GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

I. BACKGROUND

This matter was generated from information ascertained by the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(2). On January 13, 1998, the Commission found probable cause to believe that the Respondents, the Nevada State Republican Central Committee (the "Committee") and Ronald F. Ryan, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 432(a), 433(c), and 434(a)(4)(B). The Commission also approved a Conciliation Agreement
