

I am writing on behalf of the Travis County Democratic Party in response to your subpoena dated June 30, 1998 for various records. As a federally registered political committee, the Travis County Democratic Party is required to file periodic reports of contributions and expenditures with the Federal Elections Commission. The last reports filed were those due July 15, 1998. Currently, our office is operating on two part-time employees who have not recently had the time to help conduct the thorough search necessary to compile the records you seek. Moreover, the subpoena was actually not received until Monday, July 13, 1998. It is for these reasons given that we respectfully request an extension of time in which to respond. More specifically we request an extension until August 28, 1998. We believe this extension is necessary to ensure full and complete compliance with the subpoena.
