Dear Mr. Turley:



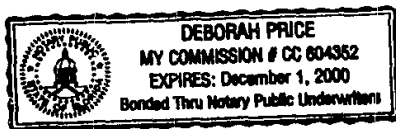
Before me this day personally appeared CAROL J. LEWIS, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

In May 1996, my client, Amy Robin Habie of Boca Raton, Florida asked me to make a \$1,000.00 political contribution to the campaign of U.S. Representative Jane Harmon (D., Calif.) on behalf of her friend, attorney David Boies of the Cravath, Swaine and Moore law firm in New York City. Ms. Habie gave me a \$1,000.00 check drawn on her personal account in exchange for my \$1,000.00 check to Rep. Jane Harmon's campaign. Ms. Habie told me that David Boies made tens of thousands of dollars of such contributions to different congressmen annually and that she helped him in doing so by enlisting the aid of her relatives, friends, and business associates, as she was doing with me. She said that Senator Kennedy also received such donations from Mr. Boies.



I called U.S. Representative Jane Harmon's (D., Calif.) California office on June 2, 1997 and spoke with Jennifer Ewing about my wife's May 1996 \$1,000.00 contribution to Rep. Harmon's campaign on behalf of attorney David Boies of the Cravath, Swaine & Moore law firm in New York City. Ms. Ewing read me the names of other Florida contributors who had written checks in 1996 for \$1,000.00. From that list I recognized Amy Habie's name and at least three more of her associates from Florida besides my wife. They include Ms. Habie's mother (Rhea Weil), her mother's husband (Lawrence Herman) and her secretary (Wallace Walker). I know these names because Rhea Weil and Wallace Walker worked in the same West Palm Beach, Florida office with me from March to September 1996 when I worked for Ms. Habie, and Lawrence Herman was a frequent visitor to that office.
