III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to File Forty-Eight Hour Notifications

The Daniel K. Akaka for U.S. Senate committee ("the Committee") has failed to file the required Forty-Eight (48) Hour Notifications ("48-Hour Notices") for thirty-seven (37) contributions totalling \$38,000 received prior to the 1990 General Election.

The candidate was involved in the 1990 General Election held on November 6, 1990. Prior Notice was sent to the Committee on October 1, 1990 (Attachment 2). The Notice includes a section titled "Last-Minute Contributions". This section reads "Committees must also file special notices if contributions of \$1,000 or more are received during the period October 18 through November 3, 1990. The notices must reach the appropriate Federal and State offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contributions."

^{1/} Although the Committee did not file a Statement of Organization noting Joseph F. Blanco as Treasurer of the Committee until August 28, 1990, Mr. Blanco signed all reports filed in 1990 in the capacity of Treasurer.

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Schedule A of the 1990 30 Day Post-General Report indicates that the Committee failed to file thirty-seven (37) 48-Hour Notices for contributions received during the aforementioned period (Attachment 3).

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On December 24, 1990, a Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") was sent to the Committee (Attachment 4). The RFAI notes on an informational basis that the Committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48-Hour Notices for "last minute" contributions of \$1,000 or more. The notice requests the Committee to review their procedures for checking contributions received during the aforementioned time period. In addition, the notice states that although the Commission may take legal steps, any response would be taken into consideration.

On April 23, 1991, the Committee responded in a letter (Attachment 5). The Committee's response failed to address the issue of the omitted 48 Hour Notices.

WHAT MUST BE REPORTED

All financial activity (not previously reported) that occurred during the reporting period.

REPORTING FORMS

Candidate committees use FORM 3 (enclosed). If the campaign has more than one authorized committee, the principal campaign committee must also file a consolidated report on FORM 32.

WHERE TO FILE

Consult the instructions on the back of the FORM 3 Summary Page. Note State filing requirements also.

LAST-MINUTE CONTRIBUTIONS

Committees must also file special notices if contributions of \$1,000 or more are received during the period of October 18 through November 3, 1990. The notices must reach the appropriate Federal and State offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contributions.

*Reports sent by registered or certified mail must be postmarked by the mailing date. Otherwise, they must be received by the filing date.

**The period begins with the close of the last report filed by the committee. If the committee has filed no previous reports, the period begins with the date of the committee's first activity.

LABEL

Committees should affix the peel-off label from the envelope to Line 1 of the report. Correction should be made on the label.

COMPLIANCE

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Schedule A of your report (pertinent portion attached) discloses a contribution(s) which appears to exceed the limit set forth in the Act. An individual or a political committee other than a qualified multi-candidate committee may not make contributions to a candidate for federal office in excess of \$1,000 per election. The term "contribution" includes any gift, subscription, loan, advance, or deposit of money or anything of value made by any person for the purpose of influencing any election for federal office. (2 U.S.C. §441a(a) and (f))

If the contribution(s) in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you should amend your original report with the clarifying information. If the contribution you received exceeds the limit, you should either refund to the donor the amount in excess of \$1,000 or get the donor to redesignate and/or reattribute the contribution in writing. Your report also discloses an apparent contribution from a corporation which is prohibited unless made from a separate segregated fund established by the organization. If the contribution was prohibited, you should refund the full amount to the donor. The Commission should be notified if a refund is necessary. Refunds, redesignations, and reattributions of excessive contributions must be made within sixty days of the treasurer's receipt of the contribution. Refunds of prohibited contributions must be made within thirty days of the treasurer's receipt of the contribution. Refunds

are reported on Line 20 and on Schedule B of the report covering the period in which they are made. Redesignations and reattributions are reported as memo entries on Schedule A of the report covering the period in which the authorization for the redesignation and/or reattributions is received. (2 U.S.C. §§41a(a) and (f) and 441b(a); 11 CFR §104.8(d)(2), (3) and (4))

Although the Commission may take further legal steps, prompt action by you to refund the prohibited amount and to refund or seek redesignation and/or reattribution of the excessive amount will be taken into consideration.

-All contributions received by your committee from October 18 through November 26, 1990 are required to be reported on this report. Your committee filed a 48 hour notice disclosing a "last minute" contribution from Richard Salamon on October 30, 1990. This contribution does not appear on a Schedule A of this report. A "last minute" contribution discloses a \$1,000 contribution from Alden Y. Kajioke; however, Schedule A discloses only \$500. Please amend your report to include these contributions or provide an explanation of these apparent discrepancies.

-Schedule A of your report indicates that your committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48 hour notices regarding "last minute" contributions received by your committee after the close of books for the 12 Day Pre-General report. A principal campaign committee must notify the Commission, in writing, within 48 hours of any contribution of \$1,000 or more received between two and twenty days before an election. 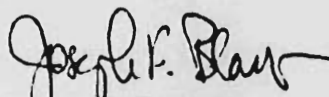

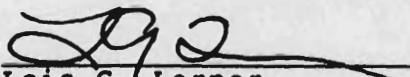

On May 30, 1991, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe Daniel K. Akaka for U.S. Senate ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer. You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

In the absence of any additional information demonstrating that no further action should be taken against the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

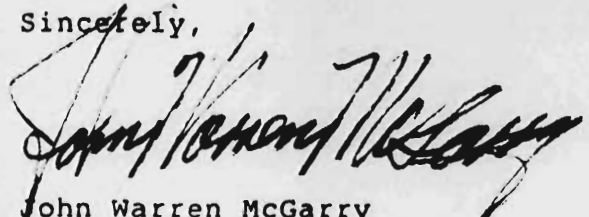

This matter was generated based on information ascertained by the Federal Election Commission ("the Commission") in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(2).

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The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify in writing either the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. Id. The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

The General Election in the State of Hawaii was held on November 6, 1990. Pursuant to the Act, Daniel K. Akaka for U.S. Senate and Joseph F. Blanco, as treasurer, ("Committee")

was required to notify the Commission, in writing, of all contributions of \$1,000 or more received from October 18 to November 3, 1990, within 48 hours of their receipt. A review of the Committee's 1990 30 Day Post-General Report identified thirty-seven contributions received on October 25, November 2, and November 3, 1990, of \$1,000 or more, totaling \$38,000. The Committee did not submit 48 Hour Notifications for these contributions.

Therefore, there is reason to believe that Daniel K. Akaka for U.S. Senate and Joseph F. Blanco, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6) by failing to report campaign contributions in excess of \$1,000 received after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before the general election, within 48 hours of receipt of the contribution.

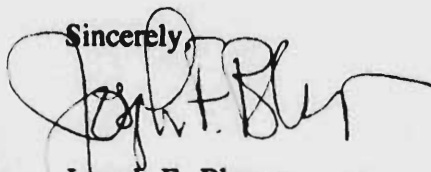

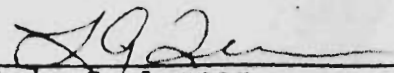

On October 28, 1991, the Federal Election Commission accepted the signed conciliation agreement and civil penalty submitted on your behalf in settlement of a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, the file has been closed in this matter.

This matter will become a part of the public record within 30 days. If you wish to submit any factual or legal materials to appear on the public record, please do so within ten days. Such materials should be sent to the Office of the General Counsel. Please be advised that information derived in connection with any conciliation attempt will not become public without the written consent of the respondent and the Commission. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(B). The enclosed conciliation agreement, however, will become a part of the public record.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that Daniel K. Akaka for U.S. Senate and Joseph F. Blanco, as treasurer, ("Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Daniel K. Akaka for U.S. Senate is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4), and is the

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authorized principal campaign committee for Mr. Akaka's 1990 Senate campaign.

2. Joseph F. Blanco is the treasurer of Daniel K. Akaka for U.S. Senate.

3. The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify in writing either the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. Id. The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

4. Respondents failed to file 48 Hour Contribution Notices for two contributions received on October 25, four contributions received on November 2, and thirty-one contributions received on November 3, 1990. The Respondents did file 48 Hour Contribution Notices for the remaining contributions received on those dates.

5. Respondents contend that the two contributions received on October 25, 1990, were entered into their computer

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system after the 48 Hour Contribution Notice was prepared for said date and therefore, were not included in the 48 Hour Contribution Notices for October 25, 1990. Respondents contend that the four contributions received on November 2, 1990, were received after the 48 Hour Contribution Notice was filed on November 2, 1990. Respondents contend that they have modified their computer system for recording and reporting contributions to better ensure that all contributions are reported as required. Respondent Joseph Blanco contends that due to serious illness, he was unable to file the 48 Hour Contribution Notices for the contributions received on November 2 and November 3.

V. 1. The Respondents failed to report thirty-seven campaign contributions in excess of \$1,000 received after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before the general election, within 48 hours of receipt of the contributions, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6).

2. The Respondents contend that the violations were not knowing and willful.

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A).

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute

a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. Respondents shall have no more than 30 days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirement contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

X. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.
