Dear Chairman McGarry:

On behalf of the Kings County Republican Committee ("KCRC"), this will respond to the Factual and Legal Analysis from the Federal Election Commission in this matter.

As an initial matter, we are unsure how and why the KCRC can even come under the jurisdiction of the Federal Election Committee. The KCRC is a county party committee created under N.Y. Elec. Code §§ 2-100 and 2-104. The KCRC is registered with the New York Board of Elections in Albany and the New York City Board of Elections. The KCRC files regular reports of contributions and disbursements with those entities as required by New York law.

The KCRC is the party committee for Kings County, New York, which is the Borough of Brooklyn. We are active in elections for state and local offices. The KCRC does not have a federal account because we do not participate in federal elections.

Furthermore, the Factual and Legal Analysis is in error. The check to the KCRC from the New York Republican State committee is dated November 7, 1994, the day before the election, not November 9, 1994 as stated in the Factual and Legal Analysis. A copy of the check is attached. I cashed the check on election day - November 8, 1994. The funds were used for election day activities such as buying meals for poll watchers and volunteers, and paying similar costs associated with challenges to a large number of uncounted and unopened ballots found the day after the election, and for the recount of the state Attorney General's election.


In conclusion, the KCRC did not "advance" any funds to the New York Republican State Committee prior to the 1994 election. Therefore, the KCRC did not make any "expenditure" as defined in the Federal Election Campaign Act, did not become a "political committee" under federal law, was not required to file a Statement of Organization and did not make any "contribution" under federal law, including one that contained prohibited funds.

Accordingly, this matter against the Kings County Republican Committee and its treasurer should be dismissed.

Response to Question 4:



Response to Question 5:


