

**SECOND CONSENT TO EXTEND TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission's agreement to accept the submission of supporting financial and other documentation relating to pre-probable cause conciliation, Respondents Cook 2000 Re-election Committee and Camille Cook, as treasurer, Merrill A. Cook and Cook Associates, Inc., by their representative, hereby consent to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Federal Election Commission might institute against them in connection with MUR 4621 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6) for an additional ninety (90) days. This action will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for an additional period of ninety (90) days, supplementing the twenty (20) day tolling previously consented to, from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable, in these matters. There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the consent of the Respondents.
