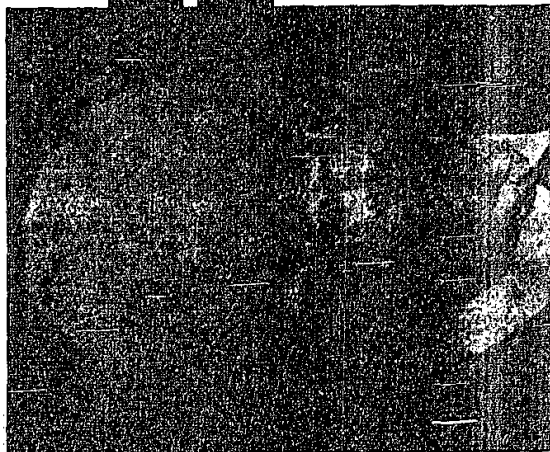

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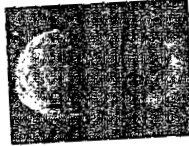

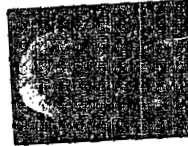

DESERT STORM

HIGHER TAXES

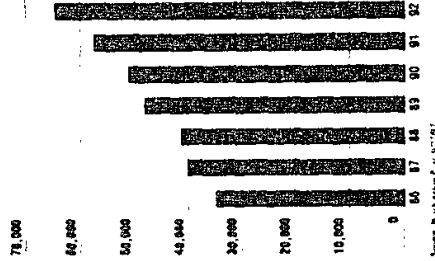
For ten years, Hollings has supported a massive tax increase on working families, through his 5% National Sales Tax. His National Sales tax is not just a tax increase; it's a tax increase that hits working people and small businesses the hardest. In 1991 Hollings told a TV audience he wanted to increase taxes by \$100 billion per year. In 1991 Hollings voted against a bill that would have required a "super-majority" of 60 Senators to raise our taxes.

MORE SPENDING

Fritz Hollings likes to call himself an "economic conservative," but his record says differently. In 1991 Citizens Against Government Waste gave Hollings a rating of 33% and called him "unfriendly" to taxpayers. Since 1986 Hollings and Ted Kennedy have voted together 24 times to spend more money than requested by the President. These votes amount to more than \$37 billion in increased federal spending. In 1991 alone the National Taxpayers Union reports Hollings personally sponsored or co-sponsored legislation that would increase federal spending by more than \$11 billion — that's \$178 in additional deficit spending for every family in South Carolina. Hollings introduced no legislation in 1991 that would reduce spending. Hollings says he's for the line-item veto to control spending but voted against it in 1990.

WELFARE VS. WORKFARE

In 1988 Hollings voted to kill an amendment which would have required able-bodied welfare recipients to work for their benefits — then tried to hide from his record.

SPECIAL INTERESTS

In 1983 Hollings co-sponsored legislation pushed by the homosexual lobby to have gays recognized as a legitimate minority by the federal government — in effect a "gay and lesbian quota bill" that could require a certain percentage of employees at your place of work to be homosexuals.

CHOICE IN EDUCATION

This year Hollings voted with Ted Kennedy and the teachers' unions and against parents who want to choose between public and private schools in educating their children.

JESSE JACKSON FOR PRESIDENT
