To Whom It May Concern:

In the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") considered the issue of whether Newcourt Credit Group, Inc. (formerly d/b/a AT&T Credit Corporation) violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, in connection with a telephone system that AT&T Credit Corporation provided to the Pete Wilson for President Committee, Inc. in 1995.

On July 20, 1999, the Commission considered this issue but there was an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe that Newcourt Credit Group, Inc. (formerly d/b/a AT&T Credit Corporation) violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

The confidentiality provisions at 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12) no longer apply and this matter is now public. In addition, although the complete file must be placed on the public record within 30 days, this could occur at any time following certification of the Commission's vote. If you wish to submit any factual or legal materials to appear on the public record, please do so as soon as possible. While the file may be placed on the public record before receiving your additional materials, any permissible submissions will be added to the public record upon receipt.
