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FACTS

5. Except for the 1991 mid-year report, filed six months after its due date as a result of an inquiry by the FEC, Irish PAC has not filed any reports with the FEC for the 1992 election cycle.

6. The mid-year report filed by the Irish PAC indicates that the Irish PAC had no cash on hand at the beginning of the reporting period, had no cash on hand at the end of the reporting period, had no outstanding debts or obligations and did not conduct any activity nor receive or expend any funds whatsoever during the reporting period.

7. Borski for Congress Committee is the principal campaign committee for Bob Borski, candidate for the United States House of Representatives for the 3rd district of Pennsylvania.

8. The flyer (Exhibit C), stating the name and address of Irish PAC at the bottom, was publicly distributed on or about September 26, 1992.

9. The purpose of the flyer is to influence a federal election. The flyer clearly advocates the election of Bob Borski and the defeat of Charlie Dougherty, both candidates for the United States House of Representatives for the 3rd district of Pennsylvania. The Irish PAC flyer states in part:

Stop Charlie Dougherty's attempt to get back into Congress
. . . Re-elect Congressman Bob Borski -- a true friend of
Irish justice and peace.

10. The flyer does not state who paid for the communication nor whether it was authorized by the Borski Committee.

11. The Irish PAC has not reported the expenditure for this communication as either an independent expenditure or an in-kind contribution.

12. The Irish PAC has not filed a report with the FEC since December 1991.

13. The Borski Committee has not reported this expenditure as an in-kind contribution.

DISCUSSION OF LAW

Disclaimer Requirement

The provisions of 2 U.S.C. 441d, 11 C.F.R. 110.11(a)(1) state:

Except as provided at 11 C.F.R. 110.11(a)(2) whenever any person makes an expenditure for the purpose of financing a communication that expressly advocates the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate, . . . through any broadcasting station, newspaper, magazine, outdoor advertising, facility, poster, yard sign, direct mailing,

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or any form of general public political advertising, a disclaimer . . . shall appear and be presented in a clear and conspicuous manner to give the reader, observer or listener adequate notice of the identity of persons who paid for, and where required, who authorized the communication.

The Irish PAC flyer expressly advocates the election of Bob Borski and the defeat of Charlie Dougherty, candidates for Federal office and therefore must include the disclaimer required by Federal election law.

In addition, Federal election law states that communications that expressly advocate the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate must also state whether such communication was authorized by a candidate, an authorized committee or an agent thereof. Specifically, the regulations state:

(i) Such communication, including any solicitation, if paid for and authorized by a candidate, unauthorized committee of a candidate, or its agent, shall clearly state that the communication has been paid for by the authorized political committee; or

(ii) Such communication, including any solicitation, if authorized by a candidate, an authorized committee of a candidate or an agent thereof, but paid for by any other person, shall clearly state that the communication is paid for by such other person and, is authorized by such candidate, authorized committee or agent; or

(iii) Such communication, including any solicitation, if made on behalf of or in opposition to a candidate, but paid for by any other person and not authorized by a candidate, authorized committee of a candidate or its agent, shall clearly state that the communication has been paid for by such person and is not authorized by a candidate or candidate's committee.

2 U.S.C. 441d, 11 C.F.R. 110.11(a)(1) (Emphasis added).

Therefore, if this was an authorized in-kind expenditure, the disclaimer should have read, "Paid for by Irish PAC. Authorized by Borski for Congress Committee." If this was an unauthorized independent expenditure, the disclaimer should have read, "Paid for by Irish PAC. Not authorized by Borski for Congress Committee." Irish PAC's failure to include any clear statement indicating who paid for the flyer and whether the flyer was authorized by a candidate or a candidate's committee is a violation of Federal election law, 2 U.S.C. 441d, 11 C.F.R. 110.11(a)(1).

Failure to File Reports

Federal election law requires political action committees to file periodic reports with the FEC. 2 U.S.C. 434(a), 11 C.F.R. 104.1(a). Political action committees must file non-election year and election year reports or monthly reports. 2 U.S.C. 434(a)(2), 11 C.F.R. 104.5(c). There does not exist an exception or waiver of this filing requirement for committees that conduct little or no activity during a reporting period. A political committee may terminate only upon filing a termination report on the appropriate FEC Form or upon filing a written statement containing the same information or a political committee may be administratively terminated by the FEC. 2 U.S.C. 433(d)(1), (2), 11 C.F.R. 102.3 and 102.4. Therefore, until a political committee is terminated it is required to file periodic reports with the FEC.

Irish PAC has not terminated nor been administratively terminated by the FEC. Therefore, Irish PAC is required to file periodic reports with the FEC. Irish PAC has not filed a report with the FEC since it filed a 1991 mid-year report six months late in December 1991. (Exhibit A). Irish PAC's failure to file FEC reports is a violation of Federal election law pursuant to 2 U.S.C. 434(a), 11 C.F.R. 104.1(a).

Inappropriate Report Signature, or Failure to Amend Statement of Organization

Federal election law requires the treasurer of each political committee to complete the required periodic reports. 2 U.S.C. 434(a), 11 C.F.R. 104.1(a) and 104.14(a). The treasurer of record of the Irish PAC is Bernadette McAuliffe. The only report filed by the Irish PAC in the 1992 election cycle is signed by Sean McManus.

Federal election law requires a political committee to record the identity of its treasurer on its Statement of Organization. 2 U.S.C. 433(a), 11 C.F.R. 102.2(a)(1)(iv). Additionally, "any change or correction in the information previously filed in the Statement of Organization shall be reported no later than 10 days following the date of the change or correction by filing an amended Statement of Organization or by filing a letter noting the change(s)." 2 U.S.C. 433(b), (c), 11 C.F.R. 102.2(a)(2). Therefore, Irish PAC has violated Federal election law by submitting a report not signed by its lawful treasurer, or in the alternative, Irish PAC has violated Federal election law by failing to report a change in treasurer.

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PRAYER FOR RELIEF

THEREFORE, the Republican Committee, respectfully requests, that the Federal Election Commission investigate these allegations and make the following findings of fact, as appropriate:

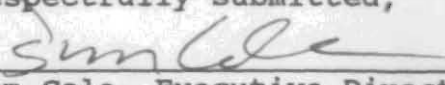
- (1) The Irish PAC flyer was, in fact, a communication expressly advocating the election of Bob Borski and the defeat of Charlie Dougherty and the omission of the required disclaimer is a violation of 2 U.S.C. 441d, 11 C.F.R. 110.11(a)(1); and,
- (2) Irish PAC's refusal to file periodic reports with the FEC is a violation of Federal election law pursuant to 2 U.S.C. 434(a), 11 C.F.R. 104.1(a); and,
- (3) Irish PAC has violated Federal election law by submitting a report not signed by its treasurer, or in the alternative, not amending its Statement of Organization to reflect a change in treasurer pursuant to 2 U.S.C. 433(b), (c) and 434(a), 11 C.F.R. 104.1(a), 102.2(a)(2); and,
- (4) Borski for Congress Committee has received an in-kind contribution and has failed to file the same in violation of 2 U.S.C. 434(b), 11 C.F.R. 104.3(a).

FURTHER, The Republican Committee requests the Federal Election Commission require Irish PAC to file all required reports and assess all appropriate penalties for said violation in accordance with 2 U.S.C. 437g(a)(5)(A).

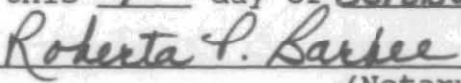
The Republican Committee requests such further and other relief as this Commission may deem appropriate.

Washington, DC, September 22, 1992-- Former Congressman Charlie Dougherty used to be England's best friend in the U.S. Congress. "Voters in the Third District of Pennsylvania who love Ireland should vote for Bob Borski and vote against Charlie Dougherty-- an enemy of justice and peace in Ireland," he urged.

This letter is submitted on behalf of the Borski for Congress Committee and Virginia M. Duffy, its treasurer, in response to the Complaint (the "Complaint") made against the Irish National Caucus Political Action Committee, Bernadette McAuliffe, Treasurer, Sean McManus, and the Borski for Congress Committee, Virginia M. Duffy, Treasurer, by the National Republican Congressional Committee, a copy of which was received, with your transmittal letter, on October 22, 1992. Capitalized terms not defined in this letter shall have the same meanings as in the Complaint.

Having reviewed the Complaint, the Borski Committee and Virginia M. Duffy, its Treasurer ("Duffy") respectfully request that the Complaint be dismissed as to the Borski Committee and as to Duffy, because the campaign flyer described therein was an independent expenditure not authorized by the Borski Committee, is not a contribution to the Borski Committee, and accordingly is not required to be reported by the Borski Committee.

In connection with the Complaint, the undersigned aver that the following are the relevant facts, all true and correct to the best of our knowledge, information and belief:

1. The Borski Committee is the only authorized committee of Robert A. Borski, candidate for the office of Representative from the Third Congressional District in Pennsylvania (the "Candidate").

2. Within the Borski Committee, the persons with authority to make or to authorize the making of expenditures on behalf of the Candidate are Duffy and John F. Dempsey, Assistant Treasurer ("Dempsey"). Duffy and Dempsey have delegated limited authority with respect to expenditures as follows:

(a) Disbursement of petty cash for campaign office supplies, volunteer parking charges, volunteer refreshments, and other incidental miscellaneous expenditures has

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been delegated by Duffy to Elsie F. Lydon and Erin Manning, who are the Borski Committee's petty cash custodians, subject to prior approval by Dempsey or Duffy of any petty cash disbursement over \$25.

(b) Three persons (Francis McCloskey, Ethan S. Chamow and Elsie F. Lydon) have signing authority for the Borski Committee's charge accounts for office supplies and sign materials, as well as for minor services such as campaign office copier repair, however all such expenditures must be approved in advance by Dempsey or Duffy.

3. The Borski Committee did not suggest, request, prepare, arrange, consent to, consult on, cooperate with, pay for or authorize the campaign flyer attached to the Complaint.

4. The expenditure for the campaign flyer attached to the Complaint was not made with the cooperation or with the prior consent of, or in consultation with, or at the request or suggestion of, the Candidate or the Borski Committee or any of the persons named in paragraph 2 or any other person who might come within the definition of "agent" under 11 CFR 109.

Federal election law does not require the reporting by candidates of independent expenditures. The relevant law is set forth in 2 U.S.C. 431(17), 434(c), 11 C.F.R. Section 109:

(a) Section 109.1(c) states that "An expenditure not qualifying under this section as an independent expenditure shall be a contribution in kind to the candidate and an expenditure by the candidate, unless otherwise exempted." By clear implication, an expenditure qualifying as an independent expenditure shall not be a contribution in kind to the candidate or an expenditure by the candidate.

(b) Section 109.1(a) defines independent expenditure as "an expenditure by a person for a communication expressly advocating the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate which is not made with the cooperation or with the prior consent of, or in consultation with, or at the request or suggestion of, a candidate or any agent or authorized committee of such candidate." (Emphasis added)

The Borski Committee and its Treasurer respectfully submit that the campaign flyer at issue was an independent expenditure within the meaning of Section 109, not a contribution in kind to, or an expenditure by, the Candidate.

The Complaint contains a bare allegation that the Borski Committee has not reported the campaign flyer expenditure as an in-kind contribution, without any further factual allegations or legal discussion. Since the campaign flyer clearly fits within the definition of an independent expenditure not required to be reported by the Borski Committee, and in the absence of any other

relevant factual allegations in the Complaint, the Borski Committee and the undersigned respectfully request that the Commission (A) make a finding of fact that the campaign flyer was an independent expenditure not required to be reported by the Borski Committee, or in the alternative, find no reason to believe that the Complaint sets forth a possible violation of the Act by the Borski Committee or its Treasurer, and (B) dismiss the Complaint as to the Borski Committee and its Treasurer, Virginia M. Duffy.

This is to follow-up our telephone conversation of October 28, 1992, and to respond to the complaint filed with the Federal Election Commission (FEC) by the National Republican Congressional Committee (Republican Committee) against the Irish National Caucus Political Action Committee (Irish PAC). The FEC has been informed that I have been officially designated as counsel to the Irish PAC and Father Sean McManus, President and Treasurer of the Irish PAC.

The facts set forth in the complaint by the Republican Committee are generally true and, for the most part, are not contested by the Irish PAC. Several of the enumerated facts require explanation or elucidation, however, in order to make the record clear, as follows:

Fact 3. The treasurer of record for the Irish PAC is no longer Bernadette McAuliffe. Fr. Sean McManus is the Treasurer, having replaced McAuliffe in May 1984. Fr. McManus advises me that the FEC has now been notified of that reorganization. The delay was an oversight.

Fact 5. Irish PAC has not yet filed reports with the FEC for the 1992 election cycle. This was also an oversight. A report is being prepared and will soon be filed. (Fact 6 of the complaint correctly notes the lack of activity of the Irish PAC during a recent reporting period, as well as its lack of resources. In short, there was nothing substantive to report.)

Fact 10. The flyer in question does not state who paid for this communication, as it should have. The flyer was paid for by the Irish PAC. The flyer was an Irish PAC initiative. The flyer was not solicited, approved, or authorized by the Borsky Committee.

Fact 11. The report soon to be filed with the FEC will disclose an independent expenditure for the flyer in question of approximately \$123.63, of which \$110.49 was for postage, an estimated \$9.14 for envelopes, and an estimated \$4.00 for xerox paper. The flyer was reproduced on an in-house xerox machine. 381 copies were mailed.

The Irish PAC is non-partisan. Candidates for office who have declared their support for peace and justice in Ireland are considered worthy of

support by the Irish PAC, regardless of political affiliation. Fr. McManus has publicly stated his appreciation for the expression of solidarity with the oppressed people of Northern Ireland by so many Americans in public life. He welcomes their support for the Caucus' singular goal of peace and justice in Ireland, which is the sole criterion by which Irish PAC judges candidates for public office; political party affiliation is irrelevant.

Severely limited resources have precluded the Irish PAC from contributing financially to the campaigns of all those who deserve support; this also accounts for the lack of vigorous activity of the Irish PAC.

If there have been violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act or FEC regulations, these have been minor unintentional infractions, and, we believe, inconsequential. Every effort has been made to correct any reporting deficiencies by the Irish PAC. It is, therefore, our position that no further action by the FEC would be justified in light of the facts and circumstances of this case.

Let me take this opportunity to thank you for the materials you sent. You have been most helpful and cooperative.
