4. Find no reason to believe that Peter Roskam or the Roskam for Congress Committee and Carl F. Lofgren, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 434(a)(6)(A) and 441a(f) and close the file as to Peter Roskam and the Roskam for Congress Committee.
5. Approve the Factual and Legal Analyses attached to the General Counsel's December 3, 1998 report.
6. Approve the Conciliation Agreement attached to the General Counsel's December 3, 1998 report
7. Approve the appropriate letters as recommended in the General Counsel's December 3, 1998 report.
