SUBJECT: UNAUTHORIZED QUARTERLY FILERS WHICH FAILED TO FILE
THE 1988 12 DAY PRE-GENERAL REPORT BY ELECTION DAY

The attached list of unauthorized committees consists of thirty-seven (37) quarterly filers which failed to file a 1988 12 Day Pre-General Report by Election Day, November 8, 1988. In accordance with Standard of the RAD Review and Referral Procedures for Unauthorized Committees, further examination is required by your office.

Unlike the mandatory reporting requirement placed upon monthly filers, 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(4)(A)(ii) requires quarterly filers to submit 12 Day Pre-General Reports only if the committees make contributions to or expenditures on behalf of federal candidates in the general election. All unauthorized committees were sent prior notification regarding the pre- and post-general filing requirements on October 3, 1988 (Attachment 38).

The Party/Non-Party Branch conducted a thorough examination to identify quarterly filers disclosing contributions or expenditures between October 1 and October 19, 1988. The research revealed committees that submitted:

- a) 12 Day Pre-General Reports in an untimely manner;
- b) 30 Day Post-General Reports indicating that 12 Day Pre-General Reports should have been filed; and
- c) Year End Reports indicating that 12 Day Pre-General Reports should have been filed.

I. GENERATION OF MATTER

The Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") referred the above (37) committees to the Office of the General Counsel on June 16, 1989. (Attachment 1). The basis for the attached referral is

the committees' failure to file the 12 Day Pre-General Report by October 27, 1988.

II. FACTUAL AND LEGAL ANALYSIS

A. Filing of Reports

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), provides that for unauthorized committees filing quarterly, such committees shall submit 12 Day Pre-General Reports if the Committees make any contributions to or expenditures on behalf of federal candidates in the general election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii). The 12 Day Pre-General Report is due as of the 12th day before the election (October 27, 1988) and should be complete as of the 20th day before the election (October 19, 1988). The Committees were notified on October 3, 1988, that the report was due on October 27, 1988.

The (37) committees fall into three categories;

(1) committees that filed 12 Day Pre-General Reports in an untimely manner, (2) committees that filed 30 Day Post-General Reports indicating that 12 Day Pre-General Reports should have been filed, and (3) committees that filed Year End Reports indicating that 12 Day Pre-General Reports should have been filed. The following Committees did not file the 1988 12 Day Pre-General Report by October 27, 1988:

III. DISCUSSION OF CONCILIATION AND CIVIL PENALTY

This Office also recommends that the Commission offer to enter into conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe with respect to the (37) referred committees. Attached for the Commission's approval are proposed conciliation agreements (Attachment 2). The proposed agreements provide for an admission of the violation and civil penalties computed as follows:

Dear Mr. Bradbury:

On August 22, 1989, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe National Association for Uniformed Services PAC ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer. You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information demonstrating that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing pre-probable cause conciliation and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.

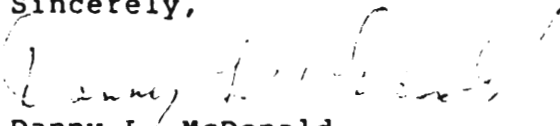
Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel ordinarily will not give extensions beyond 20 days.

If you intend to be represented by counsel in this matter, please advise the Commission by completing the enclosed form stating the name, address, and telephone number of such counsel, and authorizing such counsel to receive any notifications and other communications from the Commission.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. §§ 437g(a)(4)(B) and 437g(a)(12)(A), unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

For your information, we have attached a brief description of the Commission's procedures for handling possible violations of the Act. If you have any questions, please contact Frania Monarski, the attorney assigned to this matter, at (202) 376-8200.

On September 6, 1989, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission determined to enter into negotiations directed toward reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. On that same date you were sent a conciliation agreement offered by the Commission in settlement of this matter.

Please note that conciliation negotiations entered into prior to a finding of probable cause to believe are limited to a maximum of 30 days. To date, you have not responded to the proposed agreement. The 30 day period for negotiations will soon expire. Dear Ms. Monarski

Yesterday my NAUS contact, Charles Partridge, faxed the documentation on this case to me. He had called last week about it and I could not resolve the issues except for the following conclusions which remain unchanged today.

1. I was, indeed, late in filing the 12-day pre election report. In fact, I was completely oblivious to it and never filed one at all. A 12-day pre-election report is enclosed.

2. The report period appears to cover the period of 1 OCT 88 through 19 OCT 88. As you note, this period was covered in my "Thirtieth day report following the General Election". When I refer to that report and extract the data for the period 1 OCT - 19 OCT 88, I cannot match the figures your Conciliation Agreement notes for the relevant reporting period, i.e.,

\$105.13 in receipts

\$294.64 in disbursements.

As noted in the enclosed report, for the period of 1 Oct - 19 Oct 1988 we had no receipts and disbursed \$100.00 in a campaign contribution (4 Oct 88),

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My records for the "Thirtieth day report" shows \$ 328.54 interest income from Dean Miller Sears Liquid Assets fund for the period 1 Oct 88 - 28 Nov 88. However, the dividends are credited to our account at the end of each month so for the period 1 Oct - 19 Oct 88 we would report no income.

I think that in summary I would say - "Yes, I failed to file the report in question." The total funds involved for the relevant reporting period were \$ 100.00. I would like to see no action taken against me and the committee.

2. Close the file.

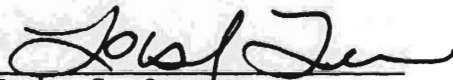

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that the National Association for Uniformed Services and James W. Bradbury, as treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. National Association for Uniformed Services PAC is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4).

2. James W. Bradbury is the treasurer of National Association for Uniformed Services PAC.

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3. Section 434(a)(4)(A)(ii) of Title 2 provides that unauthorized committees filing quarterly shall file 12 Day Pre-General Reports if the committee makes any contributions to or expenditures on behalf of federal candidates in the general election. The pre-election reports are to be filed no later than the 12th day before the election and should be complete as of the 20th day before the election.

4. Respondents were required to file the 1988 12 Day Pre-General Report no later than October 27, 1988. Respondents did not file the 12 Day Pre-General Report until December 7, 1988, 41 days late, disclosing \$0 in receipts and \$100 in disbursements for the relevant reporting period.

V. Respondents failed to file the 1988 12 Day Pre-General Report in a timely fashion in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(ii).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has

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approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirements contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

X. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.
