On August 29, 1995, your client the National Policy Forum was notified that the Federal Election Commission received a complaint from the Democratic National Committee alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. At that time the NPF was given a copy of the complaint and informed that a response to the complaint should be submitted within 15 days of receipt of the notification.

On May 13, 1997, the Commission received additional information from the complainant pertaining to the allegations in the complaint. Enclosed is a copy of this additional information.
