1. Failed in a vote of 3-1 to pass a motion to find reason to believe that the Republican National Committee and Alec Poitevint, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441a(f) and 441b(a), and 11 C.F.R. §§ 102.5(a)(1) and 106.5(g)(1).

Commissioners McDonald, McGarry, and Thomas voted affirmatively for the motion. Commissioner Elliott dissented. Commissioner Aikens recused herself from MUR 4250 and was not present during its consideration.

2. Failed in a vote of 3-1 to pass a motion to find reason to believe that the Republican National Committee and Alec Poitevint, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(1).

3. Decided by a vote of 4-0 to find reason to believe that the Republican National Committee and Alec Poitevint, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 441e.
