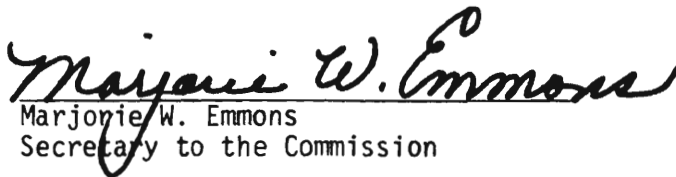

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATION

In a memorandum to the Office of General Counsel dated October 19, 1976, Reports Examining Section indicated that its review of reports of Citizens for the period January 1, 1976 to September 30, 1976 revealed:

- 1) Respondent has exceeded the New Hampshire state expenditure limit of \$220,200 by \$11,640.94 based upon reports filed with the Commission.
- 2) A discrepancy of \$13,701.35 in the total expenditures allocable to New

After this matter was originally brought to the attention of the Commission on November 1, 1976, Reports Examining advised the office of General Counsel that a letter and accompanying adjustments dated August 30, 1976 from the treasurer of Citizens for Reagan appeared to explain the \$13,701.35 discrepancy. Since this expenditure is strictly a fundraising expense it has been transferred to Line 23.

4. Form 3C of this report (June amended) represents several adjustments which can be summarized as follows:
- a. A number of checks were voided, many of which represented previously allocated expenses. The particular states have been credited with these amounts.
 - b. A \$10,000 payment to Miami Villa Hotel in Florida had, in May, been incorrectly charged to New Hampshire. This error has been corrected.
 - c. The fundraising expense of adjustment #3 (above), amounting to \$1,033.78 previously charged to New Hampshire has been credited to this state since fundraising expenditures are not charged against state limitations.
 - d. In May and June expenses totalling \$2,667.57 representing expenses incurred and subsequently repaid by the press, were allocated entirely to the state of New Hampshire. These expenses have been properly reallocated to the 50 states, as are all press relates.
5. In April, May and June a variety of expenses disbursed from our California office, were reported on Line 20. They were actually fundraising expenses. Each is itemized below and the total has been transferred from Line 20 to Line 23.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATION

1) Respondent has exceeded the New Hampshire state expenditure limit of \$220,200 by \$11,640.94 based upon reports filed with the Commission.

2) A discrepancy of \$13,701.35 in the total expenditures allocable to New Hampshire between the June and July 1976 reports exists.

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

1) Presidential candidates eligible to receive payments under 26 U.S.C. §9033 are limited in the amount of expenditures they can make in the aggregate and on a state-by-state basis under 2 U.S.C. §441a(b)(1)(A). The cumulative total of expenditures, reported under "this period" for each report, reveals expenditures totaling \$231,840.94-\$11,640.94 over the limit. 2) There appears an unexplained discrepancy of \$13,701.35 between the June 1976 and the July 1976 reports.

This notification is sent to you as a result of an examination of the reports filed by you with respect to the state by state allocation of expenditures. The Commission has examined these reports and has reason to believe that violations of 2 U.S.C. §§441a(b)(1)(A) and 434(b) have occurred. We have numbered this matter MUR 287 (76).

Specifically, the total expenditures for New Hampshire, reported under "this period" for each Form 3c, reveals expenditures of \$231,840.94, \$11,640.94 over the New Hampshire state limit of \$220,200. There is also an unexplained discrepancy of \$13,701.35 between the June 1976 and the July 1976 reports (copies are attached).

Under the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the Act), you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you. Please submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's analysis of this matter.

The Commission is under a duty to investigate this matter expeditiously; therefore, your response should be submitted within 10 days after receipt of this notification. If you have any questions, please contact Gloria R. Sulton (telephone no. 202/382-4041), the attorney assigned to this case.

Attached is a breakdown by state of the expenditures made by Ford, Carter, and Reagan. These figures were obtained from the committees' 3c reports covering the period 1/1/75 to 9/30/76. Based upon an analysis of the 3c reports, Citizens For Reagan was the only presidential committee to exceed the state limitations for presidential candidates.

The Citizens For Reagan appears to have surpassed the state limitation in New Hampshire by \$11,640.94. The expenditure limitation in New Hampshire is \$220,200.00 based upon the formula found in 2 U.S.C. 441 a(b). The cumulative total of expenditures, reported under "this period" for each report, reveals that Citizens For Reagan have spent \$231,840.94.

During analysis, a discrepancy was noted in the Citizens For Reagan 3c report for the months of June and July. In June they listed \$167,210.02 as the aggregate year (76) to date expenditures in New Hampshire. In July, Citizens For Reagan listed -0- expenditures in New Hampshire. Therefore, their aggregate should have remained constant. Instead, they listed year to date expenditures of \$153,508.67, an unexplained aggregate decline in expenditures of \$13,701.35. By carrying forward the reduced aggregate total the committee reported \$155,264.10 on its October 10 report in aggregate year to date expenditures in New Hampshire rather than the \$168,965.45 total reflected in the committee's reports for each period.

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Attached is a breakdown by state of the expenditures made by Ford, Carter, and Reagan. These figures were obtained from the committees' 3c reports covering the period 1/1/75 to 9/30/76. Based upon an analysis of the 3c reports, Citizens For Reagan was the only presidential committee to exceed the state limitations for presidential candidates.

The Citizens For Reagan appears to have surpassed the state limitation in New Hampshire by \$11,640.94. The expenditure limitation in New Hampshire is \$220,200.00 based upon the formula found in 2 U.S.C. 441 a(b). The cumulative total of expenditures, reported under "this period" for each report, reveals that Citizens For Reagan have spent \$231,840.94.

During analysis, a discrepancy was noted in the Citizens For Reagan 3c report for the months of June and July. In June they listed \$167,210.02 as the aggregate year (76) to date expenditures in New Hampshire. In July, Citizens For Reagan listed -0- expenditures in New Hampshire. Therefore, their aggregate should have remained constant. Instead, they listed year to date expenditures of \$153,508.67, an unexplained aggregate decline in expenditures of \$13,701.35. By carrying forward the reduced aggregate total the committee reported \$155,264.10 on its October 10 report in aggregate year to date expenditures in New Hampshire rather than the \$168,965.45 total reflected in the committee's reports for each period.

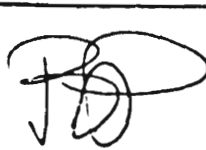
