This is in reference to the complaint you filed with the Federal Election Commission on March 16, 1998, concerning Campaign for Working Families and Peter Dickinson, as treasurer ("CWF"), Gary Bauer, the President of CWF, and Peter Roskam, a candidate in the Illinois primary on March 17, 1998, and Roskam for Congress and Carl F. Lofgren, as treasurer ("the Roskam Committee").

The Commission found that there was reason to believe CWF violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 434(b), 434(c)(2), and 441d(a), a provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, ("the Act") and conducted an investigation in this matter. On August 2, 1999, a conciliation agreement signed by CWF was accepted by the Commission. Accordingly, the Commission closed the file in this matter on August 2, 1999. A copy of this agreement is enclosed for your information.

The Commission found no reason to believe that Gary Bauer, Peter Roskam or the Roskam Committee violated the Act in this matter.
