, the Federal Election Commission found that there is probable cause to believe that The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, in connection with the failure to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report.

The Commission has a duty to attempt to correct such violations for a period of 30 to 90 days by informal methods of conference, conciliation, and persuasion, and by entering into a conciliation agreement with a respondent. 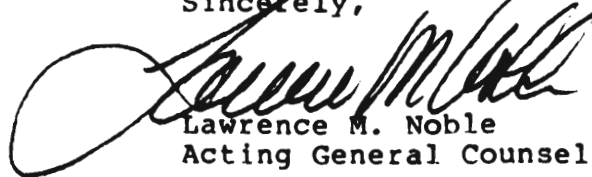

On March 10, 1988, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found probable cause to believe that The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii). On that same date, you were sent a conciliation agreement offered by the Commission in settlement of this matter.

Please note that pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i), the conciliation period in this matter may not extend for more than 90 days, but may cease after 30 days. Our records indicate that the above notification and conciliation agreement were received on March 18, 1988. Therefore, your response should be in this office no later than the close of business on April 18, 1988. The Commission is still hopeful that this matter can be settled through a conciliation agreement. However, if 30 days should elapse without a response from you, a recommendation concerning the filing of a civil suit will be made to the Commission by the Office of General Counsel.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

This matter arose as a referral from the Reports Analysis Division. The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer ("Respondents"), were referred to the Office of the General Counsel on December 31, 1986, for failure to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report. The last report filed by Respondents was the 1986 Pre-Primary Report, covering the period from July 1, 1986, through August 20, 1986. Mr. Fletcher was a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives from the State of Maryland in the 1986 election cycle. He lost the primary election held on September 9, 1986, receiving 35.4 percent of the vote.

On February 5, 1987, the Commission found reason to believe Respondents violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii). A letter notifying Respondents of the Commission's finding was mailed on February 10, 1987. That letter was mailed to Respondents at the candidate's home address, in accordance with Mr. Fletcher's request in a letter to the Commission dated November 4, 1986, which also amended the Statement of Organization to name Ms. Alston as the new treasurer. Attachment I. Respondents did not reply to that notification.

On May 13, 1987, the General Counsel's Brief, which recommended that the Commission find probable cause to believe a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii) had occurred,

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was mailed to the treasurer at her home address, with a copy sent to Mr. Fletcher. Neither Respondents nor the candidate replied to the General Counsel's Brief.

On August 18, 1987, the Commission found probable cause to believe a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii) had occurred and approved a proposed conciliation agreement. Notification of the Commission's action and a copy of the conciliation agreement were mailed, certified, return receipt requested, on August 20, 1987, to the treasurer at her home address. A certified copy was also mailed to the candidate. Ms. Alston received the notification on August 28, 1987, and called this Office on that same date. She informed staff that she had not received the previous notifications regarding this matter; that she had been hospitalized; that she had agreed to act as treasurer until a new one was appointed, but she was not informed of the Committee's activities; that the Committee as a group had ceased functioning in September 1986; and finally, that she would discuss this matter with Mr. Fletcher, then call this Office again. On September 1, 1987, Ms. Alston telephoned and stated that she had talked with Mr. Fletcher, who had not yet received his copy of the probable cause notification. She stated further that Mr. Fletcher said he would send a written response to the Commission. Ms. Alston also stated that she intended to resign from her position as treasurer.

When no written response was received in this Office from the treasurer or the candidate, a second notice regarding the

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lapse of time for conciliation was mailed to Ms. Alston, with a copy to Mr. Fletcher, on September 29, 1987.^{1/} By a letter dated October 5, 1987, Ms. Alston resigned her position as treasurer and returned the unsigned conciliation agreement. Attachment II. Ms. Alston was contacted by this Office via telephone to inform her of the receipt of her information and that no response had been received from Mr. Fletcher. She stated that Mr. Fletcher informed her that he had sent a letter and, also that to her knowledge, he may have the Committee's books and records. On October 23, 1987, this Office received a copy of Mr. Fletcher's letter to this Office, which was mailed by Ms. Alston. Attachment III. The original of Mr. Fletcher's letter has never been received by this Office.

In his letter, Mr. Fletcher stated that he and his wife are separated and that she absconded from their home with all the furniture, including his desk which contained information about his campaign committee. Mr. Fletcher also stated that he was not receiving his mail, which apparently goes into his wife's postal box. Mr. Fletcher stated that he is attempting to recover his property through legal action. The letter included a new mailing address for Mr. Fletcher. This Office then began preparing a package of information to be forwarded to him at this new address. The package included correspondence regarding the

^{1/} The letter to Mr. Fletcher was returned to this Office on October 27, 1987, as unclaimed. This letter had been mailed certified. It is the only one to be returned to this Office.

Commission's and this Office's actions in this matter including notification of the reason to believe finding, the General Counsel's Brief, notification of the probable cause finding and notifications regarding conciliation of this matter.

On October 28, 1987, Mr. Fletcher contacted the Office of the General Counsel via telephone. He was informed of the history and current status of this matter. He repeated his circumstances as stated in his letter regarding his inability to obtain his property. Mr. Fletcher gave this Office his post office box number and a work telephone number where he can be contacted, and stated that he can receive mail at the address on his letter, which is his place of employment. He stated that he would respond promptly to the information that was being mailed by this Office.^{2/}

Meanwhile, Ms. Alston contacted this Office via telephone on October 27, 1986, and requested information about procedures for filing the 1986 October Quarterly Report. However, without access to the Committee's records, it is doubtful that this Report can be accurate.^{3/} The information on the filing procedures was shared with Ms. Alston, including a referral to the Reports Analysis Division.

^{2/} The package of information was mailed certified, return receipt requested to Mr. Fletcher's work address and copies were also mailed to his post office box. The receipt for the certified mail sent to his work address was returned to this Office on November 9, 1987; it was signed by an apparent member of the staff on November 3, 1987. Mr. Fletcher was granted ten days from the date of receipt of the information to respond.

On November 13, 1987, this Office received a letter from Ms. Alston, with attachments, including copies of reports intended to satisfy the filing requirements for the 1986 October Quarterly and Year End Reports and the 1987 Mid-Year Report. Attachment IV. In her letter, Ms. Alston restated her position and did not provide any new information which would resolve this matter. The reports included in the mailing consisted of a new Summary Page for each reporting period attached to a copy of the 1986 Pre-Primary Report. The Reports Analyst, who was also forwarded a copy of these materials by Ms. Alston, stated that these reports do not constitute new filings on behalf of the Committee.

Mr. Fletcher has not yet responded in writing or via telephone to the information mailed by this Office. Therefore, unless a written response is received from Mr. Fletcher within a few days and no later than November 30, 1986, this Office will prepare a new brief recommending a probable cause to believe finding against Mr. Fletcher, acting as treasurer, and a report recommending no further action against Ms. Alston, as treasurer.

Ms. Alston), Respondents disclosed \$6,075.45 in receipts and \$8,522.43 in expenditures. An ending cash-on-hand of \$1,160.98, and \$5,800.00 in debts and obligations owed by the Committee were reported.

This Office makes no recommendations regarding this matter at this time.

Dear Ms Robinson:

I received from your office two (2) copies of a letter from Ms Lerner, dated October 30, 1987, along with documents which are copies of correspondence, ostensibly, showing that you have been trying for some time to contact me relative to the belated submission of reports due to FEC. Additionally, during the past week, I have received two telephone messages that you have called, expressing the urgency and importance of my contacting you. In neither of the situations have I tried to ignore the contacts. Permit me to explain my dilemma, as I tried to explain to you when we talked on the telephone.

While my personal business is of no importance to FEC, my marital situation presently does affect what I am able to do relative to the submission of reports. My wife, who was my campaign manager, decided to separate from me shortly after the losing effort. On several visitations to our jointly-owned house, she returned and literally cleaned out the house, including my best clothing for which she had no obvious use. She has on two occasions tried to have me incarcerated on false charges. I can only presume that her taking and retaining my campaign materials is another effort to get me in trouble. I have tried to have her served with Orders of Replevin, seeking to have her return certain items to me, including my desk in which important FEC documents were filed. Not knowing where she lives, I have been unsuccessful in these attempts. I know for whom she works, but I must have specific information as to her work location before she can be served. Regarding your telephone messages, I work in a public school system as a teacher; there is no way in which I can return your calls in an expeditious manner. On a couple of occasions when I have tried to reach you after school hours, I have been unsuccessful in trying to get through.

The only solution which I see to my dilemma, as far as conversing with you is concerned, is for me to take a day off from work and come to Washington to see you. I would appreciate your writing or calling my school to leave specific information as to your location and the best day to stop and converse with you. (Please give me at least a day's notice as I shall have to arrange for a substitute teacher.

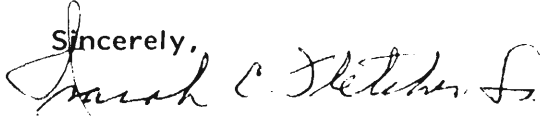

Dear Mr. Fletcher:

Based on information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, the Federal Election Commission, on February 5, 1987, found reason to believe that The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher ("the Committee") and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii), and instituted an investigation in this matter. On August 18, 1987, the Commission found probable cause to believe that the Committee and Ms. Alston, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii).

After considering all the evidence available to the Commission, the Office of the General Counsel is prepared to recommend that the Commission find probable cause to believe that you, acting as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii).

The Commission may or may not approve the General Counsel's recommendation. Submitted for your review is a brief stating the position of the General Counsel on the legal and factual issues of the case. Within 15 days of your receipt of this notice, you may file with the Secretary of the Commission a brief (10 copies if possible) stating your position on the issues and replying to the brief of the General Counsel. (Three copies of such brief

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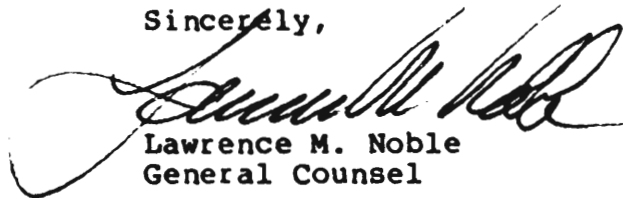

should also be forwarded to the Office of the General Counsel, if possible.) The General Counsel's brief and any brief which you may submit will be considered by the Commission before proceeding to a vote of whether there is probable cause to believe a violation has occurred.

All requests for extension of time must be submitted in writing five days prior to the due date, and good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel ordinarily will not give extensions beyond 20 days.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEF

I. STATEMENT OF THE CASE

This matter arose as a referral from the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD"). The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer ("the Committee"), were referred to the Office of the General Counsel on December 31, 1986, for failing to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report.

The Committee was designated the principal campaign committee for Isaiah Fletcher, pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 432(e)(1). Mr. Fletcher was a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives from the State of Maryland for the 1986 election cycle. He lost the primary election held on September 9, 1986, receiving 35.4 percent of the vote. The Committee was notified by correspondence from the Commission dated September 19, 1986, that its October Quarterly Report, covering the period from the close of books for its last report through September 30, 1986, was due on October 15, 1986. The Committee failed to respond to this and a subsequent notification.

On February 5, 1987, the Commission found reason to believe the Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii). A letter notifying Respondents of the Commission's finding was mailed on February 10, 1987. That letter was mailed to Respondents at the candidate's home address, in accordance with Mr. Fletcher's

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request in a letter to the Commission dated November 4, 1986, which also amended the Statement of Organization to name Ms. Alston as the new treasurer. There was no response to that notification.

On May 13, 1987, the General Counsel's Brief, which recommended that the Commission find probable cause to believe a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii) had occurred, was mailed to Ms. Alston at her home address, with a copy sent to Mr. Fletcher. Neither replied to the General Counsel's Brief.

On August 18, 1987, the Commission found probable cause to believe The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii) and approved a proposed conciliation agreement. Notification of the Commission's action and a copy of the conciliation agreement were mailed, certified, return receipt requested, on August 20, 1987, to Ms. Alston at her home address. A certified copy was also mailed to the candidate. Ms. Alston received the notification on August 28, 1987, and called this Office on that same date. She informed staff that she had agreed to act as treasurer until a new one was appointed, but she was not informed of the Committee's activities; that the Committee as a group had ceased functioning in September 1986; and that she would discuss this matter with Mr. Fletcher. On September 1, 1987, Ms. Alston telephoned and stated that she had talked with Mr. Fletcher, who would send a written response to the Commission. Ms. Alston also stated that she intended to resign her position as treasurer.

When no written response was received in this Office from the treasurer or the candidate, a second notice regarding the lapse of time for conciliation was mailed to Ms. Alston, with a copy to Mr. Fletcher, on September 29, 1987.^{1/} By a letter dated October 5, 1987, Ms. Alston resigned her position as treasurer and returned the unsigned conciliation agreement. In a follow-up telephone conversation Ms. Alston stated that Mr. Fletcher may have the Committee's books and records. On October 23, 1987, this Office received a copy of Mr. Fletcher's letter to this Office, which was mailed by Ms. Alston. The original of Mr. Fletcher's letter has never been received by this Office.

In his letter, Mr. Fletcher stated that he and his wife are separated and that she absconded from their home with all the furniture, including his desk which contained information about his campaign committee. Mr. Fletcher also stated that he was not receiving his mail, which apparently goes into his wife's postal box. Mr. Fletcher stated that he was attempting to recover his property through legal action. The letter included a new mailing address for Mr. Fletcher. This Office then began preparing a package of information to be forwarded to him at this new address. The package included correspondence regarding the Commission's and this Office's actions in this matter, including

notification of the reason to believe finding, the first General Counsel's Brief, notification of the probable cause finding and notifications regarding conciliation of this matter.

On October 28, 1987, Mr. Fletcher contacted the Office of the General Counsel via telephone. He was informed of the history and current status of this matter. He repeated his circumstances as stated in his letter regarding his inability to obtain his property. He stated that he would respond promptly to the information that was being mailed by this Office.

In response to messages left by this Office at his place of employment, Mr. Fletcher called on November 30, 1987. He stated that he had sent a letter in response to the information mailed. Staff discussed the possibility of reconstructing the Committee's financial activity through a review of the Committee's bank records. He stated that he would try to obtain copies of the reporting forms and would attempt to gather the relevant data.

On December 7, 1987, this Office received a letter from Mr. Fletcher. This letter did not contain any new information which would resolve this matter.

It is apparent from the responses received from the treasurer, Ms. Alston, and the candidate, Mr. Fletcher, that Ms. Alston does not now, nor has she ever had access to and control over the books and records of the Committee. Although Mr. Fletcher states that he does not have actual possession of these books and records at this time, it appears that he had access to and control over them during Ms. Alston's tenure as

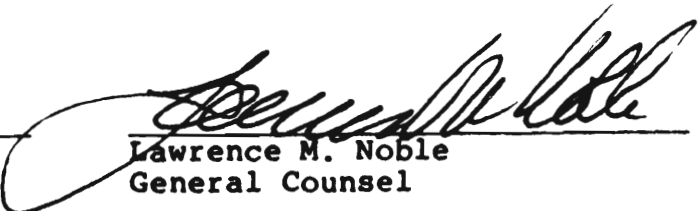
treasurer, and that at present he is the party who can obtain information on the Committee's financial activity. As such, Isaiah Fletcher, Sr., the candidate, has been acting as treasurer for his campaign committee. By failing to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report the Committee and Mr. Fletcher, acting as treasurer, are in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii).

III. GENERAL COUNSEL'S RECOMMENDATION

Find probable cause to believe Isaiah Fletcher, Sr., acting as treasurer of The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii).

I. BACKGROUND

The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher ("the Committee") and its then treasurer of record, Fannie E.C. Alston, were referred to the Office of the General Counsel on December 31, 1986, by the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD"), for failing to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report. On February 5, 1987, the Commission found reason to believe the Committee and Ms. Alston, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii); and on August 18, 1987, the Commission found probable cause to believe that such a violation had occurred.

Establishing communication with Ms. Alston and the candidate, Mr. Fletcher, has been problematic throughout the investigation of this matter. After failing to respond to notifications regarding the reason to believe finding and the General Counsel's Brief, Ms. Alston contacted this Office for the first time on August 28, 1987, upon receipt of the notification of the probable cause to believe finding. Following subsequent conversations with Ms. Alston and eventually with Mr. Fletcher, it became apparent that Ms. Alston had never assumed her full responsibilities as treasurer of the Committee. Ms. Alston explained that her role as treasurer was intended to be a temporary position. She stated that she did not have direct

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involvement in the Committee's financial activity, nor did she have control over the Committee's books and records, although she signed the amended 1986 Pre-Primary Report, which was filed on November 10, 1986. She also stated that at no time during her tenure as the Committee's treasurer did she have access to the Committee's bank account or bank records. It appears that Mr. Fletcher maintained general control over, and possession of, the Committee's books and records throughout Ms. Alston's tenure as treasurer. Ms. Alston resigned from the treasurer's position by a letter dated October 5, 1987. See, MUR 2344--General Counsel's Report, signed November 24, 1987. Therefore, this Office recommends that the Commission take no further action against Ms. Alston, as treasurer of the Committee, and close the file as it pertains to her.

Mr. Fletcher has stated that, at present, he does not have possession of the Committee's records, as they are among his items being held by his estranged wife. On November 30, 1987, staff from this Office discussed with Mr. Fletcher the possibility of reconstructing the Committee's financial activity for reporting purposes. When such information was not provided, this Office mailed its Supplemental Brief to Mr. Fletcher on January 15, 1988, which recommended a finding of probable cause to believe that he, acting as treasurer of the Committee, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii).

This Office received a letter and a 1987 Year-End Report, covering the period from October 1, 1986 through December 31,

1987, signed by Mr. Fletcher in the capacity of treasurer, on January 6, 1988. Attachment I. The total receipts and disbursements disclosed in this report is "0" and the beginning and ending cash-on-hand is \$5.25. Although no debts and obligations are listed, loans obtained from two individuals totalling \$1,500 are disclosed, and a loan of \$3,000 from the candidate is also disclosed. The RAD Analyst has stated that there are certain questions about this report which will require a Request for Additional Information. It should be noted that the 1987 Year-End Report does not include financial activity which occurred during the period covered by the October Quarterly Report (August 21, 1986 through September 30, 1986), which is the subject of this matter.

II. ANALYSIS

This Office relies on its analysis as set forth in its Supplemental Brief of January 15, 1988. It is also noted that, since Ms. Alston resigned as treasurer and Mr. Fletcher signed the 1987 Year-End Report in that capacity, he is listed in the Commission's public records as the current treasurer of the Committee.

III. DISCUSSION OF CONCILIATION AND CIVIL PENALTY

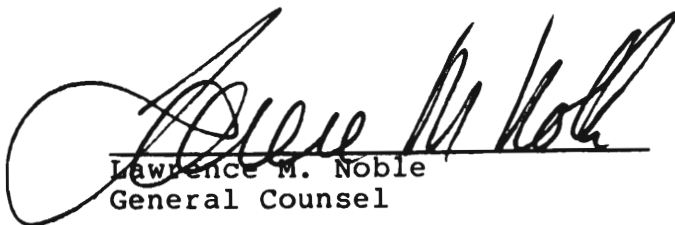

On August 18, 1987, the Federal Election Commission found probable cause to believe that The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). On March 8, 1988, the Federal Election Commission found probable cause to believe that you, as treasurer of The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii), in connection with the failure to file the 1986 October Quarterly Report.

The Commission has a duty to attempt to correct such violations for a period of 30 to 90 days by informal methods of conference, conciliation, and persuasion, and by entering into a conciliation agreement with a respondent. If we are unable to reach an agreement during that period, the Commission may institute a civil suit in United States District Court and seek payment of a civil penalty.

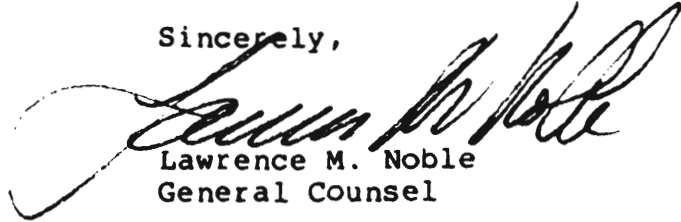

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

This matter arose as a referral from the Reports Analysis Division on December 31, 1986, due to the non-filing of the 1986 October Quarterly Report. On August 18, 1987, the Commission found probable cause to believe The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and Fannie E.C. Alston, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii). The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher is the principal campaign committee for Isaiah Fletcher, Sr., who was a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives from the State of Maryland in the 1986 election cycle.

On March 8, 1988, on the basis of facts presented by Ms. Alston and Mr. Fletcher, the Commission determined to take no further action against Ms. Alston as it pertains to this matter. On that same date the Commission found probable cause to believe that Isaiah Fletcher, Sr., as treasurer of the Friends of Isaiah Fletcher, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2)(A)(iii); the Commission also approved a conciliation agreement.

The notification of the probable cause to believe finding and the conciliation agreement were mailed to Mr. Fletcher on March 10, 1988. As evidenced by the return receipt, the

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notification was received on March 18, 1988. A letter was mailed on April 4, 1988, reminding Mr. Fletcher of the time limits for negotiating a conciliation agreement, and of the possibility of this Office filing a civil suit. On April 18, 1988, staff attempted to contact Mr. Fletcher via telephone at his workplace, but he was not available. To date, Mr. Fletcher has not returned the call.

II. DISCUSSION OF CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

Although Mr. Fletcher responded to the probable cause to believe finding made on August 18, 1987, he has not communicated with this Office with regard to the more recent probable cause finding against him as treasurer, or to the conciliation agreement. It is noted that establishing continuous communication with Respondents has been a problem throughout the processing of this matter.

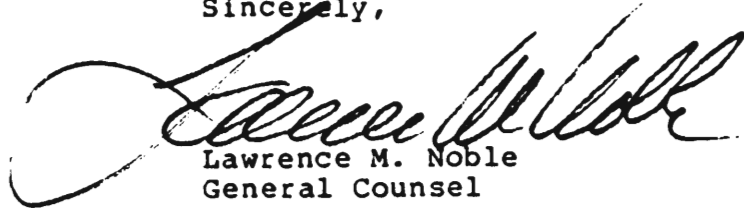

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Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6)(B),
for which both defendants shall be jointly and severally liable;

Fletcher, Sr., as treasurer shall pay the Commission its costs
in this action; and

(4) Defendants The Friends of Isaiah Fletcher and Isaiah
