## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

June 18, 1997

re: MUR 4646 (SCOTT P. LEWIS)

I spoke by phone today with the complainant, Scott P. Lewis, regarding his June 6 letter, submitted along with two affidavits which constitute a complaint alleging FECA violations involving attorney David Boies and others. The purpose of my call was to clarify an apparent misunderstanding which arose from a prior telephone discussion concerning the potential status of his wife, Carol J. Lewis, relative to this matter.

I explained to Mr. Lewis that Mrs. Lewis would be identified as a respondent in this matter, and would be receiving a notification letter as a respondent in the near future. I also provided a brief overview of the initial stages of the enforcement process. I clarified that I had made no promises in our prior discussion that the Commission would not enter any findings of liability against her, but the fact that she had come forward would most likely be given due consideration by the Commission in any action which may subsequently be taken. Mr. Lewis expressed appreciation for both the call and the clarification.
