III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to File Forty-Eight Hour Notifications

The Committee to Elect Marc Morial for Congress ("the Committee") has failed to file the required Forty-Eight (48) Hour Notifications ("48-Hour Notices") for candidate loans totalling \$25,000 received prior to the 1990 Primary Election and twenty-one (21) contributions/loans totalling \$75,500 received prior to the 1990 General Election.

The candidate was involved in the 1990 Primary and General Elections held on October 6, 1990 and November 6, 1990, respectively. Prior Notice for the 1990 Primary Election was sent to the Committee on August 31, 1990 (Attachment 2). The Notice includes a section titled "Last-Minute Contributions". This section states "Committees must also file special notices on contributions of \$1,000 or more, received during the following periods: For candidates involved in the Primary: 9/17/90 through 10/3/90. For candidates involved in the General: 10/18/90 through 11/3/90. The notice must reach the appropriate federal and state offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt." Prior Notice for the 1990 General Election was sent to the Committee on October 1, 1990 (Attachment 3). It includes a section titled "Last-Minute Contributions". This section states "Committees must also file special notices if contributions of \$1,000 or more are received during the period of October 18 through November 3, 1990. The notices must reach the appropriate Federal and State offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contributions."

On December 11, 1990 and January 22, 1991, Requests for Additional Information ("RFAIs") were sent to the Committee (Attachments 6 and 7). The RFAIs note on an informational basis that the Committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48-Hour Notices for "last-minute" contributions of \$1,000 or more. The notices request the Committee to review their procedures for checking contributions received during the aforementioned time periods. In addition, the notices state that although the Commission may take legal steps, any response would be taken into consideration.

^{1/} Schedules A and C of the Committee's report disclose the receipt of a \$78,000 candidate loan incurred on September 17, 1990. The Committee filed 48-Hour Notices for \$53,000 of this amount, resulting in unfiled 48-Hour Notices totalling \$25,000.

The basis for the attached referral is the failure of the Committee to Elect Marc Morial for Congress and Toni Hackett Antrum, as treasurer, ("Committee") to file twenty-two forty-eight hour notifications ("48 Hour Notices") for contributions totaling \$100,500.00. Marc H. Morial received 22 percent of the vote in the 1990 Primary Election and lost the General Election in Louisiana's Second Congressional District receiving forty-eight percent of the vote.

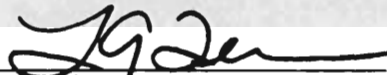

On April 15, 1991, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe the Committee to Elect Marc Morial for Congress ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer. You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information demonstrating that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

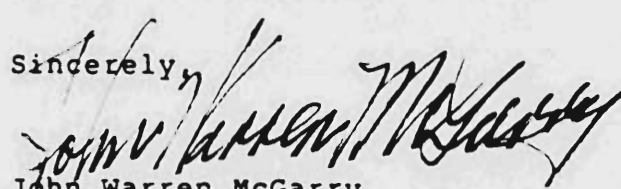

This matter was generated based on information ascertained by the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(2).

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify in writing either the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor.

Id. The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

According to 2 U.S.C. § 431(8)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 100.7(a)(1)(i)(B), a loan is a contribution at the time it is

made and is a contribution to the extent that it remains unpaid. Furthermore, each guarantor or endorser of a loan shall be deemed to have contributed that portion of the total amount of the loan for which the guarantor or endorser agreed to be liable until the loan is repaid. 2 U.S.C.

§ 431 (8)(B)(vii)(I) and 11 C.F.R. § 100.7(a)(1)(i)(C).

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The Primary Election in Louisiana was held on October 6, 1990. Pursuant to the Act, the Committee to Elect Marc Morial for Congress and Toni Hackett Antrum, as treasurer, ("Committee") was required to notify the Commission, in writing, of all contributions of \$1,000 or more received from September 17 to October 3, 1990, within 48 hours of their receipt. A review of the Committee's 1990 October Quarterly Report identified one contribution received on September 17, 1990, of \$1,000 or more, in the form of a \$78,000 loan made by the candidate to the Committee. The Commission did not receive a 48 Hour Notification for \$25,000 of this contribution.

The General Election in Louisiana was held on November 6, 1990. Pursuant to the Act, the Committee was required to notify the Commission, in writing, of all contributions of \$1,000 or more received from October 18 through November 3, 1990, within 48 hours of their receipt. A review of the Committee's 1990 30 Day Post-General Report identified twenty-one contributions received between October 18 and November 2, 1990, of \$1,000 or more totaling \$75,500, including one contribution in the form of a \$50,000 loan made by the candidate to the Committee. The Commission did not receive 48

Hour Notifications for these contributions.

Therefore, there is reason to believe that the Committee to Elect Marc Morial for Congress and Toni Hackett Antrum, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6) by failing to report campaign contributions in excess of \$1,000 received after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before the primary and general elections, within 48 hours of receipt of the contribution.

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that the Committee to Elect Marc Morial for Congress and Toni Hackett Antrum, as treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Committee to Elect Marc Morial for Congress is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4), and is the authorized principal campaign committee for Mr. Morial's 1990 congressional campaign.

2. Toni Hackett Antrum is the treasurer of Committee to Elect Marc Morial for Congress.

3. The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify in writing either the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. Id. The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

5. The Primary Election in Louisiana was held on October 6, 1990. Pursuant to the Act, the Respondents were required to notify the Commission, in writing, of all contributions of \$1,000 or more received from September 17 through October 3, 1990, within 48 hours of their receipt.

6. The Respondents received on September 17, 1990, a contribution of \$1,000 or more, in the form of \$78,000 loan made by the candidate to the Committee of which \$25,000 was not reported within 48 hours.

7. The General Election in Louisiana was held on November 6, 1990. Pursuant to the Act, the Respondents were required to notify the Commission, in writing, of all contributions of \$1,000 or more received from October 18 through November 3, 1990, within 48 hours of their receipt.

8. The Respondents received twenty-one contributions between October 18 and November 2, 1990, of \$1,000 or more totaling \$75,500, including one contribution in the form of a loan made by the candidate to the Committee totaling \$50,000.

9. The Respondents did not submit 48 Hour Notices for these contributions.

V. The Respondents failed to report twenty-two campaign contributions in excess of \$1,000 received after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before the general election, within 48 hours of receipt of the contributions, in violation of 2 U.S.C.

§ 434(a)(6).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal

Election Commission in the amount of two thousand eight hundred dollars (\$2,800.00), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirement contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

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X. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.

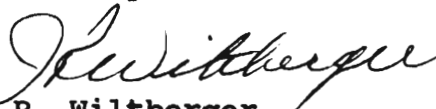
