COMPLAINT OF CENTER FOR RESPONSIVE POLITICS

1. This complaint charges that the respondent has violated the Federal Election Campaign Act, 2 U.S.C. § 431 et seq., as amended ("FECA"), by making aggregate contributions in excess of the limits permitted by the FECA.

PARTIES

2. The complainant, the Center for Responsive Politics, is a nonprofit, nonpartisan research group incorporated in the State of Iowa and headquartered in Washington, D.C., that studies Congress and related issues. Founded in 1983, it was designed to research matters concerning the organization and operation of Congress as an institution and to examine potential reforms that could improve both its internal operation and its responsiveness to the American public. The patterns of contributions of money to federal candidates has been one of its chief areas of study.

3. The respondent is an individual contributor to various candidates and political committees.

APPLICABLE STATUTES AND REGULATIONS

4. The FECA limits contributions by any one individual to an aggregate total of \$25,000 per calendar year. Contributions to a candidate or the candidate's authorized committee made in a year other than the calendar year of the election with respect to which the contribution is made are considered to be made during the calendar year in which such election is held. 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(3); 11 C.F.R. § 110.5.

GROUND FOR COMPLAINT

5. According to FEC records, respondent John A. Gabriel made contributions subject to FECA in the amounts and to the persons identified in the list attached to this complaint as Exhibit 1. Attached as Exhibit 2 are copies of the FEC records for each contribution listed in Exhibit 1. All exhibits reflect the records on file at the FEC as of December 15, 1993.

6. On information and belief, respondent John A. Gabriel made contributions attributed to the 1992 calendar year in the amount of \$50,340. These contributions exceeded by \$25,340 the \$25,000 contribution limit imposed by the FECA and Commission regulations on all contributions by any individual in a calendar year.

RELIEF

7. The Center for Responsive Politics respectfully urges the Commission to conduct a prompt and thorough investigation into the allegations in this Complaint, and to declare that the Respondent has violated the FECA and Commission regulations.

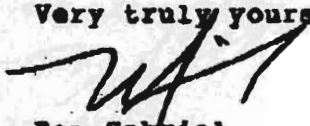

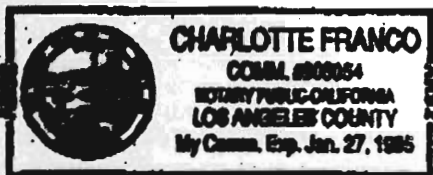

I appreciate the opportunity to attempt to respond to a complaint which indicates that my father John A. Gabriel may have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act.

My father who will be 78 years old this year has suffered a number of strokes and seizures during the last few years. Each time these events have added to gradual deterioration of his physical and mental well being. At the present time due to my father having a major stroke in March 1993 he is immobile physically and mentally is incapable of any form of communication.

Therefore it is reluctantly that I attempt to address the complaint which is directed at my father. In reviewing my father's political contributions during this period, it is evident that my father's health was in a declining state which caused him to be confused at times, leading him to respond to letters of request from political organizations as though they were desperate personal appeals for help. Because of his declining health he may have mistaken these random political request letters as direct personal pleas of help from the top leaders of our country, (e.g. the President of the United States) and responded out of a belief of patriotism.

I can only surmise that my father who at the time was in failing health contributed with no political objective or motive in mind other than responding to what he believed was a request for help from his country's leaders. In doing so he may have had difficulty in distinguishing between a random piece of political mail and a direct personal request. I can state that to the best of my knowledge my father never personally meet or had contact with any of the people or groups he contributed to during this time.

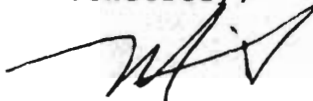

It seems clear in reviewing the correspondence that the more certificates, plaques and resolutions of gratitude he received, along with them came additional requests for funds and more he felt obligated to contribute. Without anyone of political expertise by his side to explain to him the full impact of his actions he may have unwittingly participated without understanding the scope and restrictions of the federal campaign contribution laws.

I hope this will be insightful as to any alleged violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act that may have occurred. it is clear that if any violation did occur it was unintentional. Unfortunately due to my father's failing health he will never be able to contribute to any future political campaign. Based on the facts above I would very much appreciate the Commission taking action to close the file on this matter.

If and when any medical reports are necessary to verify above statements in regards to my father's health, they can and will be supplied upon request. If I may be of any further assistance, please feel free to contact me.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S MONTHLY REPORT

SENSITIVE

I. INTRODUCTION

This report is the second Enforcement Priority System Monthly Report. The purpose of this September Monthly Report is to recommend that the Commission no longer pursue the identified lower priority and stale cases.

II. CASES RECOMMENDED FOR CLOSING

A. Cases Not Warranting Further Pursuit Relative to Other Cases Pending Before the Commission

A critical component of the Priority System is identifying those pending cases that do not warrant the further expenditure of resources. Each incoming matter is evaluated using Commission-approved criteria and cases that, based on their rating, do not warrant pursuit relative to other pending cases are placed in this category. By closing such cases, the Commission is able to use its limited resources to focus on more important cases.

Having evaluated incoming matters, this Office has identified 44 cases which do not warrant further pursuit

relative to the other pending cases.¹ A short description of each case and the factors leading to assignment of a relatively low priority and consequent recommendation not to pursue each case is attached to this report. See Attachments 1-44. For the Commission's convenience, the narratives for the externally-generated matters are immediately followed by the complaint and response(s) and the narrative for the internally-generated matter is immediately followed by the referral.

B. Stale Cases

Investigations are severely impeded and require relatively more resources when the activity and evidence are old. Consequently, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission focus its efforts on cases involving more recent activity. Such efforts will also generate more impact on the current electoral process and are a more efficient allocation of our limited resources. To this end, this Office has identified 2 cases that have remained inactive and assigned to the Central Enforcement Docket for one year and which it believes do not warrant further investment of significant Commission resources.² Since the recommendation not to pursue the identified cases is
