III. BACKGROUND:

Contributions to State and County Party Committees in Excess of the Limitations

The 1996 October Monthly Report filed by the Association of Trial Lawyers of America Political Action Committee ("the Committee") disclosed contributions to the federal accounts of the Texas Democratic Party (C00099267) and 21st Century Political Action Committee (C00274001)¹ of \$5,000 each on September 30, 1996 (Attachment 2).

The 1996 12 Day Pre-General Report disclosed contributions to the federal accounts of Bexar County Democratic Party (C00270868), Dallas County Democratic Party (C00248864), Galveston County Democratic Party

(C00274019), Harris County Democratic Party (C00161067), Jefferson County Democratic Party (C00253880) and Travis County Democratic Party (C00257519) of \$5,000 per committee on October 1, 1996, bringing the total of apparent excessive contributions to the Texas State and County Democratic Party committees to \$35,000 (Attachment 3).

On May 21, 1997, Requests for Additional Information ("RFAs") were sent to the Committee for the 1996 October [REDACTED] Pre-General Reports. The RFAs notified the Committee that [REDACTED] 11 CFR § 110.3(a) precluded a committee from making contributions to another political committee and its affiliates in excess of \$5,000 per calendar year. The RFAs advised the Committee that if the contributions were incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, amendments to the original reports should be submitted with clarifying information. In addition, the Committee was advised that if these were excessive contributions, it should notify the recipients and request refunds of the amount in excess of \$5,000. The Committee also was to inform the Commission of its corrective action immediately in writing and provide a photocopy of the refund request sent to the recipient committees (Attachment 4).

On June 5, 1997 the Committee responded to the RFAs in a letter from Heather Tureen (FKA Heather Weaver), Assistant Treasurer and Director of the Committee. Ms. Tureen stated that the Committee's understanding of 11 CFR § 110.3(b) required local party committees to share the same contribution limit with their state party committee, unless they demonstrate their independence. She went on to state that it was its understanding that the Texas County Democratic Party committees had demonstrated their independence from the Texas State Democratic Party and were therefore subject to separate contribution limits. According to Ms. Tureen, prior to making the contributions, it was represented to them that the County Party committees were independently run, controlled, and financed. She said if the County Party committees were in fact affiliated, the Committee would promptly take any and all necessary remedial action (Attachment 5).

On June 12, 1997 a Second Notice was sent to the Committee for not providing all requested information.² The Notice advised the Committee that local party committees within a state and the state party committee are presumed to be affiliated with each other and share one contribution limit as one political committee. If a local party committee wished to be considered independent of the state party committee it must meet certain standards under 11 CFR § 110.3(b)(3)(i)

and (ii) and submit an Advisory Opinion Request to the Commission. The Committee was further advised that the recipient committees should be notified and refunds requested of the amounts in excess of \$5,000 (Attachment 6).

In a letter dated June 23, 1997 Ms. Tureen responded to the Second Notice by summarizing its position concerning the contributions made to the Texas State and County Party committees. Ms. Tureen said that upon receipt of the Notice, letters were sent to the local County Party committees requesting refunds of the Committee's contributions (copies of the letters were attached to its response). Ms. Tureen said that once the Committee receives refunds from the County Party committees, it would submit amendments for the 1996 October Monthly and 12 Day Pre-General Reports reflecting these refunds (Attachment 7).

On July 1, 1997 the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") analyst called Ms. Tureen to advise her that any refunds received should be included in the report covering the period in which they are received and not on amendments to the original reports (Attachment 8).

In a letter dated July 1, 1997 Ms. Tureen amended her June 23, 1997 letter by stating the Committee will disclose any refunds from the local county party committees on the report covering the period that they are received (Attachment 9).

As of the date of this referral, the Committee has not disclosed the receipt of any refunds from any of the Texas Democratic State and County Party committees.





As shown in our FEC reports, ATLA PAC made \$5,000 contributions to the Texas State Democratic Party and the following other political committees in the state of Texas: the Tarrant County Democratic Party, the Bexar County Democratic Party, the Dallas County Democratic Party, the Gavelston County Democratic Party, the Harris County Democratic Party, and the Jefferson County Democratic Party.

We understand that under 11 C.F.R. §110.3(b) local party committees share the same contribution limits as their state party committee, unless they can demonstrate their independence. 

You therefore feel it was proper to make a \$5000 contribution to each. Please note that local party committees within a state are presumed to be affiliated with the state party committee and therefore considered affiliated with each other, thus sharing the contribution limit for one political committee. I write to respond to correspondence I received from John D. Gibson of your office, dated June 12, 1997 concerning contributions ATLA PAC made to the Texas State Democratic Party and the following local county parties:
(1) Tarrant County Democratic Party; (2) Bexar County Democratic Party; (3) Dallas County Democratic Party; (4) Galveston County Democratic Party; (5) Harris County Democratic Party; (6) Jefferson County Democratic Party; and (7) Travis County Democratic Party.

As I wrote to you previously, prior to making the contributions in question, ATLA PAC believed in good faith that the local Texas party committees listed above had demonstrated their independence from the Texas State Democratic Party and were therefore subject to separate contributions limits. I also noted that ATLA PAC was willing to take any and all necessary remedial action if the FEC determined that the local party committees were in fact affiliated with the state party committee or each other. The letter from Mr. Gibson indicates that local party committees are presumed to be affiliated with their state party counterparts and suggests that the local party committees submit an Advisory Opinion Request to the Commission to establish their independence. It concludes by advising ATLA PAC to correct its alleged excessive contributions by requesting refunds from the recipient local party committees.

Upon receipt of Mr. Gibson's letter, ATLA PAC acted promptly to take the appropriate remedial action indicated. Once ATLA PAC receives refunds from the recipient local party committees, we will submit amendments for the October Quarterly report and the amended 12 Day Pre-General Report reflecting these refunds. I have attached copies of letters ATLA PAC sent to the local party committee recipients requesting refunds of ATLA PAC's contributions. I hope that these corrective actions resolve this matter.

On behalf of the Association of Trial Lawyers of America ("ATLA PAC"), I write to request a refund of ATLA PAC's \$5,000 contribution made on October 1, 1996.

In correspondence to ATLA PAC, the Federal Election Commission ("FEC" or "Commission") questioned whether the Jefferson County Democratic Party committee is affiliated with the Texas State Democratic Party. ATLA PAC responded that it in good faith believed that your committee was an independent committee, unaffiliated with the state party or any other county party. The FEC answered that there is a presumption that local party committees are affiliated with their state party counterparts and recommended that your committee submit an Advisory Opinion Request to the Commission to establish its independence. Accordingly, the FEC informed ATLA PAC that its contributions to your committee and the state party were presumed to be excessive contributions and instructed ATLA PAC to seek refunds.

At the time ATLA PAC made its contributions, it received, and had no reason to question, assurances that your committee was independent from the state party committee. However, due to the FEC's inquiry, ATLA PAC believes that its only prudent course of action at this time is to request a refund.

I placed a telephone call to Ms. Heather (Weaver) Tureen, Coordinator of the Association of Trial Lawyers of America Political Action Committee ("the Committee"), after she had responded to an Inadequate Response (IR) Notice dated June 12, 1997. In that response, dated June 23, 1997, she had summarized the Committee's position concerning contributions made to the Texas State and Local County Democratic Party committees and stated that once they received the IR notice they took prompt "appropriate remedial action". That action consisted of sending letters to the local party committee recipients requesting refunds of the Committee's contributions. Ms. Tureen said that once they received the refunds they would submit amendments for the October Quarterly and 12 Day Pre-General Reports reflecting the refunds.

I advised Ms. Tureen, that when they receive the refunds from these committees they should include them on the report covering the period when they are received, not on amendments to the original reports. I told her not to go back in time to include this activity, but to go forward based on when they receive the refunds. She understood and said she would amend her response accordingly.
